

Spice Quilt

Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Finished quilt size approximately 50" x 50"

Fabric Requirements:

1-3/8 yard of CX3104 Spice

3/4 yard of CX3104 Cocoa

1/2 yard of CX3162 Cocoa

1/2 yard of CX3103 Olive

3/8 yard of CX3163 Coffee

3/8 yard of CX3164 Tobacco

3/4 yard of CX3164 Cocoa

Fat Quarter of CX3164 Pumpkin

Fat Quarter of CX3103 Cinnamon

1/6 yard of CX3163 Olive

1/6 yard of CX3163 Teal

1/4 yard of CX3163 Pumpkin

1/4 yard of CX3163 Paprika

6" square of CX3163 Tobacco

3-1/4 yards of Backing

58" square piece of batting

Acrylic ruler, mat and rotary cutter

100% cotton thread

Basic sewing supplies

Fusible Web

*Please read the fusible applique instructions before cutting.

Cutting Instructions:

Fussy cut the orange motif into four

1-1/2" x 30" strips. Fussy cut the Black

Diamonds into four 1-1/2" x 40" strips.

Fussy cut the Black zig zag motif into

1-1/2" x 46" strips. Fussy Cut twenty-eight

pairs of Paisleys in 1-7/8" x 4-1/2" pieces.

Fussy cut the green zig zag motif into four

1-1/2" x 24" strips. Fussy cut twenty-eight

pairs of Paisleys into 1-7/8" x 4-1/2" pieces.

Cut one 12-1/2" square and twenty-eight

1-3/4" x 4-1/2" strips.

Cut two 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips and two

2-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips. Use for extra

medallions.

Cut five 2-1/4" x width of fabric (WOF)

strips. Piece the strips together for the

binding.

Cut two 3-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips and two

3-1/2" x 20-1/2" strips.

Cut six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece them

together into two 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips and

two 3-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips.

Cut twelve of Template B*

Cut one Large Medallion for the center. Use

the rest for extra Medallions.

Cut sixteen 2-1/2" squares.

Cut sixteen 2-1/2" squares.

Cut sixteen 2-1/2" squares and six of

Template A.

Cut sixteen 2-1/2" squares and six of

Template A.

Cut twenty-eight of Template C*

Piece into one 58" square.

Disclaimers

1. This pattern is provided as a courtesy to quilt stores, catalogs and quilters. Michael Miller Fabrics, LLC is not responsible for the accuracy of any kits packaged to accompany this pattern. Please direct any inquiries to the kit maker.
2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

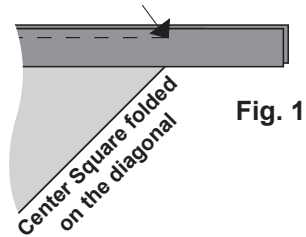
Fusible Applique Instructions:

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape.
2. Press the fusible web to the back side of the listed fabric. Cut out each shape on the drawn line.

Assembly Instructions:

3. Sew together the the six CX3163 Pumpkin Template A pieces and the six CX3163 Paprika Template A pieces alternating the colors into the center medallion piece.
4. Place the pieced Center Medallion on the center of the 12-1/2" CX3162 square. Machine applique in place. Trim the excess fabric away from the CX3162 square behind the pieced Center Medallion.
5. Take the twelve CX3164 Pumpkin Template B pieces and fuse one in the center of each petal on the piece Center Medallion. Finish the raw edges with a decorative stitch such as a satin or blanket stitch.
6. Put Fusible web on the back side of the CX3106 Cinnamon fat quarter. Cut out one large medallion. Fuse the medallion to the center of the pieced Center Medallion. Finish the raw edges.
7. Center one 1-1/2" x 16" CX3104 Cocoa strip on each side of the Center square. Starting and stopping 1/4" away from each end of the Center Square sew the two strips to the sides. Repeat with the two remaining strips and the top and bottom edges of the center square.
8. To miter the corners, fold the Center Square on the diagonal back sides together. This should line up the borders from the adjacent side (fig. 1).

- Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 1) draw a 45° line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Open up the panel and press the mitered seam. Trim away the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seam.



- Sew one 3-1/2" x 14-1/2" CX3164 Tobacco strip to the top and bottom of the center square. Sew one 3-1/2" x 20-1/2" CX3164 Tobacco strip to each side of the center square.
- Repeat the directions for adding mitered corners and sew the four 1-1/2" x 24" CX3104 Cocoa strips to the quilt top.
- Take the sixteen 2-1/2" squares from CX3163 Paprika, Olive Pumpkin and Teal to piece the next border. Sew eleven squares together alternating the four colors to make the top strip. Repeat to make the bottom strip. Sew the strips to the quilt top.
- Sew together thirteen 2-1/2" squares alternating the four colors for each side border. Sew the side borders to the quilt top.
- With the remaining 2-1/2" square make four 4-patch squares using one of each color. Set the four 4-patch blocks aside.
- Repeat the directions for adding mitered corners and sew the four 1-1/2" x 30" CX3104 Spice strips to the quilt top.
- To make one Butterfly Block, Sew one pair of CX3104 Spice paisley blocks together with one pair of CX3104 Cocoa paisley blocks. Make twenty-eight blocks total.
- Sew one 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" CX3162 Cocoa piece to each the bottom of twenty-two Butterfly Blocks. Sew one 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" CX3162 Cocoa piece to the top of the remaining Butterfly Blocks.
- Press one Template C piece to each Butterfly Block for the body. Finish the raw edges.
- Refer to the quilt photo and sew together seven butterfly blocks with the strip on the bottom for each side border. Sew the borders to the quilt.
- Sew the remaining Butterfly blocks together alternating the ones with the strip on top with the ones with the strip on the bottom into two strips of seven blocks for the top and bottom borders. Sew one 4-patch block from Step 14 to each end of the top and Bottom borders. Sew the borders to the quilt.
- Repeat the directions for adding mitered corners and sew the four 1-1/2" x 40" CX3104 Spice strips to the quilt top.
- Sew one 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" CX3103 strip to the top and Bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 42-1/2" CX3103 strip to each side of the quilt top.
- Repeat the directions for adding mitered corners and sew the four 1-1/2" x 46" CX3104 Spice strips to the quilt top.

- Sew one 3-1/2" x 44-1/2" CX3164 Strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" strip to the sides of the quilt top.
- Iron Fusible onto the back side of the remaining CX3103 Olive. Cut 69-70 assorted Medallion from both CX3103 Olive and Cinnamon.
- Press matching medallions in the center of the 4-patch blocks. Scatter the remaining medallions as follows: twenty-one on the CX3164 Tobacco Border, sixteen on the four color 2-1/2" pieced border and twenty-eight on the last Outer Border. Finish the raw edges on all with a decorative stitch.
- Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
