CX1505 Picnic Plaid col. Green (includes binding)	1¼ yards
CX2507 Daisy Flowers col. Lime	¼ yard
CX2411 Carrots col. Green, Blue, Pink, Fuschia	7⁄8 yard each
K3055 Krystal, col. Green	⅓ yard
CX2832 Graceful Vine col. Turquoise	⅓ yard
Backing	3 yards
Batting	50" x 60"

Tear away stabilizer and thread for embroideries

5", 6½", and 8½" square rulers or template plastic cut to these sizes

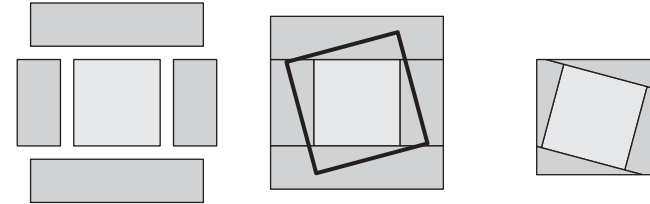
Disclaimers

3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

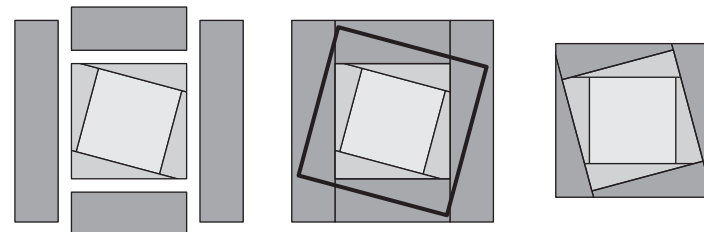
Cutting and Piecing

Blocks are scrappy so fabric color placement is up to you.

1. Embroideries: You will be embroidering six bunny motifs on CX2832 Graceful Vine Turquoise and 6 on Krystal K3055 Green fabrics. Prepare your fabric, stabilizer and embroidery hoop according to your machine manufacturer's directions. Note: the model quilt bunnies were done with 2 layers of stabilizer. The bobbin thread color matched the embroidery thread color. Do a test embroidery, you can always use it as a quilt label later.
Cut a piece of fabric and stabilizer big enough to allow for hooping. After the embroidery is done, "fussy cut" the bunny using the 5" square ruler (or template plastic). Embroider 12 bunnies from the Bunny Parade disc. Be creative! Add in extra carrots or flowers.
2. From one of the CX2411 carrot fabric colors, cut 11 strips 2¾" x width of fabric. Cross-cut each fabric into 12 rectangles each of: 2¾" x 5", 2¾" x 6½", 2¾" x 9½", and 2¾" x 11".
3. Stitch 5" strips to the sides of the embroidered squares, then stitch the 9½" strips to the top and bottom. Make 9. Tip the 6½" ruler at an angle to cut these squares. Tip the ruler to the left for the blue blocks and to the right for the green blocks.



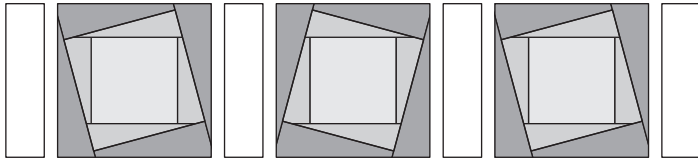
4. Stitch the 6½" strips to the top and bottom of the blocks and the 11" strips to each side. Tip the 8½" ruler at an angle to cut these squares. Tip the ruler to the right for the blue blocks and to the left for the green blocks.



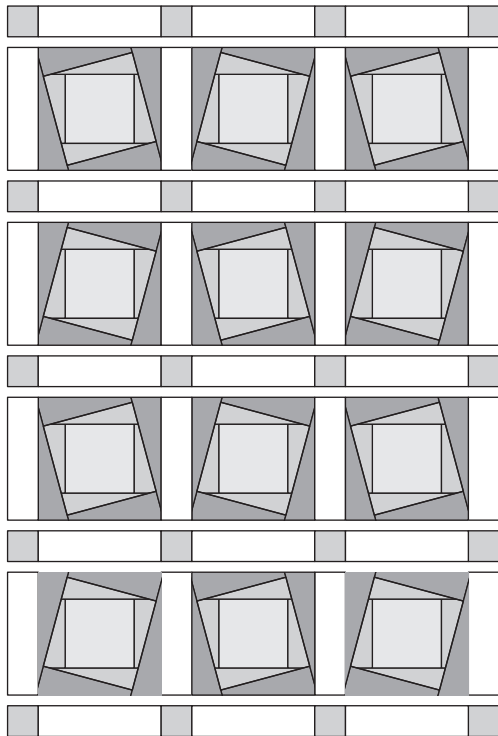
- From the CX1505 plaid fabric, cut 8 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric. Cross-cut into 31 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " for sashing.
- From CX2507 daisy fabric cut 1 strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric. Cross-cut into 15 squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " for cornerstones.
- Stitch 5 rows with 4 daisy squares and 3 plaid rectangles. Press seams toward rectangles.



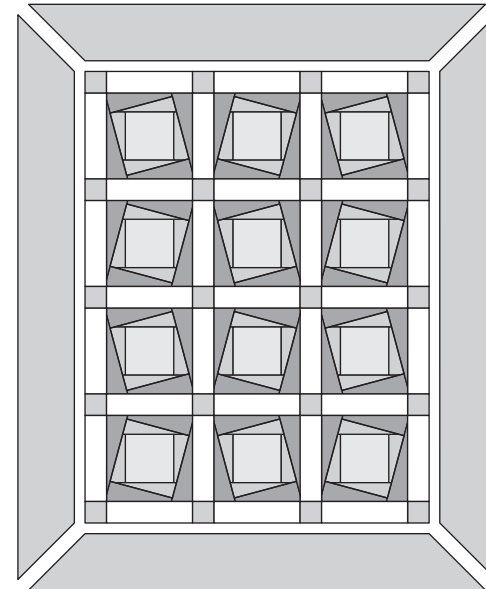
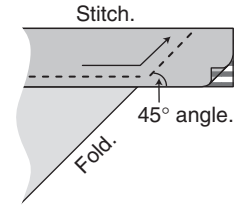
- Refer to the photo for placement of the blocks, if desired. Sew 4 rows of rectangles and blocks. Press seams toward sashes. Use blocks that tilt to the left and to the right in each row.



- Sew rows together.



- From CX2409 Bunny stripe, cut 4 strips $5\frac{3}{4}$ " wide and LENGTHWISE of fabric. Center the sky/grass row of the bunny stripe motif in the $5\frac{3}{4}$ " width. Refer to quilt photo, if necessary. Cut 2 strips $5\frac{3}{4}$ " x 55" for the side borders, and 2 strips $5\frac{3}{4}$ " x 44" for the top and bottom.
- The Bunny stripe borders are stitched with mitered corners. Measure the quilt top lengthwise and widthwise. Place a pin at the center of quilt top and the center of each side strip, and each top and bottom strips. Also place pins in the border strips that are the length and width of the top, having the pins equal distance from the center pin. Stitch strips to sides, top and bottom, starting and stopping stitching $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edges. Miter strips by folding the block at a 45° angle, layering strips right sides together and stitching at a 45° angle from outside edge to inside corner. Trim excess fabric.



- Layer and quilt as desired. The model quilt was quilted "in the ditch" around the bunny square, each full block and around the outer edge of the sash/cornestone. An invisible nylon thread was used to quilt around the bunnies in the outer border.
- The binding on the model quilt was cut on the bias from the plaid fabric. Cut binding strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. You will need approximately 200" of continuous binding.
