

Bunny Babies

Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Quilt measures approximately 51" x 51"

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
CX3134 Cream	*3-1/4 yards	Cut off the printed border 7" x 126" strip. Cut into four equal parts approximately 7" x 31-1/2". Fussy cut the following squares, centering a motif in each; twelve 5-1/2" squares and four 4" squares. Fussy cut four 4-1/2" squares centering a cottage in each for the outer border corner stones.
CX2879 Maize	5/8 yard	Cut sixteen 2-1/4" squares, forty-eight 2" squares, forty-eight A-1 Templates and sixteen B-1 Templates.
CX2861 Turq.	1/8 yard	Cut eight B-2 templates and eight B-2 reversed Templates.
CX0274 Pink	1/8 yard	Cut eight B-2 templates and eight B-2 reversed Templates.
CX2899 Brown	**1-1/4 yards	Cut four 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" strips from the length of fabric (LOF). Cut four 1-1/2" x 29-1/2" strips from the LOF. Cut four 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips, twenty-four 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips and eight 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips from the LOF.
CX1065 Sky	5/8 yard	Cut two 1" x 29-1/2" strips, two 1" x 28-1/2" strips and nine 1-1/2" squares. Cut six 2-1/4" x width of fabric strips and piece them together for the binding.
CX2858 Candy	1/6 yard	Cut twenty-four A-2 Templates and twenty-four A-2 reversed templates.
CX2857 Sky	1/6 yard	Cut twenty-four A-2 Templates and twenty-four A-2 reversed templates.
CX3133 Cream	7/8 yard	Cut four 4-1/2" x 41-1/2" strips. Fussy cut twelve 2" squares, centering a bunny in each.

* Yardage required for printed border and fussy-cut motifs. We recommend using the leftover yardage to be pieced into the backing.

** Extra yardage required. Pieces from the strips are cut vertically. Excess yardage can be pieced into the quilt backing.

You will also need:

Backing	56" x 56" piece
Batting	56" x 56" piece

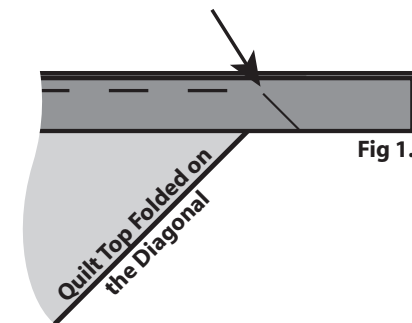
Acrylic ruler, mat and rotary cutter
Scissors and Straight Pins
100% cotton thread to match
Basic sewing supplies

- Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
- While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Assembly Instructions

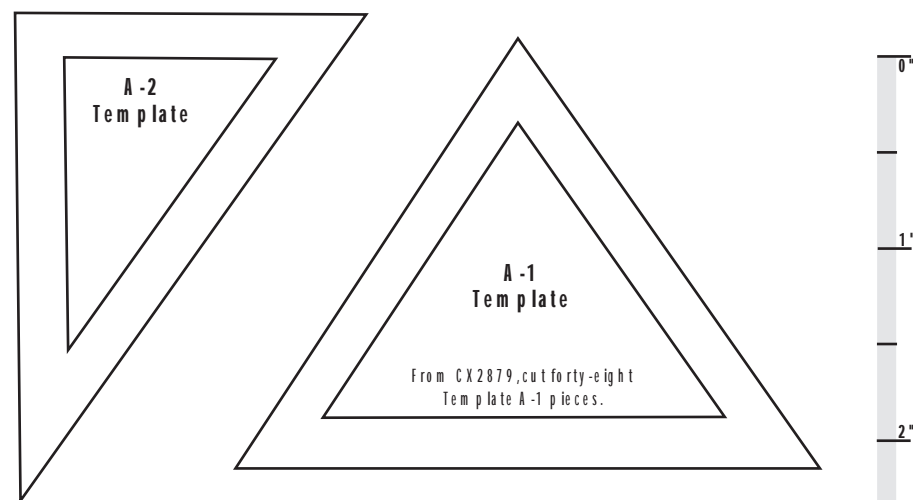
- 01) To make the large star blocks, sew one CX2861 B-2 and one B-2 reversed pieces to each side of one CX2879 B-1 piece to make one flying goose unit. Repeat to make eight CX2861 B-Units.
- 02) Sew one B-Unit to the top and bottom of one 4" CX3134 square. Sew one 2-1/4" CX2879 square to each end of two B-units to make two side units. Sew each side unit to the 4" CX3134 square to make one CX2861 Star block. Repeat to make a second CX2861 star block.
- 03) Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make two CX0274 B-2 and B-2 reversed pieces to make two more star blocks.
- 04) To assemble the quilt top center, sew one 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" CX2899 strip to the bottom of one pink star. Sew one turquoise star block to the bottom of the 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" CX2899 stripe to make one vertical row.
- 05) Repeat Step 5, only this time place the turquoise star on top and the pink star on the bottom to make the second vertical row.
- 06) Sew one 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" CX2899 strip to the top of one 1-1/2" CX1065 square. Sew another 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" CX2899 strip to the bottom of the 1-1/2" square to make the middle vertical row.
- 07) Sew the vertical row with the pink star on top to the left side of the middle vertical row. Sew the vertical row with the blue star on top to the right side of the middle vertical row to make the quilt top.
- 08) Center one 7" x 31-1/2" CX3134 strip to one side of the quilt top. Start sewing the strip 1/4" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop 1/4" from the bottom edge.
- 09) Repeat with the remaining three 7" x 31-1/2" strips on the other sides of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the quilt top.
- 10) To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal back sides together. This should line up the borders from the adjacent side (Fig. 1).
- 11) Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 4) draw a 45° line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.



