CX2879 Seeds col. Olive (includes binding)	1½ yards
CX2853 Jessica's Garden col. Black	⅝ yard
CX2678 Sophisticated Paisley col. Gold	½ yard
CX2678 Sophisticated Paisley col. Red	½ yard
CX2854 Jessica's Bouquet col. Red	½ yard
CX2854 Jessica's Bouquet col. Tan	½ yard
CX2879 Seeds col. Red	½ yard
CX2801 Scroll Swirls col. Cream	½ yard
CM2822 Gold Tiles col. Black	⅝ yard
CX2678 Sophisticated Paisley col. Mustard	¼ yard
Template plastic, optional	
Acrylic ruler with 45° lines	
Backing	3 yards
Batting	60" x 60"
Fusible web enough to cover CX2853 Jessica's Garden fabric

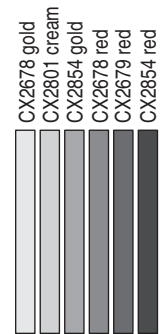

2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

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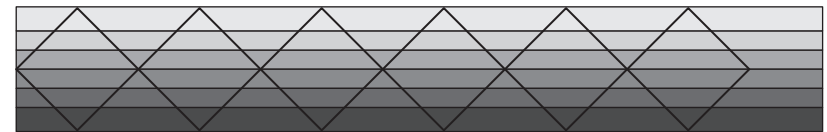
Directions

1. Cut 11 strips 1½" x width of fabric from each of the following: CX2678 Sophisticated Paisley red, gold; CX2854 Jessica's Bouquet red, tan; CX2879 Seeds red; CX2801 Scroll Swirls cream.

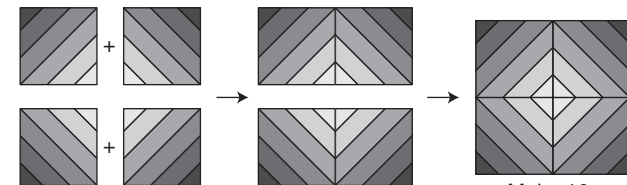
Stitch strips together into sets in the following sequence left to right: CX2678 gold, CX2801 cream, CX2854 tan, CX2678 red, CX2879 red, CX2854 red. Make 11 strip sets.



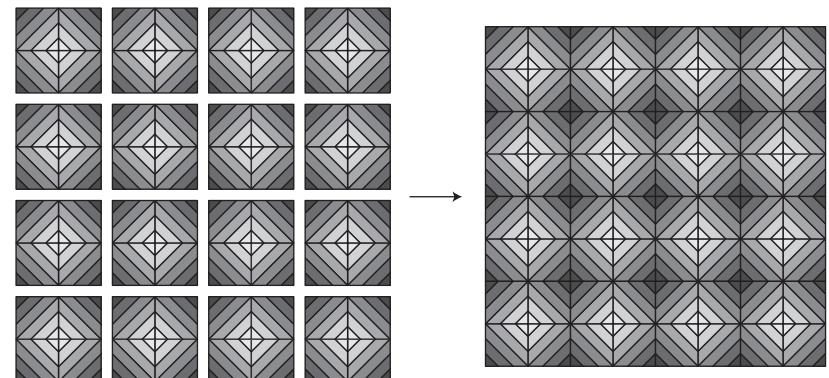
2. Cut a template 4½" x 4½" or use your ruler at a 45° angle. Cut 64 squares 4½" x 4½" on the diagonal from the strip sets. You will get 6 cuts from each strip set.



