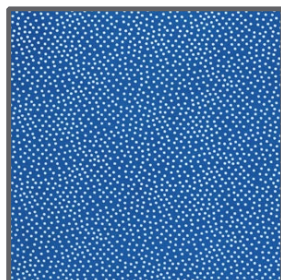

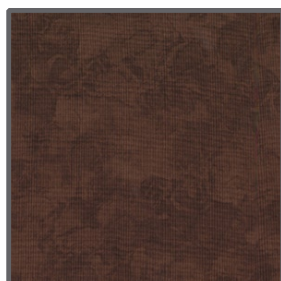

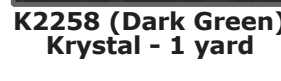

Snow Lake DC4112 Snow	*2/3 yard	Cut (1) 23 1/2" H x 40 1/2" W
Snow Forest DC4115 Snow	Fat 1/4	Cut (10) 4 1/2" Squares
Krystal K1164 (Blue)	Fat 1/8	Cut (10) 2 1/2" Squares
Garden Pindot CX1065 Ocean	1/6 yard	Cut (10) 2 1/2" Squares Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2"
Fairy Frost CM0376 Silver	1/4 yard	Cut (10) 2 1/2" Squares Cut (8) 3" Squares
Serenity Sky CX3586 Blue	1/6 yard	Cut (10) 2 1/2" Squares Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2"
Krystal K4152 (Green)	1/6 yard	Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Cut (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2"
Snow Bunny DC4114 Snow	Fat 1/4	Cut (8) 5 1/2" Squares
Fairy Frost CM0376 Sepia	Fat 1/8	Cut (8) 3" Squares
Krystal K2214 (Brown)	1/4 yard	Cut (8) 3" Squares Cut (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2"
Krystal K1083 (Grey)	1/4 yard	Cut (8) 3" Squares Cut (20) 2 1/2" Squares
Snow Rock DC4113 Snow	1/6 yard	Cut (20) 2 1/2" Squares
Krystal K2258 (Dark Green)	1 yard	Cut (1) 3 1/2" x 40 1/2" Cut (1) 4 1/2" x 40 1/2" **Cut (2) 2 1/2" x 53 1/2" Cut (5) 2 1/2" x W.O.F.

* or amount needed for one complete motif

** pieced as needed to achieve length

Additional Materials: 48" x 57" Backing, 48" x 57" Batting, Threads to match, Straight Pins, Scissors, Acrylic Ruler, Rotary Cutter, and Mat.

Disclaimers

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

- Starting from the top of the quilt. Sew CX3586 2 1/2" strip to the bottom of K2258 3 1/2" strip.
- Sew K2214 1 1/2" strip to the bottom of CX3586 strip.
- For pieced strip - place one CX3586 2 1/2" right sides together on upper left corner of DC4115 4 1/2" square. Draw a diagonal line across corner of CX3586. Stitch on drawn line. Press triangle to the right side. Trim excess fabric from the back. Repeat using CM0376 Silver in upper right corner, K1164 in lower left corner, and CX1065 in lower right corner to make complete block. Make 10 blocks. Sew blocks together to make 40 1/2" strip. Sew to the bottom of the quilt.
- Sew K4152 2 1/2" strip to the bottom of the quilt.
- Sew DC4112 panel to the bottom of the quilt.
- Sew CX1065 2 1/2" strip to the bottom of the quilt.
- For pieced strip repeat step #3 using DC4114 5 1/2" squares and CM0376 Silver in upper left corner, CM0376 Sepia in upper right corner, K2214 in lower left corner, and K1083 lower right corner. Make (8) blocks. Sew blocks into a 40 1/2" strip. Sew strip to the bottom of the quilt.

8. Sew K4152 1 1/2" strip to the bottom of the quilt.
9. Sew K2214 2 1/2" strip to the bottom of the quilt.
10. For checkerboard strip - make two rows of 2 1/2" squares using (10) DC4113 and (10) K1083. Alternate squares. Sew strips together maintaining the checkerboard pattern. Sew to the bottom of the quilt.
11. Sew K2258 4 1/2" strip to the bottom of the quilt.
12. Sew (1) K2258 2 1/2" x 53 1/2" strip to each side.
13. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
14. Quilt as desired.
15. Using K2258 bind quilt to finish.
