2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

1. From CX3076 Lavender Hills, cut one 21-1/2" x 30-1/2" piece, centering the design as desired.
2. From K1163, CM376-Nite and K1165, cut two 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips (WOF) from each color.
3. Take one of each color strips from Step 2 and sew them together lengthwise in the order listed in Step 2, into one 3-strip set. Repeat to make two strip sets total.
4. Cut the two strip sets into thirteen Blue 3-1/2" square blocks total.
5. From K2153, CM376-Loden and K2258, cut one 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips (WOF) from each color.
6. Take color strips from Step 5 and sew them together lengthwise in the order listed in Step 5, into one 3-strip set.
7. Cut the strip set into seven Green 3-1/2" square blocks total.
8. From K1278, CM376 Berry and K2274, cut two 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips (WOF) from each color.
9. Take one strip of each color from Step 8 and sew them together lengthwise in the order listed in Step 8, into one 3-strip set. Repeat to make two strip sets total.
10. Cut the two strip sets into eighteen Purple 3-1/2" square blocks total.
11. To make the left side of the pieced border, refer to the quilt photo and sew together one Blue, three Green and three Purple 3-1/2" square blocks. Alternate the direction of the strips with each block. Sew the left pieced border to the CX3076 panel.
12. To make the right side of the pieced border, refer to the quilt photo and sew together four Green and three Purple 3-1/2" square blocks. Alternate the direction of the strips with each block. Sew the right pieced border to the CX3076 panel.
13. For the top pieced border, sew together twelve Blue squares. Alternate the direction of the strips with each block. Sew the top pieced border to the CX3076 panel.
14. For the bottom pieced border, sew together twelve Purple squares. Alternate the direction of the strips with each block. Sew the bottom pieced border to the CX3076 panel to make the quilt top.
15. From CM376-Gold, cut two 1-1/2" x 27-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips.
16. Sew one 1-1/2" x 27-12" strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
17. From K1277, cut one 4-1/2" x 38-1/2" strip. Sew the strip to the top of the quilt top.
18. From K1277, cut one 3-1/2" x 38-1/2" strip. Sew the strip to the bottom of the quilt top. Set the quilt top aside.
19. For the applique scene, follow the manufacturer's instructions and iron fusible web to the back side of the following:
  - one 4" x 30-1/2" K1163
  - one 4" x 36" K2255
  - one 4" x 12" K1156
  - one 8" square C1081
  - one 3" x 30" K2274
  - one 3" x 12" K1278
  - one 3" x 11" K2258
20. Refer to the quilt photo for the landscape. For the sky, align K1163 with the top and each side of the foundation piece, pin in place. From K2255 and K1156 draw and cut out four different pieces of "hill". Overlap the pieces on top of the sky. The hills need to cover from side to side. Pin the hills in place. Leave approximately 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" of foundation showing on the bottom.

21. Cut away the excess sky from beneath the hills to reduce the bulk.
22. Refer to the quilt photo and from K2274, cut lavender fields accenting with K1278 as shown.
23. When the desired design is complete, remove the paper backing and fuse all the pieces down to the foundation piece.
24. From K2258, cut out thirteen small trees measuring 1" to 1-3/4" tall and 3/8" to 1/2" wide. From CX1087 cut thirteen tree trunks each 1/8" x 1/2". Arrange the trees and trunks on top of the landscape. Fuse the trees and trunks in place.
25. Finish all the raw edges with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.
26. To cut the landscape strip into three sections, cut from each end of the landscape strip one 8-1/2" square. From the center cut one 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece.
27. From CM376-Gold, cut four 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. Join the three landscape pieces back together, beginning and ending with one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" gold strip.
28. From CM376-Gold, cut two 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips. Sew one strip to the top and bottom of the landscape panel.
29. From K1277, cut two 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips. Sew one strip to each side of the landscape panel. From K1277, cut two 4-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips. Sew the strip to the top and bottom of the landscape panel.
30. Sew the Landscape panel to the bottom of the quilt top from Step 18.
31. From K1277, cut three 6-1/2" x width of fabric strips. Piece the strips together into two 6-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips. Sew the strips to each side of the quilt top.
32. From K2255, cut two 4-1/2" x 37" strips. Following the manufacturer's instructions, Back each strip with fusible web.
33. Refer to the quilt photo and cut out one irregular tapered tree from each strip.
34. From CX1087 Marble, cut out two 2" x 5" tree trunks.
35. Refer to the quilt photo and center each tree and trunk on the side of the quilt top. Fuse them in place. Finish the raw edges of the trees and trunks with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.
36. Layer and quilt as desired.
37. From K1277, cut five 2-1/4" strips. Piece the strips together for the binding. Bind as desired.
