

## Ferns

Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Finished quilt size approximately 50" x 50"

### Fabric Requirements:

1-1/8 yards of CX2860 Lime

3/8 yard of CX3197 Kiwi

3/4 yard of CX3095 Pistachio

12" square of CX2832 Kiwi

5/8 yard of CX3195 Pistachio

1/2 yard of CX3095 Meadow

Fat Quarter of CX2490 Apple

Fat Quarter of CX3095 Avocado

1/8 yard of CX2490 Avocado

1/8 yard of CX3197 Grass

Fat Eighth of CX2861 Lime

9" x 14" piece of CX2490 Kiwi

4" x 12" piece of CX2781 Kiwi

56" squares for backing

56" square piece of batting

Acrylic ruler, mat and rotary cutter

100% cotton threads to match

Basic sewing supplies

Fusible Web

### Cutting Instructions:

Cut one 38-1/2" square.

Cut four 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips. Cut three 1-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece them together into two 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips.

Cut four 5-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips.

Cut four 5-1/2" squares.

Cut five 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Piece them together for the binding. See directions to create the Stems.

2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

### Assembly Instructions:

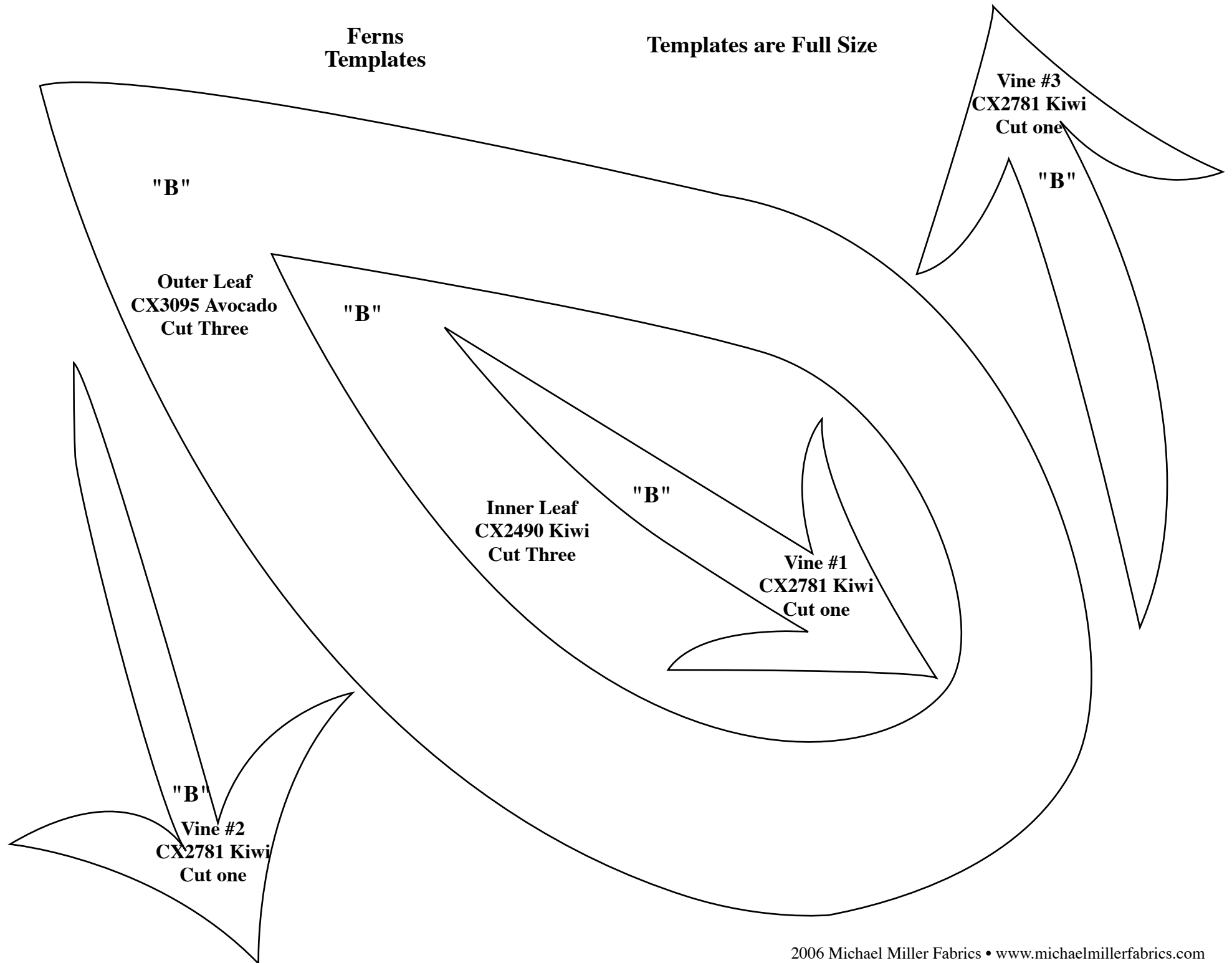
1. Sew one 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" CX3197 Kiwi strip to the top and bottom of the 38-1/2" CX2860 Lime square to make the quilt top.
2. Sew one 5-1/2" x 38-1/2" CX3095 Pistachio strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
3. Sew one 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" CX3197 Kiwi strip to each side of the quilt top.
4. Sew one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" CX3197 Kiwi strip to each end of the remaining two 5-1/2" x 38-1/2" CX3095 Pistachio strips. Sew one 5-1/2" CX2832 Kiwi square to each end of the CX3197 strip to make each Side Outer Border.
5. Sew the Side Outer Border to the quilt top to complete the quilt top background.
6. **To make the Stems:** Following the manufacturer's instructions, iron fusible web onto the wrong side of the remaining yardage of CX3195 Pistachio. Cut the fabric in the bias into 3/4" wide strips for the large stems and 3/8" strips for the small stems.
7. Following the quilt photo, arrange each stem to the quilt top background and iron in place. Finish the raw edges with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.