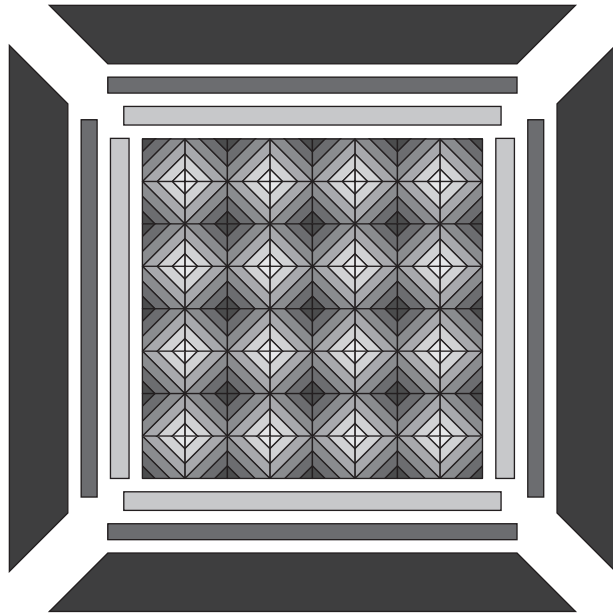
3. Stitch 4 squares together with the tan placed in the center of the squares. Make 16 larger squares. Handle blocks with care as all edges are on the bias.



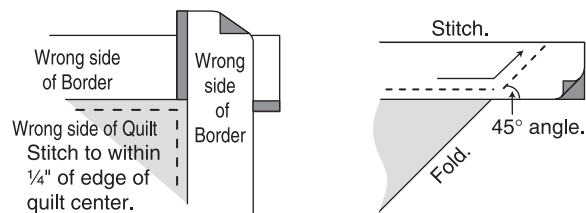
4. Sew blocks together into 4 rows of 4 blocks each, then sew the rows together to complete the quilt center. The center will measure approximately 32½" x 32½".



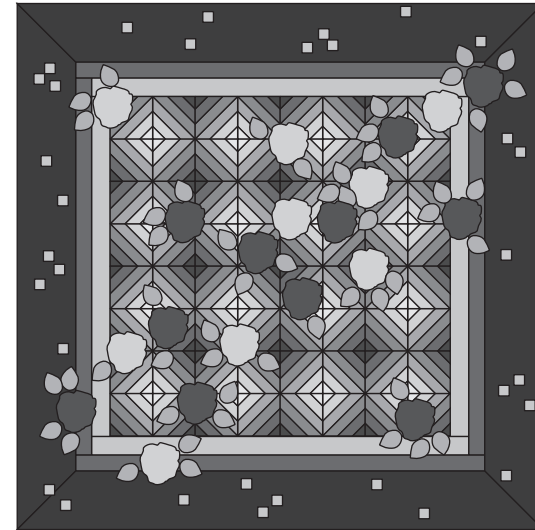
5. From CM2822 Gold Tiles black, fussy-cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ ", with 2 rows of tiles centered in the strips. Stitch strips to each side of the quilt center. Repeat and cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 36" and stitch to the top and bottom.
6. From CX2678 Sophisticated Paisley mustard, cut 2 strips 2" x 36" and stitch to the sides of the quilt. Cut 2 strips 2" x 39" and stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt.
7. From CX2879 Seeds olive, cut 4 strips LENGTHWISE of fabric 6" x 50". Center strips on each side of the quilt and stitch. Miter corners.



Miter corners by folding square in half diagonally, lining up the strips and stitching at a 45° angle from corner to outside of strips. Trim excess fabric from underneath strips.



8. Following manufacturer's directions, iron fusible web to CX2853 Jessica's Garden black. Fussy-cut roses and leaves. The quilt pictured on the cover has 21 roses - you may want to cut more or less for your quilt. Peel away paper and fuse to the quilt as shown or as you desire. Satin stitch raw edges of roses and leaves to finish.



9. Iron fusible web to the scraps of CM2822 Gold Tiles black. Cut the tiles apart and randomly scatter them around the border. Satin stitch the raw edges to finish.
10. Cut binding strips from the remaining CX2879 Seeds olive. Cut strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. Make one continuous length of binding, press in half lengthwise and stitch to the quilt top. Turn to back and hand or machine stitch in place.
