

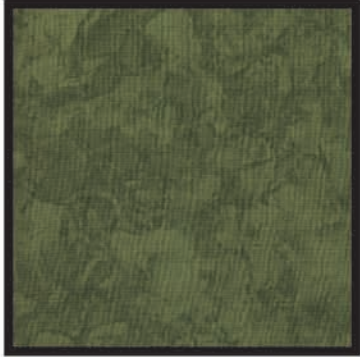

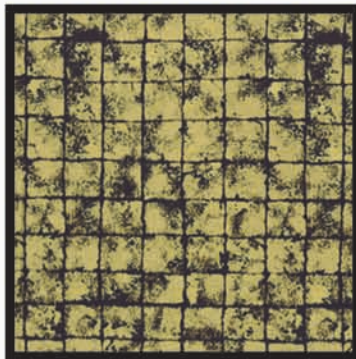

Pretty Peacock

Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Quilt measures approximately 40" x 50"

Always measure the quilt top before cutting border lengths.

Fabric:	Yardage:	Cutting:
CM3641 Teal	1 yard	Cut one 20-1/2" x 30-1/2" panel, centered on one peacock motif. Fussy cut six 3-1/2" squares centered on a small cluster of flowers. See instructions for appliquéd flowers.
K2276	1-1/2 yards	Cut fifty 5-1/2" squares. Cut six 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles. Cut six 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces. Cut five 2-1/4" x WOF (Width of Fabric) pieces for binding.
K1156	Fat Eighth	See instructions for appliquéd leaves.
K2255	Fat Eighth	See instructions for appliquéd leaves.
CM2822 Black	Fat Eighth	See instructions for appliquéd tiles.

You will also need:

45" x 55" backing (Recommended – CM3642 Teal)

45" X 55" batting

Threads to match (including a brass color for appliqué)

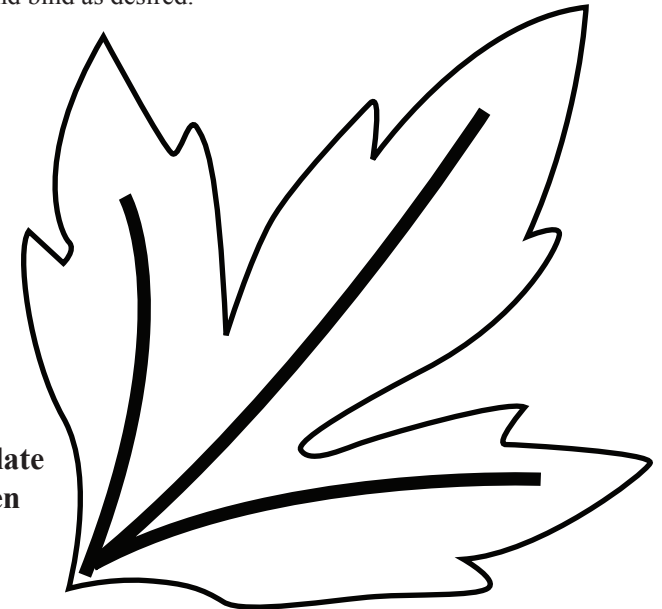
Scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, mat, rotary cutter

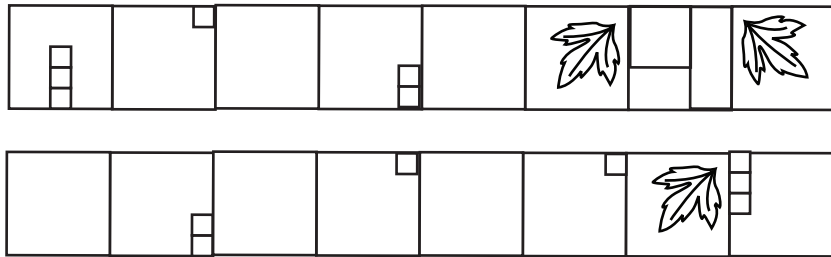
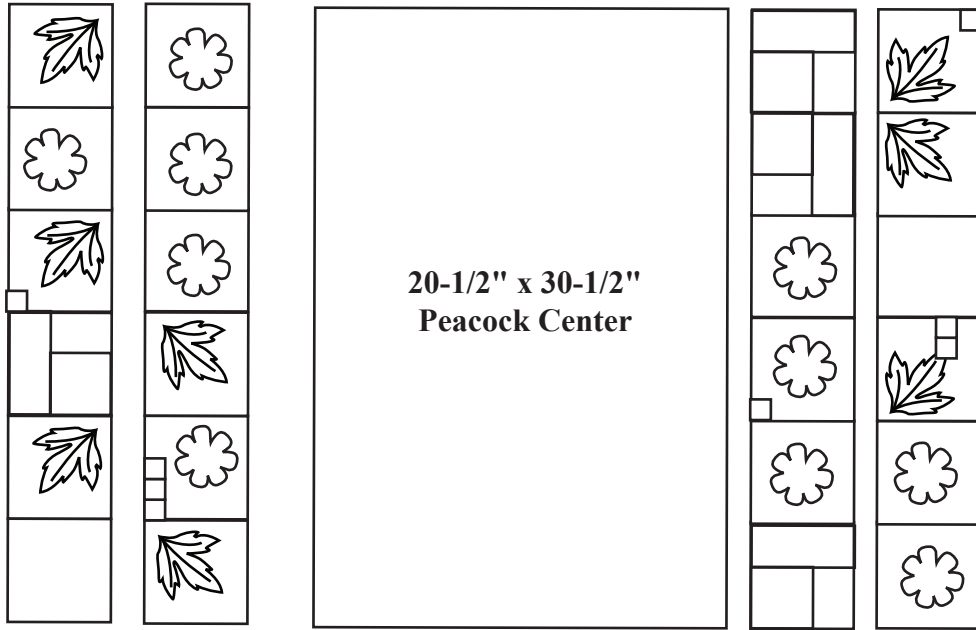
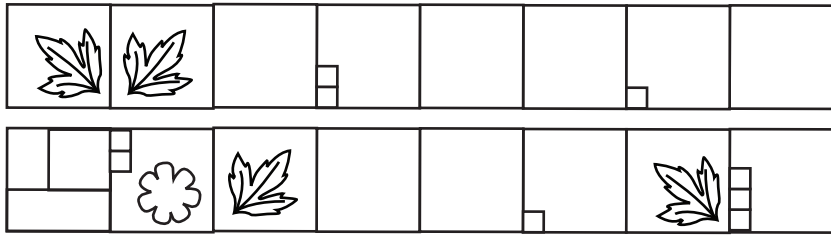

- Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
- While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and or sewing. the enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Assembly Instructions:

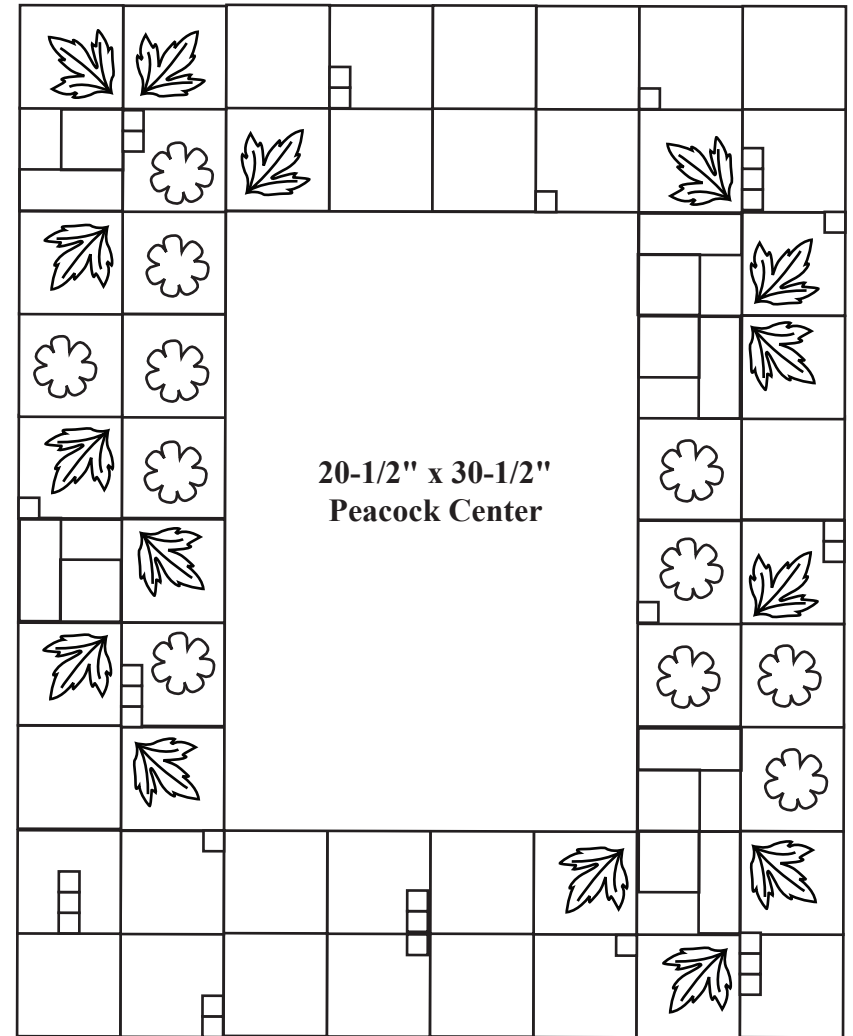
- 01) Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace fifteen leaves onto fusible web using the leaf template. Roughly cut out each leaf about a 1/4" outside the drawn lines.
- 02) Press seven leaves onto the back side of the K1156 and eight leaves onto the back side of K2255. Cut the leaves out on the drawn lines.
- 03) Fuse one leaf to one K2276 block with the stem end placed in a corner of the square. NOTE: Place the leaves inside the seam allowance on the blocks. Machine appliqué the raw edges of the leaf with contrasting brass colored thread. Add leaf veins with a satin stitch. Make fifteen leaf blocks total.
- 04) Iron fusible web onto the back of CM2822 Black. Fussy cut four 3-tile pieces, five 2-tile pieces and eight 1-tile pieces. Refer to the quilt top layout and press four 3-tile pieces, four 2-tile pieces and six 1-tile pieces each onto a K2276 square. Press one 2-tile piece and two 1-tile pieces on K2276 blocks that have leafs on them. Machine appliqué all pieces in place. NOTE: Place tiles inside seam allowance on the blocks.
- 05) Rough cut eleven assorted flowers from CM3641 Teal. Back each flower with fusible web. Fussy cut out each flower.
- 06) Press eight flowers onto eight plain K2276 blocks. Press one flower to a K2276 block with a 3-tile piece on it. Press one flower to a K2276 block with a 2-tile piece. Press one flower to a K2276 block with a 1-tile piece. Machine appliqué all pieces in place.
- 07) To make a pieced block, sew one 3-1/2" x 2-1/2" K2276 strip to the top of each 3-1/2" square CM3641 Teal. Sew one 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" K2276 strip to one side of each piece.
- 08) Follow the quilt top layouts on page 2 to arrange the 5-1/2" blocks around the 20-1/2" x 30-1/2" peacock center. Sew the blocks and Peacock center together to make the quilt top.
- 09) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
