

# Sally Look

Quilts designed by Marinda Stewart. Quilt measures approximately 50" x 50"

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
DJ2731 Cream	1 panel	Cut eight 9-1/2" squares. Center a motif in each square.
DJ3156 Yellow	1/2 yard	Cut four 4" x 42-1/2" strips.
CX0940 Red	Fat Quarter	Cut two 2" x 6-1/2" strips, two 2" x 9-1/2" strips and four 4" squares.
CX1684 Yellow	Fat Quarter	Cut eight 2" x 22" strips. Piece them into two 2" x 42-1/2" strips and two 2" x 39-1/2" strips.
CX3136 Black	Fat Quarter	Cut twenty-six Template A pieces.
CX3138 Black	Fat Quarter	Cut twenty-two Template A pieces.
CX1065 Cherry	Fat Quarter	Cut sixteen 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips and twenty 1-1/2" squares.
CX1065 Tangerine	Fat Quarter	Cut twenty 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips and sixteen 1-1/2" squares.
DJ3157 White	Fat Quarter	Cut twenty-two Template A pieces and two 3-1/2" squares.
CX3155 Retro	Fat Quarter	Cut twenty-six Template A pieces and two 3-1/2" squares.

## You will also need:

CX1065 Cherry	3/8 yard	Cut five 2-1/4 x width of fabric strips. Piece the strips together for the binding.
Backing	55" x 55"	
Batting	55" x 55"	

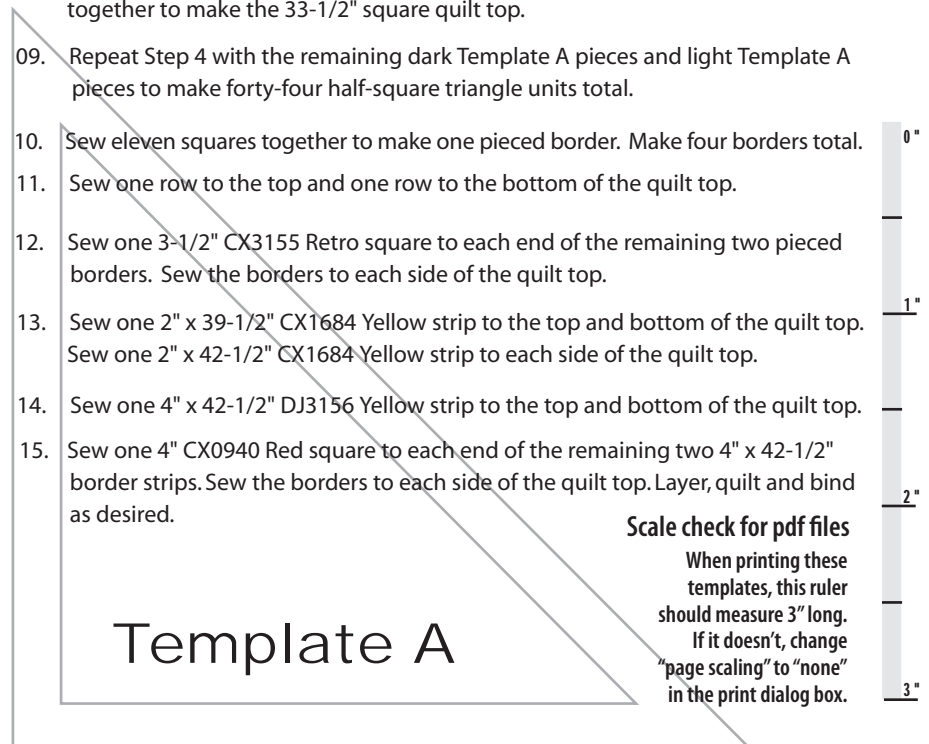
Acrylic ruler, mat and rotary cutter  
 Scissors and Straight Pins  
 100% cotton thread to match  
 Basic sewing supplies

## Disclaimers

- Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
- While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Assembly Instructions

01. Sew one 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" CX1065 Cherry strip to the top and bottom of one 9-1/2" DJ2731 Cream square. Sew one 1-1/2" Tangerine square to each end of two 1 1/2" x 9-1/2" CX1065 Cherry stripes. Sew each strip to the side of the 9-1/2" block.
02. Repeat Step 1 to make three more Cherry bordered squares.
03. Repeat Step 1 with sixteen 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" Tangerine strips and sixteen 1-1/2" Cherry squares to border the four remaining 9-1/2" DJ2731 Cream squares.
04. To make the center square: Sew together one CX3136 Black Template A piece and one DJ3155 Retro Template A piece to make one 3-1/2" half-square triangle. Repeat to make four half-square triangles total.
05. Refer to the quilt photo and sew the four half-square triangles together to make a 6-1/2" square pinwheel block.
06. Sew one 2" x 6-1/2" CX0940 Red strip to the top and bottom of the Pinwheel block. Sew one 2" x 9-1/2" CX0940 Red strip to each side of the pinwheel block.
07. Repeat Step one with four 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" CX1065 Tangerine strips and four 1-1/2" CX1065 Cherry squares.
08. Sew the blocks together into three rows alternating border colors as shown in the quilt photo. Place the pieced block in the center of row #2. Join the three rows together to make the 33-1/2" square quilt top.
09. Repeat Step 4 with the remaining dark Template A pieces and light Template A pieces to make forty-four half-square triangle units total.
10. Sew eleven squares together to make one pieced border. Make four borders total.
11. Sew one row to the top and one row to the bottom of the quilt top.
12. Sew one 3-1/2" CX3155 Retro square to each end of the remaining two pieced borders. Sew the borders to each side of the quilt top.
13. Sew one 2" x 39-1/2" CX1684 Yellow strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 42-1/2" CX1684 Yellow strip to each side of the quilt top.
14. Sew one 4" x 42-1/2" DJ3156 Yellow strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
15. Sew one 4" CX0940 Red square to each end of the remaining two 4" x 42-1/2" border strips. Sew the borders to each side of the quilt top. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.



### Scale check for pdf files

When printing these templates, this ruler should measure 3" long. If it doesn't, change "page scaling" to "none" in the print dialog box.