### Applique Instructions:

8. Trace A-1 and A-3 templates onto fusible web. Roughly cut out each leaf and iron onto the wrong side of CX3095 Meadow. Cut out each shape. Refer to the quilt photo and press in place onto the background.
9. Trace A-2 and A-4 templates on fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape and press onto the wrong side of CX2490 Apple. Cut out each shape. Refer to the quilt photo and place them on top of the large leaves for veins, press in place.
10. Finish the raw edges on the leaves with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.
11. Repeat Steps 8-10 for the "B" Leaf templates. Use CX3095 Avocado for the Outer Leaf. Use CX2490 Kiwi for the Inner Leaf. Use CX2781 for the veins.
12. Repeat Steps 8-10 for the "C" leaves. Make thirty-eight Large leaves using CX2490 Avocado and CX3197 Grass. Make thirty-three Medium Leaves using CX2490 Avocado, CX3197 Grass and CX2861 Lime. make sixteen Small Leaves using CX2861 Lime and CX3197 Grass.
13. Refer to the quilt photo for placement and arrange the leaves along the Fern Stems, graduating the leaves from largest to smallest at the tip of the stem.
14. Repeat Steps 8-10 for the "D" leaves using CX3095 Meadow for the leaves and CX2781 for the Vines. Make four "D" leaves total. Iron one leaf in each Outer Border Cornerstone.
15. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

