Finished Quilt approximately 56" x 56"

CX3083 Button Up col. Red	1/3 yard
CX3083 Button Up col. White	1/3 yard
CX3085 Sew What col. White	1/3 yard
CX3085 Sew What col. Red	1/3 yard
CX3086 Zip It col. Black	1 yard
CX3086 Zip It col. Red	1 3/4 yards
CX2781 Tiny Check col. Snow	1/3 yard
CX1065 Garden Pindot col. Black	1/4 yard
K1080 Krystal (col. Light Grey)	1/4 yard
K2149 Krystal (col. Dark Red)	1/4 yard
Backing	3 yards
Batting	60" x 60"

2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

# ZIPPER-DE-DO-DAH

## Directions

1. From each Button Up CX3083 and Sew What CX3085 fabrics, cut 16 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".
2. From each Krystal, cut 16 squares 3" x 3" and 16 squares 2" x 2".
3. The grey Krystal will be used with the CX3083 Button Up red squares and the red CX3085 Sew What red squares. The red Krystal will be used with the CX3083 Button Up black squares and the CX3085 Sew What white squares.

NOTE: The CX3085 Sew What square is a one-way design. Make sure you have the connector squares placed in the correct corner.

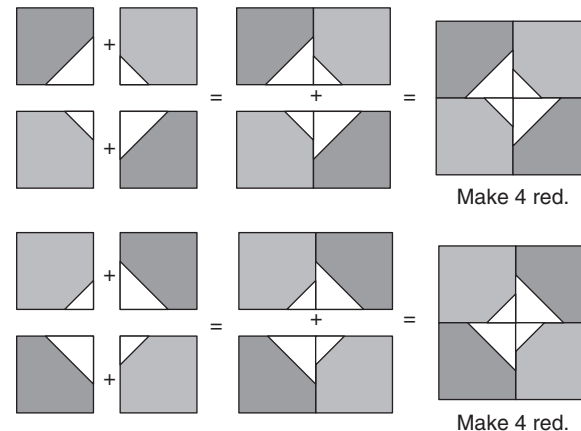
Place 3" grey squares right sides together in one corner of a red square. Stitch diagonally across the square. Press triangle back. Trim excess fabric from behind triangle, if desired. Repeat for a total of 16 squares.

Place 2" squares right sides together with the remaining red squares. Stitch diagonally across the square. Press triangle back. Trim excess fabric from behind triangle, if desired. Repeat for a total of 16 squares.



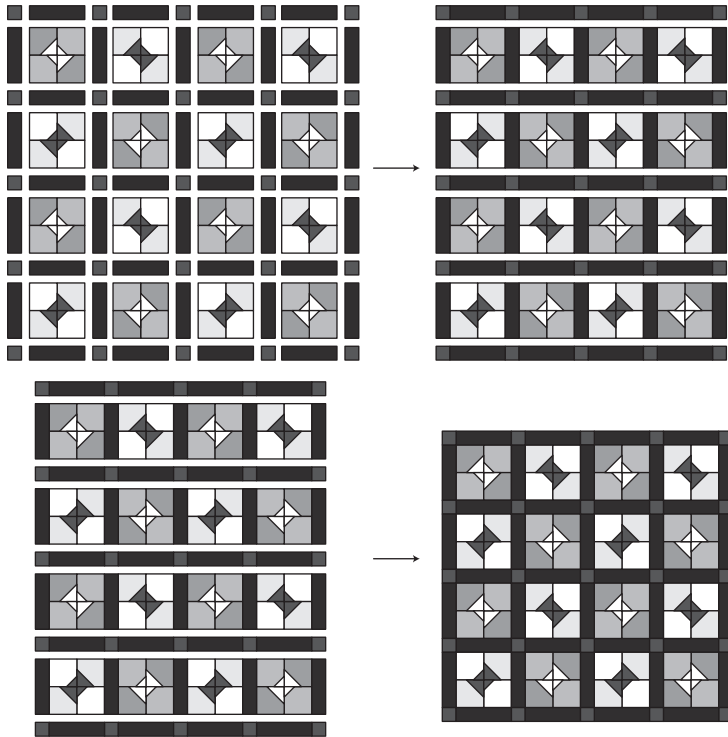
Place square right sides together on background rectangle. Stitch diagonally as shown. Press square on seam line. Cut away both layers behind triangle. Press and trim.

4. Stitch squares together into 4 patches.



5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to make eight 4-patches with CX3083 Button Up white and the CX3085 Sew What white squares. Make 4 with the spools turning left and 4 with the spools turning right.

6. From CX3086 Zip It black, cut 40 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut all fabric LENGTHWISE and center the zipper motifs in the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " width.
7. From CX1065 Garden Pindot black, cut 20 squares  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".
8. Stitch the zipper strips, the pindot squares and the 4-patches together to complete the quilt center.



9. From CX2781 Tiny Check snow, cut 2 strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42\frac{1}{2}$ ". Stitch to the sides of the quilt center. Cut 2 strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ " and stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
10. From CX3086 Zip It red, cut 4 strips  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x LENGTHWISE of fabric, centering the zippers in the width. Stitch strips to all 4 sides of the quilt, starting and stopping stitching  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each end. Miter the corners corners by folding strips in half diagonally, lining up the strips and stitching at a  $45^\circ$  angle from corner to outside of strips. Trim excess fabric from underneath strips. Repeat for all 4 corners.
