Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Quilt measures approximately 51" x 51"

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
<b>Block Combination A</b>		
CX3318 Wedgwood (L-1)	1/4 yard	Cut twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blocks.
CX3323 Sailor (L-2)	3/8 yard	Cut thirty-six 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares and six 5" x 5" blocks.
CX3346 Navy (D-1)	1/4 yard	Cut twenty-four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blocks.
CX3351 Navy (D-2)	1/4 yard	Cut fifteen 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares and six 5" x 5" blocks.
<b>Block Combination B</b>		
CX3248 Denim (L-1)	1/4 yard	Cut twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blocks.
CX3318 Ivory (L-2)	3/8 yard	Cut thirty-six 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares and six 5" x 5" blocks.
CX3345 Navy (D-1)	1/4 yard	Cut twenty-four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blocks.
CX3323 Navy (D-2)	1/4 yard	Cut fifteen 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares and six 5" x 5" blocks.
<b>Block Combination C</b>		
CX3323 Wedgwood (L-1)	1/4 yard	Cut twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blocks.
CX1065 Navy (L-2)	3/8 yard	Cut thirty-six 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares and six 5" x 5" blocks.
CX3349 Navy (D-1)	1/4 yard	Cut twenty-four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blocks.
CX3347 Navy (D-2)	1/4 yard	Cut fifteen 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares and six 5" x 5" blocks.
<b>Borders</b>		
CX3318 Navy	1/2 yard	Cut thirty 4" x 4" squares.
CX3348 Navy	1/2 yard	Cut thirty 4" x 4" squares.
K2264	5/8 yard	Cut six 1-3/4" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together and then cut two 1-3/4" x 48-1/2" strips and two 1-3/4" x 51" strips. Cut six 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together for binding.

## You will also need:

59" x 59" backing  
59" x 59" batting  
Threads to match  
Scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, mat, rotary cutter

- While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and or sewing. the enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Assembly Instructions:

This quilt is made with one block layout from three different color combinations. You will need to make three blocks of each color combination for a total of nine blocks. Follow the instructions to make half-square triangles and picket units for each block using the Light #1 (L-1), Light #2 (L-2), Dark #1 (D-1) and Dark #2 (D-2) as listed in the cutting instructions next to each fabric for each color combination. Follow the block diagram to assemble the blocks.

## Quick Half-Square Triangles:

- 01) Place one 5" L-2 square on top of one 5" D-2 square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner (fig. 1).
- 02) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn line (fig. 2). Cut the sewn squares apart on drawn line to make two half-square triangles (fig. 3). Trim each square to measure 4-1/2". Make twelve half-square triangles for each colorway.

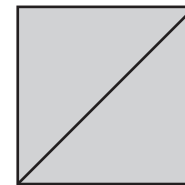

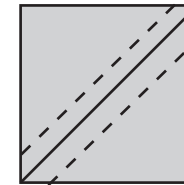

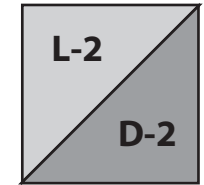
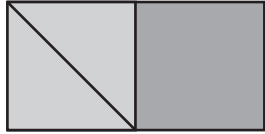

**Pickets Instructions:**

- 03) Place one 2-1/2" L-2 square on top of one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" D-1 strip aligning one side, right sides together. Draw a line across the square's diagonal from the upper left to lower right corner (fig. 4).
- 04) Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Flip open the the triangle formed to check alignment (fig. 5). Trim away excess fabric. Press open. Make twelve pickets for each color combination.

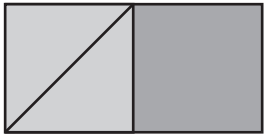

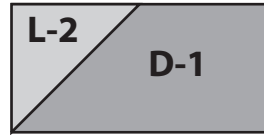

- 05) Place one 2-1/2" L-2 square on top of one 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" D-1 strip aligning one side, right sides together. Draw a line across the square's diagonal from the upper right to lower left corner (fig. 6).
- 06) Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Flip open the the triangle formed to check alignment (fig. 7). Trim away excess fabric. Press open. Make twelve pickets for each color combination.

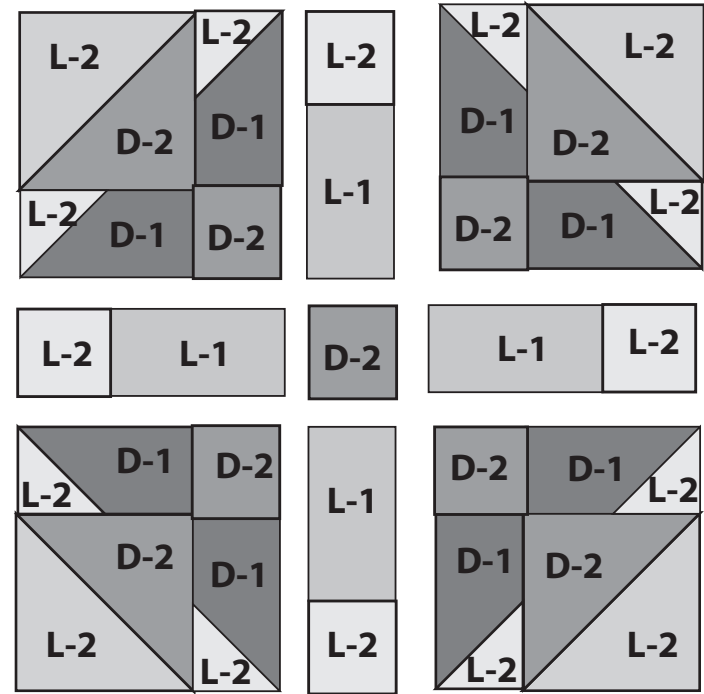

- 07) Make three 14-1/2" (unfinished) blocks from each color combination following the block layout.
- 08) Refer to the quilt photo for block placement and sew together three blocks to make one row. Make three rows total. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.
- 09) For the pieced border, make sixty half- squares using the 4" x 4" CX3318 squares and the 4" x 4" CX3348 squares, following the steps 1 and 2, but trim the the squares to measure 3-1/2" square.
- 10) Sew fourteen half-square triangles together for the top and bottom borders. Sew the borders to the quilt top. Sew sixteen half-square triangles together for each side border. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
- 11) Sew one 1-3/4" x 48-1/2" K2264 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 1-3/4" x 51" K2264 strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 12) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
