Quilt by Marinda Stewart

Size: Approximately 39" x 49" Square - Skill Level: Confident Beginner

**Also Needed:** 45" x 54" Backing, 45" x 54" Batting, threads to match, Fusible Web, Straight Pins, Scissors, Acrylic Ruler, Rotary Cutter, and Mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

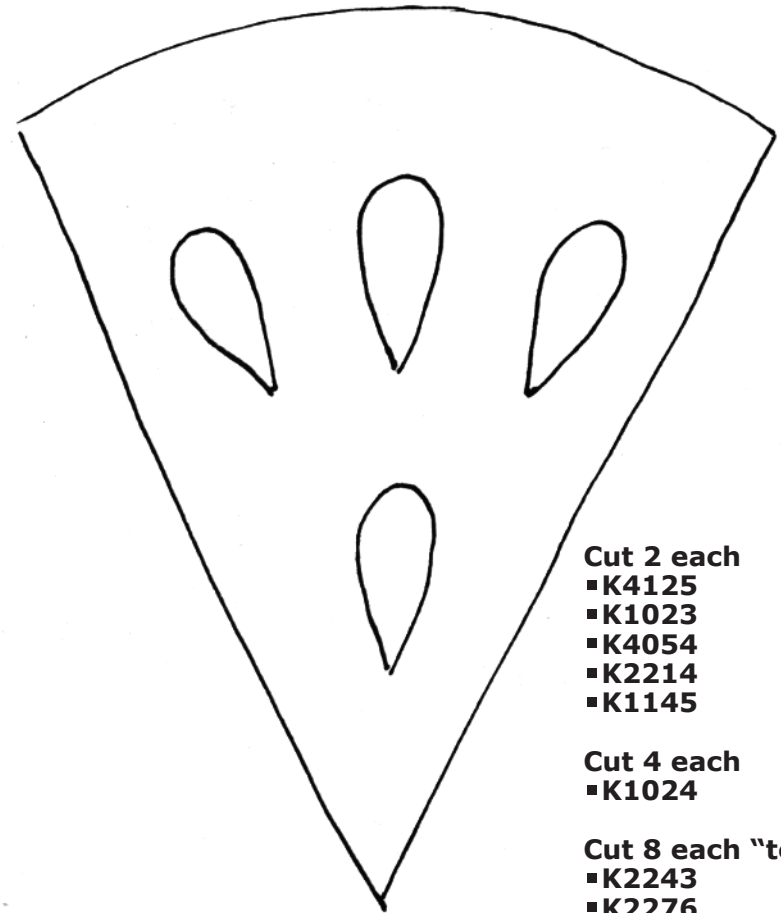
While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

**Directions**

1. Sew one CX1065 Red 24" piece to the top and bottom of the DC4216 panel. Sew one CX1065 Red 15 1/2" piece to each side.
2. Mark the middle of the panel at the top and bottom and each side. Center one DC4246 35" piece on the top and bottom. Stitch in place to within 1/4" of each edge. Center one DC4246 25" piece on each side. Sew in place as described. Miter corners to finish. Trim away excess to 1/4" seam allowance.
3. Sew one CX4247 3 1/2" strip to each side of the quilt.
4. Sew one CX1065 Red 1 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the panel. Set aside.
5. For "pie" panel - Trace (14) pie wedges onto the paper side of the fusible web. Cut out leaving a margin around each piece. Following manufacturers directions iron pie wedges onto the fabrics as listed on the pattern sheet. Cut out. Fuse (7) pie wedges onto each 6 1/2" CX1065 Ocean panels as shown. Trace (16) teardrops onto the fusible web. Iron (8) each on K2243 and K2276. Cut out. Add to the tops of (2) each of the K1024 pie wedges as shown. From remaining K1024 cut 1/2" strips. Make a woven lattice "crust" for the K1145 pie wedges. Machine applique all raw edges to finish. Make two panels.
6. Sew one panel to the top and bottom of the quilt.
7. Sew one CX1065 Red 1 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
8. Sew one DC4227 3 1/2" strip to the top of the quilt. Sew one DC4227 4 1/2" strip to the bottom of the quilt.

9. Sew one CX1065 Red 1 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
10. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
11. Quilt as desired.
12. Turning under raw edges, stitch RR1065-Latte pieces to each pie wedge for crust. Sew one RR1065 Snow 4 1/2" and 4" to (4) of the pie wedges for whipped cream. Sew remaining (4) pieces of RR1065 Snow into rosettes. Sew onto remaining pie wedges as shown.
13. Bind the quilt with CX1065 Red piecing as needed for length.
