2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

1. To make the Block: From CX2833 Tan, cut four 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips, four 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips and sixteen 2-1/2" squares. From CX2781 Kiwi, cut eight 5-1/2" x 7" strips, four 5-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips and eight 2-1/2" squares. From CX2816 Purple cut eight 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips and eight 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips.
2. Place one 2-1/2" CX2781 Kiwi square on top of the lower left corner of one 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" CX2833 Tan strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabrics 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
3. Place another 2-1/2" CX2781 Kiwi square on top of the lower right corner of the 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" CX2833 Tan strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabrics 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

4. Sew one 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" CX2781 Kiwi Strip to either side of one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" CX2833 Tan strip (fig. 3).

5. Follow Figure Four and sew together the basket block.
6. Sew one 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" CX 2816 Purple strip to each of the basket block. Sew one 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" CX2816 Purple strip to the top and bottom of the basket block.
7. Follow the flip and sew technique from Step 2 and sew one 2-1/2" CX2833 Tan square on each corner of the basket block (fig. 5). Repeat Steps 2-6 to make three more basket blocks.

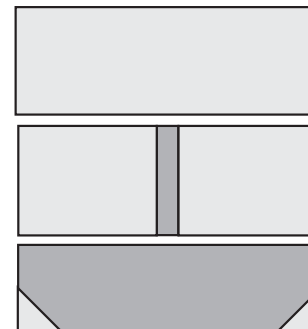

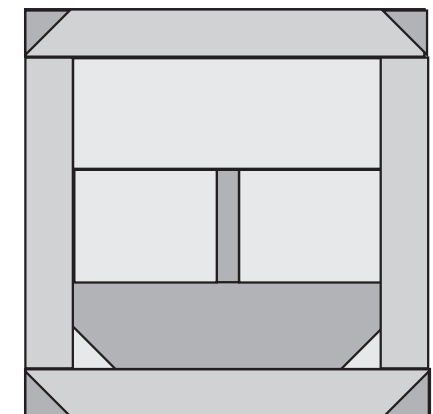

8. Following the manufacturer's instructions on the fusible web, trace sixteen of the Dragonfly Body templates and sixteen of each of the Dragonfly Wing templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape.
9. Fuse each shape onto the back side of the appropriate fabric as listed on the template. Cut out each shape on the drawn line.
10. Following the manufacturer's instructions on the fusible web, fuse the remaining piece of fusible web to the back side of 5/8 yard of CX2545-Blue fabric (the remainder is for the second border).
11. Fussy cut sixteen bunches of flowers from the fabric print. Using the quilt photo as a reference position four bunches of flowers in each basket. Add more or take away bunches of flowers until you are happy with the result. Press the flowers to the basket block.
12. Using the quilt photo as a reference press two dragonflies onto each quilt block.
13. Finish the raw edges on all of the applique shapes with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
14. Sew the four completed basket blocks together to make the quilt top.
15. Using the quilt photo as a reference press the remaining dragonflies onto the quilt top.
16. Finish the raw edges on all of the applique shapes with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
17. For Border One, from Krystal 2255, cut two 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips for the side borders and two 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips for the top and bottom borders.
18. Starting with the side borders, sew Border One to the quilt top.
19. For Border Two, from CX2545-Blue, cut two 3-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips for the side borders and three 3-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together into two 3-1/2" x 46-1/2" strips for the top and bottom borders.
20. Starting with the side borders, sew Border Two to the quilt top.
21. For Border Three, from CX2490 Kiwi, cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips and piece them together into two 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" strips for the side borders and two 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips for the top and bottom borders.
22. Starting with the side borders, sew Border Three to the quilt top.
21. For the binding: From Krystal 1267, cut six 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Piece them together to make the binding.
22. Layer quilt and bind as desired.
