

Advent Calendar

Quilt designed by Ma rind a Stewart. Quilt measures approximately 28" x 34"

Always measure the quilt top before cutting border lengths.

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
CX3328 Red	2/3 yard	Cut one 17-1/4" wide x 23-1/2" high
CX3302 Red	3/4 yard	Cut the following strips on the bias: two 1-1/4" x 17-1/4" two 1-1/4" x 24-1/2"
		Cut and Piece enough bias strips to make 2-1/4" x 3-3/4 yards for Binding.
CX3348 red	3/4 yard	Cut two 5-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips and two 5-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips.

BORDER PACKAGES-

CX1065 Snow	1/4 yard	Cut twelve 2-1/2" squares and twelve 2-1/2 x 3-1/2" rectangles for lining.
CX3136 Santa	Fat 1/8	Cut two 2-1/2" squares and two 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
CX482 Bubblegum	Fat 1/8	Cut two 2-1/2" squares and two 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
CX3197 Grass	Fat 1/8	Cut two 2-1/2" squares and two 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
CX3248 Red	Fat 1/8	Cut two 2-1/2" squares and two 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
CX3300 Red	Fat 1/8	Cut two 2-1/2" squares and two 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
CX3584 Key Lime	Fat 1/8	Cut two 2-1/2" squares and two 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
RR-1065 Apple	Two 4 yard packages of Michael Miller "Ruffle Rac"	

You will also need:

32" x 44" backing
32" x 44" batting
Threads to match
Scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, mat, rotary cutter
1-3/4 yards each of six different 1/4" wide ribbons for small packages
2-2/3 yards each of three different 1/4" wide red ribbons for the tree
Twenty-four small assorted ornaments 1" to 1-1/2" in size
Fabric Glue or a hot glue gun with glue sticks

- Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
- While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and or sewing. the enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Assembly Instructions:

- 01) Sew one 1-1/4" x 17-1/4" CX3302 Red strip to top and bottom of the 17-1/4" x 23-1/2" CX3328 Red piece. Sew one 1-1/4" x 24-1/2" CX3302 Red strip to each side of the CX3328 Red piece to make the quilt top.
- 02) Sew one 5-1/2" x 18-1/2" CX3348 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 5-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 03) Take the six 1/4" wide package ribbons and match them to each of the 2-1/2" square and 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle border packages.
- 04) Cut two 2-1/2" ribbon pieces for each 2-1/2" square package. Glue or sew each piece of ribbon to each 2-1/2" square as shown in the quilt photo.
- 05) Cut one 2-1/2" ribbon piece and one 3-1/2" ribbon piece for each 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Glue or sew each piece of ribbon to each 2-1/2" square as shown in the quilt photo.
- 06) Tie a bow from the matching 10" length of ribbon for each package. Attach the bows to each package by gluing or sewing it in place.
- 07) To line each package, place one 2-1/2" CX1065 Snow square right sides together with one 2-1/2" package from Step 5. Sew around all four sides of the layered pieces using an 1/8" seam allowance, leaving a 1" opening for turning. Clip corners and turn the present right side out. Press and slip stitch the opening close. Repeat with the remaining 2-1/2" square presents.
- 08) Repeat Step 7 with the 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" CX1065 Snow and the 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" presents.
- 09) Arrange the packages around the outside border of the quilt top as shown in the quilt photo. Topstitch each package down each side and across the bottom in place. Leave the top of each present open to slide the ornaments into when not in use.
- 10) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
- 11) Using fabric glue or hot glue. Arrange "Ruffle Rac" in a tree shape starting at the top and working back and forth to create the tree as shown.
- 12) Cut eight 12" lengths from each of the three red ribbon for a total of twenty-four 12" ribbons. Attach each ribbon to the tree as shown in the photo. Tie each ribbon into a bow.
- 13) Remove one ornament from a package each day starting on December 1. Tie the ornament onto the tree using an attached bow. The tree is fully decorated on Christmas Eve.
