Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Quilt measures approximately 50" x 50"

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
CX3363 Black	1/2 yard	Fussy cut one 16-1/2" wide x 19-1/2" high for Block A and one 16-1/2" wide x 7-1/2" high for Block C.
CX3365 Black	1/2 yard	Fussy cut one 10-1/2" x wide x 12-1/2" high for Block F and two 7-1/2" squares for Block D.
CX3364 Black	1/2 yard	Fussy cut one 15-1/2" wide x 17-1/2" high for Block B and one 4-1/2" wide x 10-1/2" high for Block E.
CX0482 White	3/8 yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Cut two 1-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips for Block A. •Cut two 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 19-1/2" strips for Block B. •Cut two 1" x 16-1/2" strips and two 1" x 8-1/2" strips for Block C. •Cut four 1" x 7-1/2" strips and four 1" x 8-1/2" strips for Block D. •Cut two 1" x 4-1/2" strips and two 1" x 11-1/2" strips for Block E. •Cut two 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips for Block F.
Jet Black	1 yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Cut two 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" strips for Block A. •Cut two 1-1/2" x 17-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips for Block B. •Cut two 1" x 17-1/2" strips and two 1" x 9-1/2" strips for Block C. •Cut four 1" x 8-1/2" strips and four 1" x 9-1/2" strips for Block D. •Cut two 1" x 5-1/2" strips and two 1" x 12-1/2" strips for Block E. •Cut two 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips for Block F.
*CX2573 Black	1-1/4 yard	<p>Sashing cut from width of fabric: One 4-1/2" x 20-1/2" for Block A One 3-1/2" x 27-1/2" for Block A One 4-1/2" x 21-1/2" for Block B One 3-1/2" x 23-1/2" for Block B One 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" for Block B</p>

*CX2573 Black (continued)

Sashing cut from width of fabric:

One 4-1/2" x 26-1/2" for Block C
 Two 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" for Block D
 One 2-1/2" x 27-1/2" for Block D
 Two 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" for Block E
 One 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" for Block E
 One 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" for Block F

Sashing cut from Bias-lower left to upper right:

One 4-1/2" x 20-1/2" for Block A
 One 5-1/2" x 9-1/2" for Block C
 Two 3-1/2" x 11-1/2" for Block D
 One 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" for Block E

Sashing cut from Bias-lower right to upper left:

One 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" for Block A
 One 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" for Block B
 One 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" for Block C
 One 3-1/2" x 11-1/2" for Block D

You will also need:

55" X 55" backing
 55" X 55" batting
 Threads to match, including black.
 Scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, mat, rotary cutter

- While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and or sewing. the enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

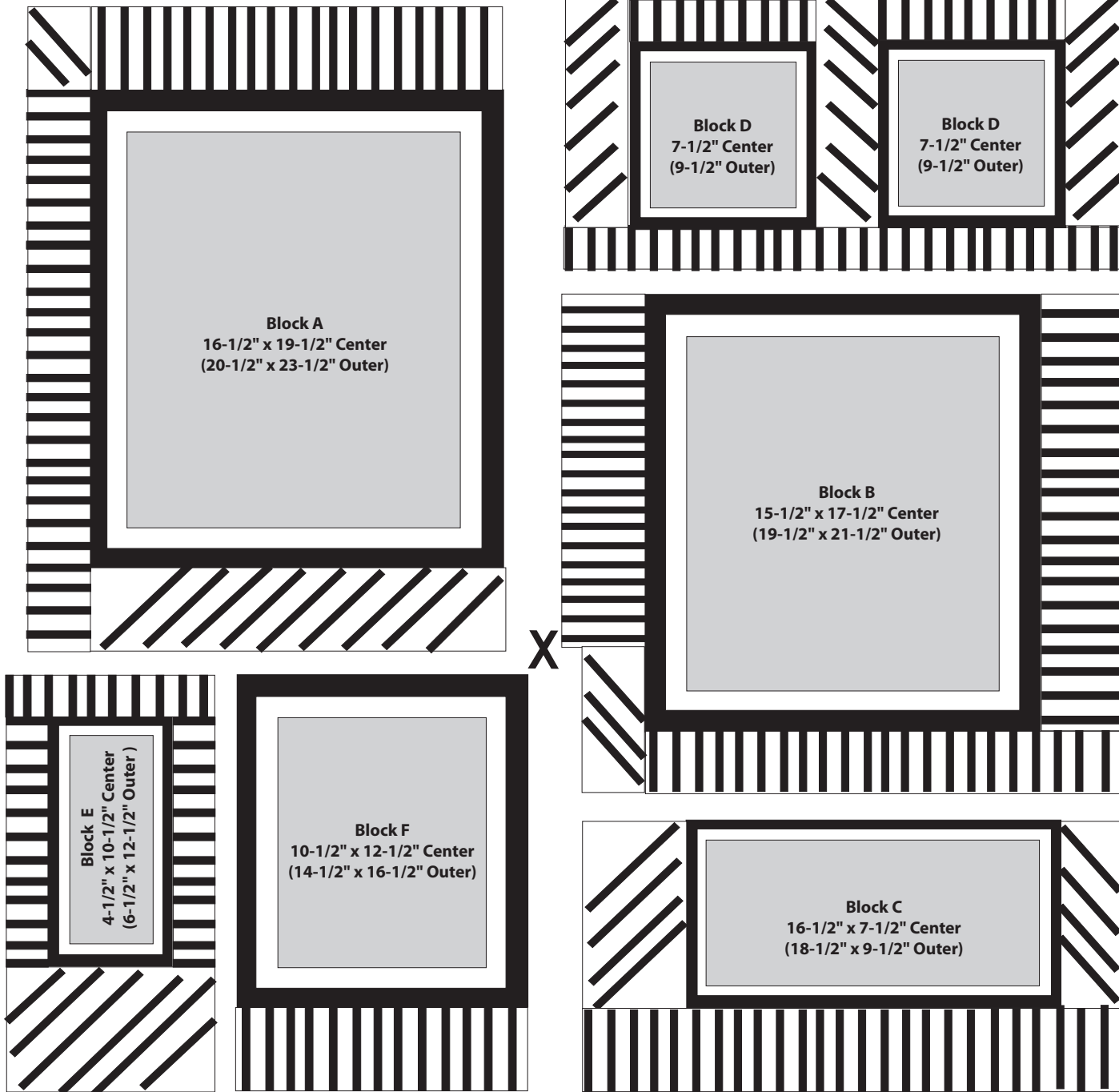
Assembly Instructions- Refer to the quilt layout on page 2 as you piece.

