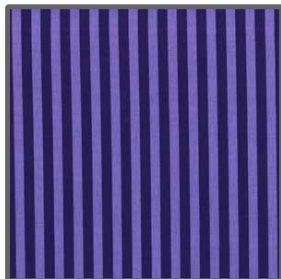

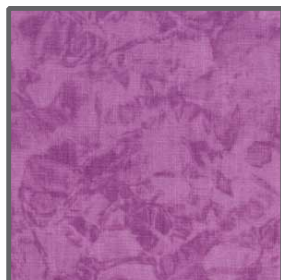

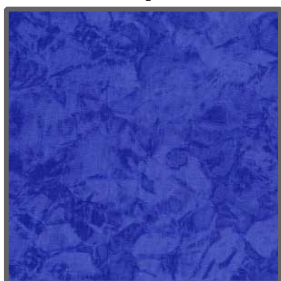

Blossoming Bouquet CX3878 Lilac	1 yard	(24) 6 1/2" squares
Krystal K1072	5/8 yard	(2) 17" squares
Krystal K1175	5/8 yard	(2) 1 3/4" x 33" (2) 1 3/4" x 35 1/2" **(2) 2" x 48 1/2" **(2) 2" x 51 1/2"
Krystal K1173	Fat 1/4 each	(24) Fan Blades

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

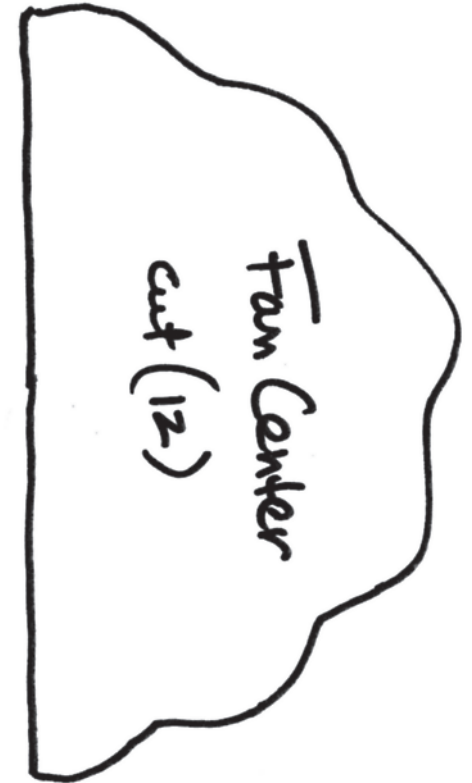
While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

- Sew CX3584 22 1/2" piece to the top and bottom of DC4127 22 1/2" square. Sew one CX3584 23 1/2" piece to each side.
- Cut each 17" K1072 square in half diagonally. Make (4) right angle triangles. Sew one to the top and bottom of the DC4127 panel. Sew one to each side. If necessary, trim to 33" square.
- Turn Iris on point as shown. Sew one K1175 33" piece to the top and bottom. Sew one K1175 35 1/2" piece to each side.
- Sew one CX3584 35 1/2" piece to the top and bottom and one CX3584 36 1/2" piece to each side.
- Piece together one fan blade of each color - K1173, K4262, CX3565, CX1065, CX3877 in a desired sequence. Make (24) fans. Press seams open. Place a fan on one CX3878 6 1/2" square. Machine applique top edge of blades in place. Sew two fan blocks together in pairs. Make (12). Machine applique fan center K4173 over the remaining lower raw edge of the fan blades to finish.
- Sew three fans together in alternating directions. Make four rows. Sew one row to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one DC4127 6 1/2" square to the top and bottom of each remaining fan row. Sew one finished strip to each side of the quilt.

7. Sew one K1175 48 1/2" length to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one K1175 51 1/2" length to each side.
8. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
9. Quilt as desired.
10. Piece CX3584 as needed for bind. Bind all edges to finish.



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
