Finished Quilt approximately 47½" x 68½"

CX2832 Graceful Vine col. Lime, Sky	½ yard each
CX2824 Woodland Squares col. Cream (You will need 4 toads, 4 rabbits and 2 sections with 5 critters. Refer to photo for sections used.)	at least ¾ yard
CX2787 Woodland Flowers col. Cream	¼ yard
CX2790 Woodland Berries col. Cream	⅓ yard
CX2784 Woodland Font col. Cream (The yardage must include two complete alphabet strips.)	at least ⅓ yard
CX2785 Woodland Stripe col. Cream	1¾ yards
CX2833 Basketweave col. Tan	¾ yard
CX2786 Woodland Leaves col. Yellow, Blue, Red	¼ yard each
CX2788 Woodland Critters col. Cream (You need enough yardage so you have rabbit motifs as shown in the quilt.)	at least ⅓ yard
Krystal 2214 Dark brown (for binding)	¾ yard
Backing	3 yards
Batting	60" x 60"

2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

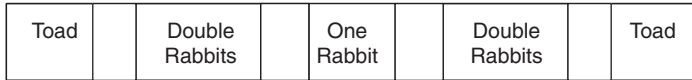
1. From CX2784 Woodland Font, cut 2 strips 3¼" x 36½", with the font centered in the strip width. The quilt shown has a strip with A-B-C and G-H-I. You may choose different strips of letters.
2. From each CX2832 Graceful Vine sky and lime, cut 7 strips 2" x 36½". Piece strips together along the short ends at a 45° angle alternating the slant of the angle right or left depending on the strip. Sky on the left, angle slants left to right. Lime on the left, angle slants right to left. Refer to the photo and trim strips to 36½" wide.

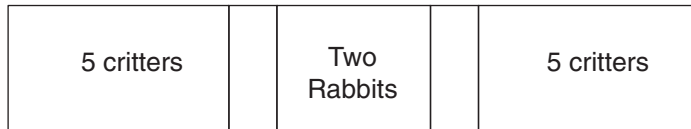

3. From CX2785 Woodland Stripe, cut the strips with the critters and the toad stools along the outside edge of the blue line, cutting lengthwise. You will use 2 wider strips (with critters) and 1 narrower strip (with toad stools) and 4 strips of the flower vine.

Trim the strips with critters and toad stools to 36½". Trim 2 strips of the flower vine to 36½" and 2 strips 57½".
4. From each CX2786 Woodland Leaves yellow and blue, cut 1 strip 2" x 36½", 2 rectangles 2¾" x 4½", and 2 rectangles 3" x 4½".
5. From CX2786 Woodland Leaves red, cut 1 strip 2" x 36½" and 2 rectangles 3" x 7".
6. From CX2788 Woodland Critters, cut 2 rabbit motifs 8½" x 7", centering the rabbit and 1 rabbit motif 8½" x 7". Refer to photo for motifs used in the quilt.
7. From CX2824 Woodland Squares, center all motifs within the cutting dimensions. Refer to photo for exact motifs used. Cut 4 toad motifs 5" x 4½", 4 double rabbit motifs 7" x 4½", and 2 motifs with 5 critters 12" x 7".
8. From CX2833 Basketweave, cut 12 strips 2" x width of fabric. Trim 4 strips to 36½". From the remaining strips, piece 2 strips together along the short ends. Repeat for remaining strips to make 4 strips 57½" long.
9. From CX2797 Woodland Flowers, cut 4 squares 6¼" x 6¼".
10. From CX2790 Woodland Berries, cut 2 strips 4½" x 36½".
11. From Krystal, cut 9 strips 2½" wide for binding. Stitch binding strips together to get 240" of continuous binding.

10. Following the diagram and the photo, piece rows with toads and rabbits. One row (at the top) is pieced with yellow leaves and one row (at the bottom) is pieced with blue leaves.



11. Following the diagram and the photo, piece the row with red leaves, the 5 critter motifs and 2 two rabbits motif.



12. Stitch all rows together following the placement shown in the diagram.
13. Stitch the flower vine between the strips of basketweave, making 2 strips 36½" long and 2 strips 57½" long. Stitch the 6¼" squares to each end of the 57½" strips
14. Lay out each row of the quilt following the diagram to the right or refer to the photo. Stitch rows together, then stitch the side borders to the quilt. The top and bottom borders are the top and bottom rows.
15. Layer, quilt, and bind. Bind with dark brown Krystal strips.
