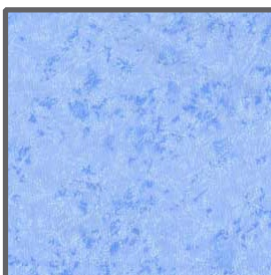

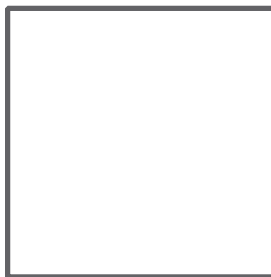

Additional Materials:

45" x 54" Backing, 45" x 54" Batting, Fusible web, Thread to match, Straight Pins, Scissors, Acrylic Ruler, Rotary Cutter, and Mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

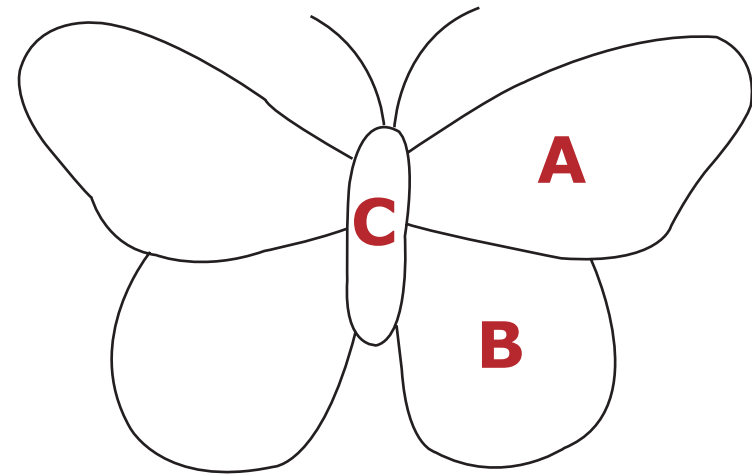
Directions

1. Sew CM0376 Cornflower 1 1/2" x 44 1/8" strips to each side of DC3937 panel. Sew 1 1/2" x 25 7/8" strips to the top and bottom of the panel.
2. Sew CM0376 Hyacinth 1" x 25 7/8" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew 1" x 47 1/8" strips to each side.
3. Sew CX2517 2 1/2" x 27 7/8" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Set center panel aside.
4. For butterfly blocks, trace four sets of wings 'A' and 'B' onto the paper side of fusible web. Iron two sets of 'A' onto the back of CX3877 Lilac and DC3931 Peri. Iron two sets of 'B' onto CX3877 Peri and CX3878 Lilac. Trace four 'C' body onto fusible web. Iron onto Jet Brown. Cut out all pieces. Arrange butterfly wings in pairs on each CM0376 Cornflower 4 1/2" square as shown on cover. Place body in the center. Fuse in place. Machine satin stitch all edges to finish.
5. Sew one CX2517 2 1/2" w x 4 1/2" h piece to each side of each butterfly block.
6. For the left panel starting at the top, sew one butterfly unit to the bottom of the CX2517 2 1/2" h x 8 1/2" w strip. Sew one 8 1/2" w x 9 1/2" h to the bottom. Add another butterfly unit to the bottom. Sew the 8 1/2" w x 14 1/2" h piece to the bottom. Sew one 2 1/2" w x 14 1/2" h

strip to each side of the CM0376 Cornflower 4 1/2" x 14 1/2" piece. Sew this unit to the bottom of the panel. Finish panel with one CX2517 4 1/2" h x 8 1/2" w piece.

7. For the right panel. Sew one butterfly unit to the bottom of one CX2517 8 1/2" w x 9 1/2" h piece. Sew 8 1/2" w x 16 1/2" h piece to the bottom. Add remaining butterfly unit to the bottom. Sew one 4 1/2" h x 8 1/2" w piece to the bottom. Sew one CX2517 2 1/2" w x 10 1/2" h piece to the bottom. Sew one CX2517 2 1/2" w x 10 1/2" h piece to each side of CM0376 Cornflower 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" piece. Sew unit to the bottom of the panel. Finally add remaining Cx2517 4 1/2" h x 8 1/2" w to the bottom.
8. For the appliqued grass, iron fusible web onto the back of CM0376 Asparagus and Krystal 1156 to make blades of grass, cut into thin diagonal wedges. Arrange as desired on each CM0376 Cornflower blocks. Fuse in place. Machine satin stitch all edges to finish.
9. Sew left panel to left side of quilt and right side to right side of quilt.
10. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste.
Bind with CM0376 Hyacinth. Piece as needed.
