

# Tuscan Vista

Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Quilt measures approximately 29-1/2" x 44"

<b>Fabric</b>	<b>Yardage</b>	<b>Cutting</b>
CX3225 Grape	1/2 yard*	Cut each landscape into nine 4-3/4" x 4-3/4" squares. Keep the landscape pieces in order.
K2255 Dark Olive Green	3/4 yard	Cut fifteen 1-1/4" x 4-3/4" pieces. Cut four 1-1/4" x 29-3/4" pieces. Cut two 1-1/4" x 16-1/4" pieces. Cut four 2-1/4" x width of fabric strips for the binding.
CX3223 Moss	1-1/8 yard**	Cut two horizontal pieces 4" x 37-1/2". Cut two vertical pieces 4" x 29-1/2". (1/2 yard cut crosswise)
CX3223 Sienna	5/8 yard**	Cut two horizontal pieces 2-5/8" x 31-1/4". Cut two vertical pieces 2-5/8" x 20-1/2". (1/4 yard cut crosswise)
CX3223 Seafoam	5/8 yard**	Cut two vertical pieces 1-1/2" x 20-1/2". Cut two horizontal pieces 1-1/2" x 37-1/2". (1/6 yard cut crosswise)

\* Or amount needed to give a complete motif.

\*\* These fabrics are a one-way print. Crosswise cutting only measurements are in parenthesis.

## You will also need:

34" X 48" backing

34" X 48" batting

Threads to match

Scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, mat, rotary cutter

- Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
- While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and or sewing. the enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Assembly Instructions

- 01) Sew one 1-1/4" x 4-3/4" K2255 Green piece to the right side of the first five CX3225 Grape squares in each row.
- 02) Refer to the quilt photo and sew the squares together to make three rows.
- 03) Sew the remaining 6th CX3225 Grape square to each row.
- 04) Using the 1-1/4" x 29-3/4" K2255 Green strips, join the rows together, starting and ending with a K2255 Green strip to make the quilt top center.
- 05) Sew one 1-1/4" x 16-1/4" K2255 Green strip to each side of the quilt top center to make a 16-1/4" x 31-1/4" quilt top.
- 06) Sew one 2-5/8" x 31-1/4" CX3223 Sienna strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 07) Sew one 2-5/8" x 20-1/2" CX3223 Sienna strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 08) Sew one 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" CX3223 Seafoam strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 09) Sew one 1-1/2" x 37-1/2" CX3223 Seafoam strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 10) Sew one 4" x 37-1/2" CX3223 Moss strip to top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 11) Sew one 4" x 29-1/2" CX3233 Moss strip to each side of the panel.
- 12) Layer and quilt as desired.
- 13) Using K2255 green to bind the quilt.

NOTE: Extra yardage from 1-way pattern may be pieced together for backing.