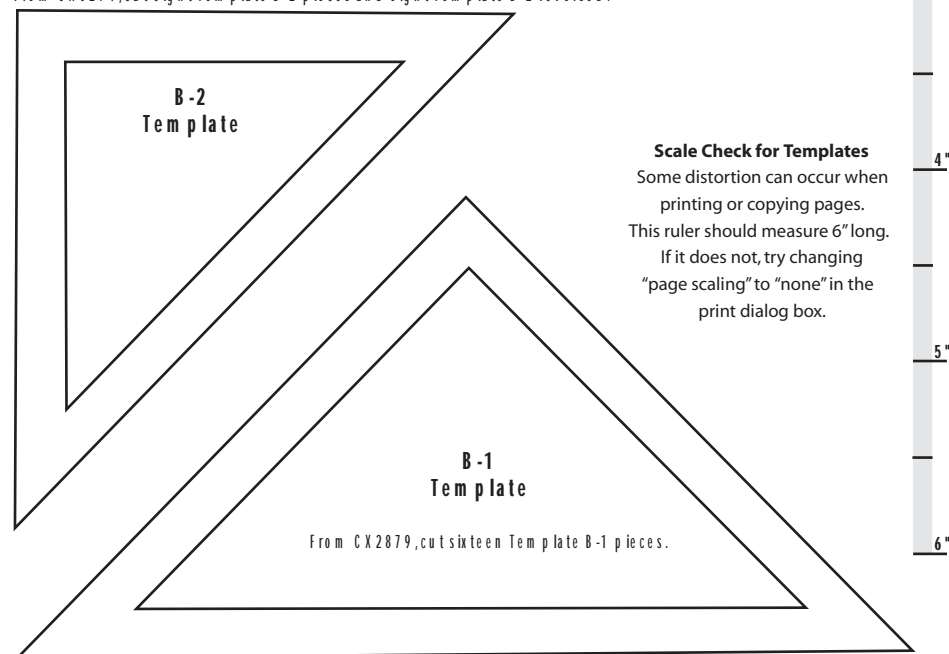
Assembly Instructions

- 12) Sew one 1" x 28-1/2" CX1065 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 1" x 29-1/2" CX1065 strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 13) Sew one 1-1/2" x 29-1/2" CX2899 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 14) Sew one 1-1/2" CX1065 square to each end of two more 1-1/2" x 29-1/2" CX2899 strips.
- 15) Sew one strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 16) For the small stars, repeat Steps 1 and 2 with twenty-four CX2858 A-2 pieces, twenty-four A-2 reversed pieces, twenty-four CX2879 A-1 pieces and twenty-four 2" CX2879 squares to make six CX2858 star blocks.
- 17) For the small stars, repeat Steps 1 and 2 with twenty-four CX2857 A-2 pieces, twenty-four A-2 reversed pieces, twenty-four CX2879 A-1 pieces and twenty-four 2" CX2879 squares to make six CX2857 star blocks.
- 18) To make the pieced top and bottom rows begin and end with a stripe piece. Alternate 5-1/2" CX 33 squares with the 5-1/2" star blocks as shown in the quilt photo with one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" CX2899 strip in between each block. Sew the top and bottom pieced borders to the quilt top.
- 19) For the side pieced borders, begin and end with a star block. Alternate the star blocks with 5-1/2" CX 33 squares with one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" CX2899 strip in between each block. Sew the pieced side borders to the quilt top.
- 20) Sew one 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" CX2899 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 21) Sew one 1-1/2" CX1065 square to each end of the remaining two 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" CX2899 strips. Sew the strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 22) For the outer border, sew one 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" CX2899 strip to each of the four 4-1/2" x 41-1/2" CX 33 strips.
- 23) Sew one 4-1/2" x 41-1/2" CX2899 strip from Step 22 to each side of the quilt top.
- 24) Sew one 4-1/2" CX 33 square to each end of the remaining two 4-1/2" x 41-1/2" CX2899 strips. Sew the strips to each side of the quilt top.
- 25) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

From CX2858, cut twenty-four Template A-2 pieces and twenty-four Template A-2 reversed.
From CX2857, cut twenty-four Template A-2 pieces and twenty-four Template A-2 reversed.



From CX2861, cut eight Template B-2 pieces and eight Template B-2 reversed.
From CX0274, cut eight Template B-2 pieces and eight Template B-2 reversed.



Scale Check for Templates
Some distortion can occur when printing or copying pages. This ruler should measure 6" long. If it does not, try changing "page scaling" to "none" in the print dialog box.
