Disclaimers

1. This pattern is provided as a courtesy to quilt stores, catalogs and quilters. Michael Miller Fabrics, LLC is not responsible for the accuracy of any kits packaged to accompany this pattern. Please direct any inquiries to the kit maker.
2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

1. Trace the listed number of the templates onto the paper side of the fusible web and roughly cut out each shape. Make sure to label each piece from the templates.
2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, iron each shape to the back side of the listed fabric on the templates.
3. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse a piece of fusible web to the back side of the 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" CM376 Natural, cut the piece into six 1-1/4" x 3-1/2" pieces for the candles.
4. From CX3030, cut one 26-1/2" square. Fold the square in half vertically and press to mark the center line.
5. To construct the center of the chandelier, start with Piece A, position it 1-1/4" down from the top of the 26-1/2" square on the pressed center line. Add the following pieces in the order listed below along the fold. Use the quilt photo as reference, once you like your layout, fuse the pieces in place.
 - Piece A
 - Piece B
 - Piece C
 - Piece D
 - Piece E
 - Piece F (place one piece I inside)
 - Piece E
 - Piece D
 - Piece G
 - Piece C
 - Piece D
 - Piece C
 - Piece C
 - Piece H
6. Using the quilt photo as reference, with a fabric pencil free hand draw one short, one medium and one long chandelier arm on each side of the center.
7. Place the Quick Bias Tape over the drawn lines. Fuse the tape in place.
8. Using the quilt photo as reference, draw in place the small curves that come off each chandelier arm and fuse Quick Bias Tape over the drawn lines.
9. To cover the raw edges of each small curve piece, fuse one Piece C over the end.
10. To cover the raw edge of each chandelier arm, fuse one candle cup over the end.
11. Machine stitch the Quick Bias Tape in place. Finish the raw edges of the chandelier with a decorative stitch such as a satin or blanket stitch.
12. Add one candle and flame to each candle cup. Fuse in place and finish the raw edges with a decorative stitch such as a satin or blanket stitch.
13. From CX3032, fussy cut two 1-1/2" x 26-1/2" strips, make sure to center the chairs in the middle of each strip and the chairs run up and down for the side borders. Sew the side borders to the quilt top. Cut two 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" strips, make sure the chairs in the middle of the strip and run lengthwise for the top and bottom borders. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
14. From CX2857 Cut two 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" strips and sew them to each side of the quilt top. Cut two 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips and sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

15. From CX3044, cut two vertical strips 2-1/2" x 30-1/2". Make sure to center the 2-1/2" over the diamond which measures 2" and leaves a 1/4" on either side of the diamond. Sew the strips to each side of the quilt top.
16. From CX3044, cut two horizontal strips 2-1/2" x 34-1/2". Make sure to center the 2-1/2" over the diamond which measures 2" and leaves a 1/4" on either side of the diamond. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
17. From CX2860, cut two 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips. Sew the strips to each side of the quilt top.
18. From CX2860, cut two 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
19. From CX3040, cut two vertical strips 7-1/2" x 36-1/2". Sew the strips to each side of the quilt top.
20. From CX3040, cut two horizontal strips 7-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
21. Layer and quilt as desired.
22. From CX2857, cut five 2-1/4" x width of fabric strips. Piece the strips together for the binding. Bind the quilt.
23. Sew the white tassel to the bottom center of the Chandelier.
24. Follow the manufacturer's instructions and refer to the quilt photo for placement to iron the "Hot Fix Crystals" to the Chandelier.
25. Cut 3/8 yard of round fused pearls in half. Refer to the quilt photo for placement and sew each end to the middle arms of the chandelier.
26. Cut the fused teardrop pearls into four 9" pieces. Sew one piece between the two top arms as shown. Sew the remaining three pieces to the bottom arms as shown.
27. Sew the two 1-1/4" teardrop crystals to each side of the pearls on the middle arms.
28. Sew remaining large acrylic crystals throughout the center core of the chandelier.
