



## "Grande Alfabeto"

Quilt by Marinda Stewart

Size: Approximately 39"W x 45"H - Skill Level: Confident Beginner

### Materials

*CX4396 Cream Grande Alfabeto	1/2 yard	(4) Vertical 5 1/2" x 15 1/2" (4) Horizontal 5 1/2" x 12 1/2"
CX4395 Multi Blocks Italiano	2/3 yard	(1) Complete Alphabet panel Cut (20) squares as marked
CX4399 Black Numeri Piccoli	1/4 yard	(2) 2" x 25 1/2" (2) 2" x 34 1/2"
CX3137 Retro Play Stripe	3/4 yard	(40) 7/8" x 4 3/4" (40) 7/8" x 5 1/2" (4) 6" squares (4) 5 1/2" squares (4) 1 1/2" squares (5) 2 1/2" x W.O.F. - binding
CX1065 Cherry Garden Pindot	1/2 yard	(25) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" (6) 1 1/2" x 25 1/2" (2) 1" x 28 1/2" (2) 1" x 35 1/2"

<b>Additional Materials:</b> 45" x 50" Backing, 45" x 50" Batting, Thread to match, Straight Pins, Scissors, Acrylic Ruler, Rotary Cutter, and Mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

### Directions

1. Sew one CX3137 4 3/4" piece to the top and bottom of each CX4396 alphabet square. Sew one CX3137 5 1/2" piece to each side of each square. Make (20) total.
2. Keeping the alphabet in order, begin and end with one CX1065 5 1/2" strip, alternate CX1065 strips with four alphabet blocks. Make five rows total.
3. Begin and end with a CX1065 25 1/2" strip, alternate strips with the five alphabet rows. Keep the alphabet in order.
4. Sew one CX4399 25 1/2" piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one CX4399 34 1/2" piece to each side.
5. Sew one CX1065 28 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one CX1065 35 1/2" to each side.
6. Machine applique one CX1065 1 1/2" square to the center of each CX3137 5 1/2" square.
7. Sew one CX4396 12 1/2" horizontal piece to each side of two CX3137 5 1/2" squares. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
8. With right sides together and stripes aligned place two CX3137 6" squares together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" on each side of drawn line. Cut apart. Repeat with remaining two CX3137 6" square. Trim each pieced square to an accurate 5 1/2" square.
9. Sew one CX4396 15 1/2" vertical strip to each side of the 5 1/2" appliqued square. Sew one pieced 5 1/2" square to each end of each strip. Sew strips to the quilt sides.
10. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
11. Quilt as desired.
12. Bind quilt with CX3137 piecing as needed for length.
