Disclaimers

2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Center Square:

1. From C2860-Lime and C2861 Spearmint, cut two 9-1/2" squares for a total of four 9-1/2" squares.
2. Sew the four 9-1/2" squares into one 18-1/2" four patch background.
3. Using a water soluble marker, refer to the quilt photo and draw five flower stems on the 18-1/2" Background.
4. Using green thread, and machine satin stitch over the drawn lines to make the flower stems.
5. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace twenty-four leaves and one bow onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape.
6. From C2858-Green, cut one 6" square.
7. Press twelve leaves onto the back side of the 6" C2858-Green square. Press the remaining twelve leaves onto the back side of C2857-Green. Press the Bow onto the back side of C2857-Ocean.
8. Cut out each shape on the drawn line. Follow the quilt photo for reference and press the bow and leaves onto the 18-1/2" Background.
9. Finish the raw edges with a decorative stitch such as a satin or blanket stitch.

Border One:

10. From C2861-Lime, cut two 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" strips.
11. Sew one 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strip to each side of the Center Square. Sew one 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the Center Square.

Border Two:

12. From C2857-Sunny, cut forty-eight 2-1/2" squares. From C2858-Candy, cut forty-eight 2-1/2" squares.
13. Take two squares of each color and sew them together into a 4-1/2" 4-patch square. Make twenty-four 4-patch squares total.
14. Sew together five 4-patch blocks to make one side border. Make two total. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
16. Sew together seven 4-patch blocks for the top and bottom borders. Sew the borders to the quilt top.

Border Three:

17. From C 2860 Lagoon, cut two 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips.
18. Sew one 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