- 01) Make a pile of pieces for each block as listed in the cutting instructions. You should have one center square, four CX0482 strips, two of each size for the inner border and four Jet Black strips, two of each size for the outer border. You will be making one of each block except for Block D, which you will make two.
- 02) Sew the CX0482 inner border strip to the top and bottom of each center, sew one CX0482 outer border strip to each side of each center to make the blocks.
- 03) Sew one Jet Black outer border strip to the top and bottom of each block. Sew one Jet Black outer border strip to each side of each block to complete them.

The quilt top is made up of five sections. Refer the quilt top layout on page 3 for stripe direction on each piece.

- 04) For Block A section, sew one 4-1/2" x 20-1/2" vertical stripe strip to the top of Block A. Sew one 4-1/2" x 20-1/2" bias stripe strip to the bottom of Block A.
- 05) Sew one 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" bias stripe strip to the top of the 3-1/2" x 27-1/2" vertical stripe strip. Sew this piece to the left side of Block A to complete the Block A section.
- 06) For Block B section, sew one 4-1/2" x 21-1/2" vertical stripe strip to the right side of Block B. Sew the 3-1/2" x 23-1/2" vertical stripe strip to the bottom of Block B.
- 07) Sew the 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" vertical stripe strip to the top of the 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" bias stripe strip, aligning the right side of the strips. Sew these strips to the left side of Block B to complete the Block B section.
- 08) To make the Block C section, sew one 5-1/2" x 9-1/2" bias stripe strip to the left side of Block C. Sew the 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" bias stripe strip to the right side of the Block C. Sew the 4-1/2" x 26-1/2" vertical stripe strip to the bottom of the Block C to complete the section.
- 09) To make the Block D section, sew together the two Block D pieces with the three 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" bias stripe strips alternating them. Sew the 2-1/2" x 27-1/2" vertical stripe strip to the bottom of the two Block D pieces to complete the section.
- 10) To make the Block E section, sew one 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" vertical stripe strip to each side of Block E. Sew the 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" bias stripe strip to the bottom of Block E to complete the section. Sew 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" vertical stripe strip to the top of Block E.
- 11) To make the Block F section, sew the 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" vertical stripe strip to the bottom of Block F.
- 12) Sew the Block E section to the left side of the Block F section. Sew these two section to the bottom of the Block A section aligning the left edges of the block to make the left side of the quilt top. NOTE: Right side of Section F will extend beyond Section A
- 13) Sew the Block D section to the top of the Block B section. Sew the Block C section to the bottom of the Block B section to complete the left side of the quilt top.
- 14) Sew the right and left half of the quilt top together pivoting at the center corners marked by the X on diagram to sew together the quilt top.
- 15) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
