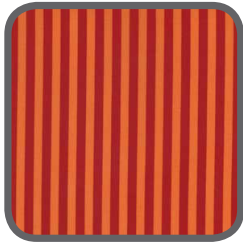

# Gerberalicious Quilt



Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart

Size: Approximately 51" x 51"

Skill Level: Intermediate or very confident beginner due to bias cuts



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## Materials

- 1½ yards of Gerberalicious • CX3730 – Red
- ¾ yard of Garden Pindot • CX1065 -Dalmation
- ⅝ yard of Cubism • CX3021 - Black
- ½ yard of Clown Stripe • CX3584 – Clementine
- ½ yard of Clown Stripe • CX3584 – White
- ⅜ yard of Jet Black
- ¼ yard of La de Dot • CX1181 – Onyx
- ⅙ yard of That's it Dot • CX2489 – Ruby
- 55" x 55" Backing
- 55" x 55" Batting
- Threads to match, Scissors, Straight Pins, Rotary Cutter, Acrylic Ruler, Mat

## Disclaimers

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Directions

1. For one 10 ½" x 10 ½" block from CX3730 fussy cut nine 4 ½ squares. From CX1181 cut two 1" x 4 ½" pieces. Sew to the top and bottom. Cut two pieces 1 ½" x 5 ½" and sew to each side. From CX1065 cut four 3" squares and four 3" x 5 ½" rectangles. From CX3584 Ketchup fussy cut eight 3" squares on point (stripes run diagonally from opposite corners). To make one flying geese unit, place one CX3584 ketchup square right side together with one CX1065 rectangle. Sew diagonally from corner to corner. Press & trim excess from the back.

Repeat for other corner.

Strips should point to the center of the rectangle. Make four flying geese units. Sew one flying geese unit to the top and bottom of the 5 ½" square. Sew one 3" CX1065 square to each end of remaining flying geese units. Sew one strip to each side of the block. Make nine blocks total.

2. For Sashing – from CX1181 cut (16) 2 ½" squares. From CX3584 – White, cut (18) 2 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles. To assemble, begin with one 2 ½" x 10 ½" piece alternate rectangle and three blocks ending with a rectangle. Make three rows of blocks. For sashing strips, begin and end with a CX1181 2 ½" square, sew a rectangle, alternating with a square using three rectangles and four squares. Make four strips.
3. Begin and end with 2 ½" pieced strip. Join the three block rows with pieced strips between them. Match sashing seams row to row.
4. From CX2489 fussy cut two 1 ¼" x 38 ½" strips of one row of polka dots. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Fussy cut two 1 ¼" x 40" strips and sew to each side.
5. From CX3021 fussy cut bias strips following the diagonal line created by the fabric pattern. Piece as needed to make two strips approximately 1 ½" x 40". Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Make two pieces 1 ½" x 42 ½" and sew to each side.
6. From CX3730 cut two lengthwise pieces. Sew to the top and bottom. Cut two lengthwise pieces 4 ½" x 51" and sew to each side.
7. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
8. Quilt as desired.
9. From Jet Black cut binding. Piece as needed. Bind all sides of quilt to finish.