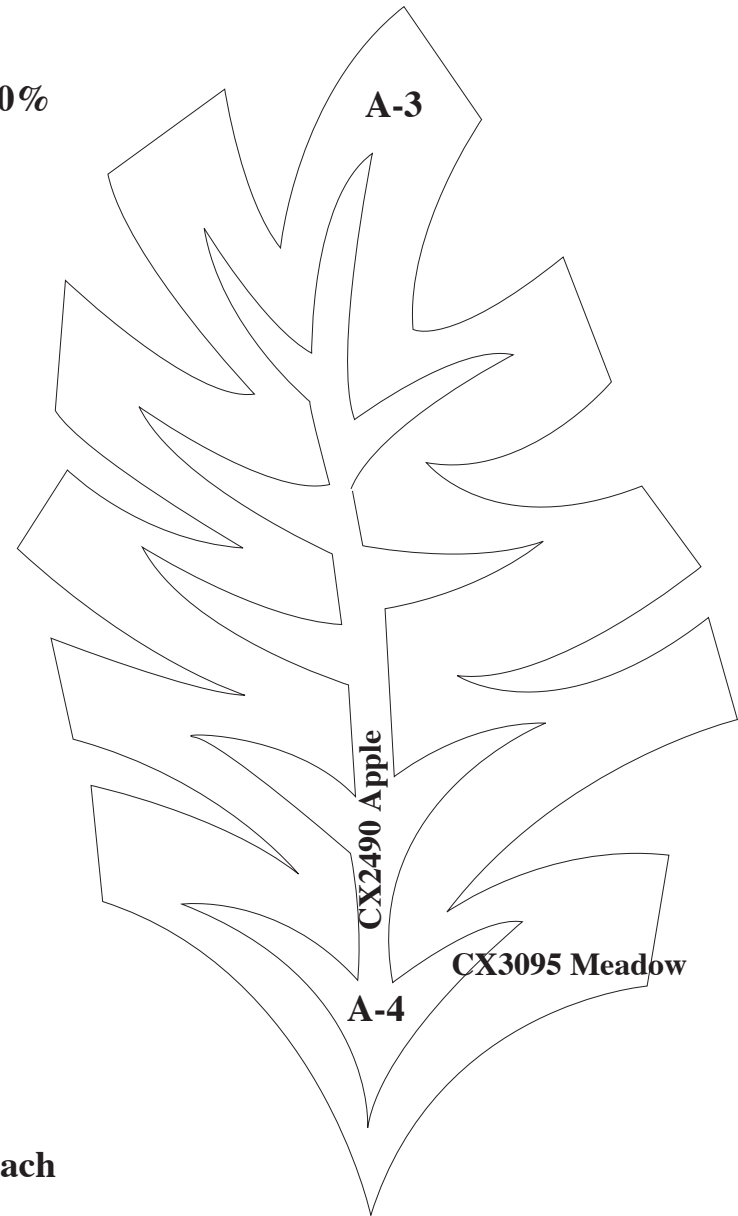
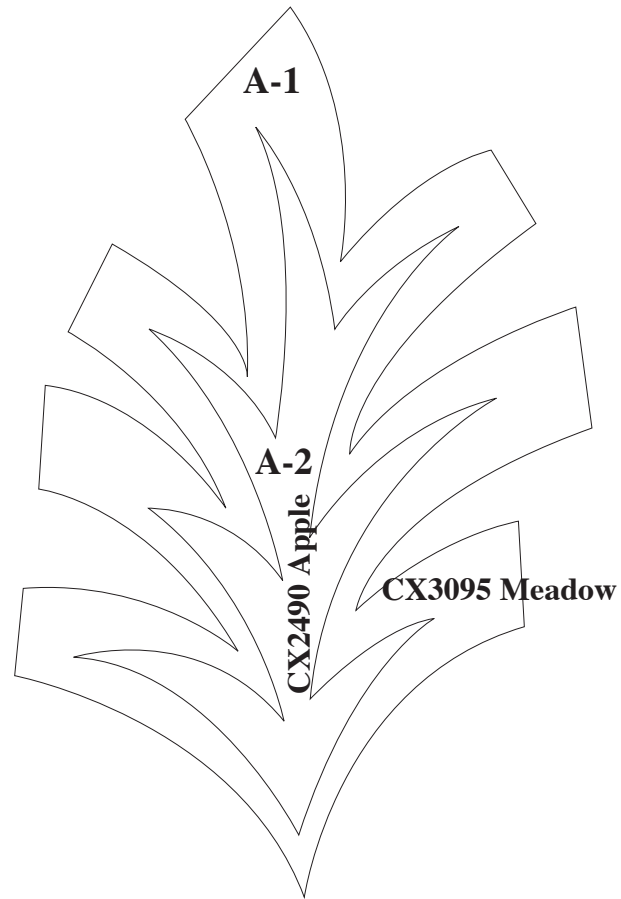

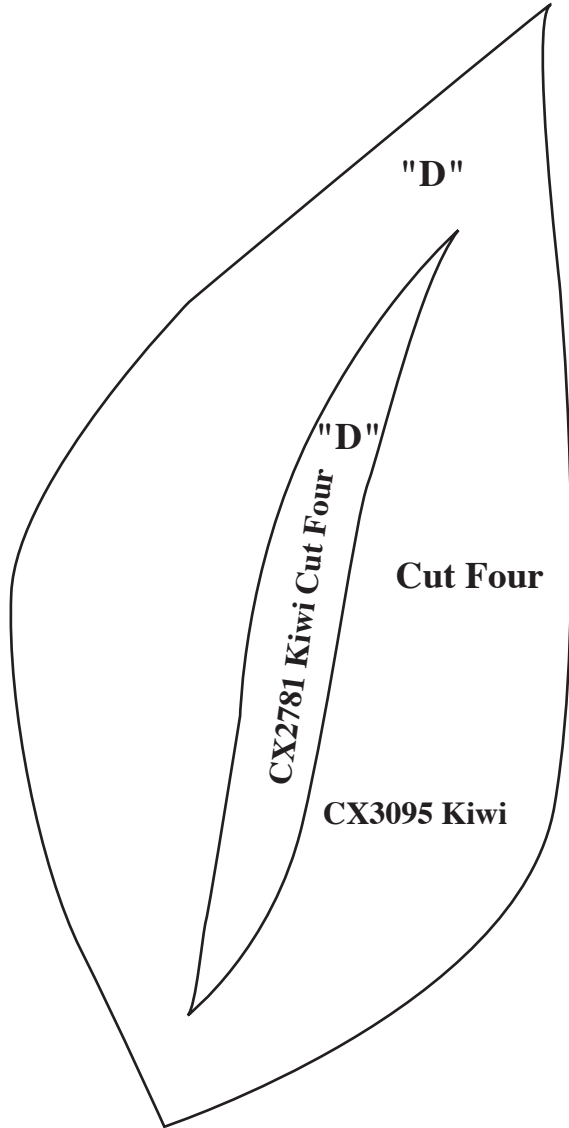
