Fabric Requirements

1-1/2 yd CX3258 Nesting Time-Green

1/4 yd each:

K1156 Krystal

CX3163 Dinky Diamonds-Teal

CX3101 Slub Stripe-Cinnamon

CX3060 Waterspot-Stone

54" x 54" CX3023 Fiber Stripe-Cocoa for backing

1/2 yd K2269 Krystal for binding

7/8 yd K2269 Krystal

K2258 Krystal

CX3023 Fiber Stripe-Cocoa

K2255 Krystal

CX3060 Waterspot-Bark

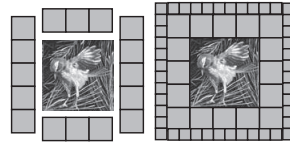
54" x 54" thin cotton batting

Cutting

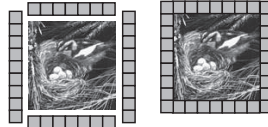
- Using CX3258 Nesting Time, center each square over a bird motif and fussy cut the following: (3) 6-1/2" squares, (2) 7-1/2" squares, (1) 9-1/2" square, (2) 10-1/2" squares, (1) 12-1/2" square. Save the remnants for the background piecing.
- From each of the ten fabrics cut (5) 2-1/2" squares for a total of 50 squares.
- From each of the ten fabrics cut (26) 1-1/2" squares for a total of 260 squares.
- From each of the ten fabrics cut (38) 2" squares for a total of 380 pieces.

Sewing

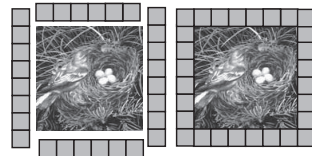
5. Sew two rows of (3) 2-1/2" squares. Sew one row to the top and one row to the bottom of one 6-1/2" bird motif square. Repeat for the two remaining 6-1/2" squares. Sew two more rows of 5 squares together and sew to the sides of the bird motif square to make a 10-1/2" block. Make 3 blocks.



6. For the 7-1/2" bird motif sew two rows of (7) 1-1/2" squares. Sew to the top and bottom of the bird motif square. Sew two rows of (9) 1-1/2" squares and sew to the sides of the bird motif square to make a 9-1/2" block. Make 2 blocks.



7. For the 9-1/2" bird motif square sew two rows of (6) 2" squares for the top and bottom of the square. Sew two rows of (8) 2" squares for the sides of the square to make a 12-1/2" block. Make 1 block.

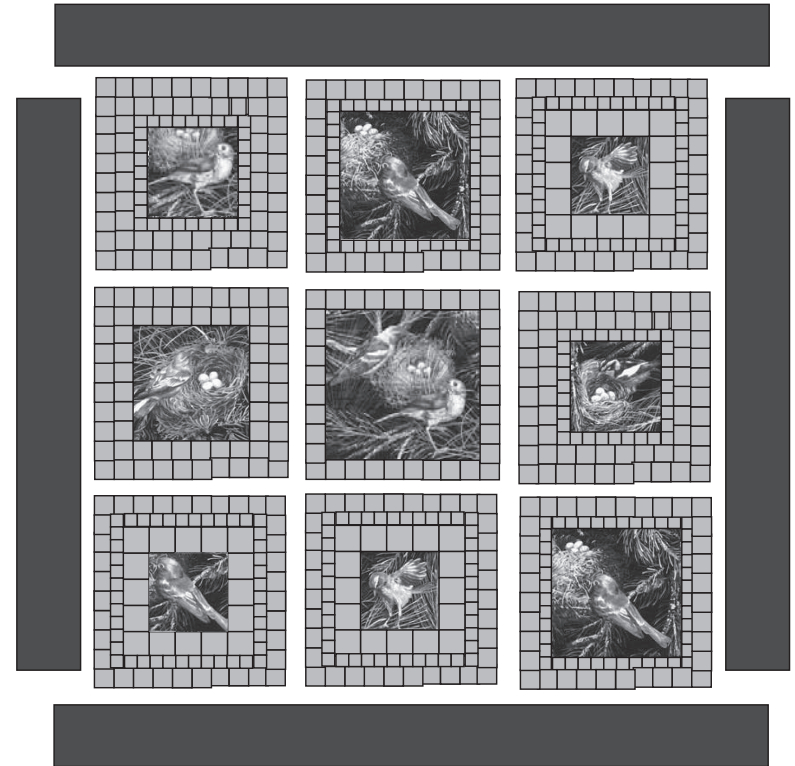


8. For the 10-1/2" bird motif squares sew two rows of (10) 1-1/2" squares for the top and bottom of the square. Sew two rows of (12) 1-1/2" squares and sew to the sides of the bird motif square to make a 12-1/2" block. Make 2.



9. All of the blocks should measure 12-1/2" including the seam allowances. The 12-1/2" fussy cut square will be the center block in the quilt. Each block will be bordered with 2" squares to increase the size to 15-1/2". Sew eighteen strips of (8) 2" squares. Sew one of these strips to each side of the 8 blocks and the fussy cut center square. Sew eighteen strips of (10) 2" squares and sew to the top and bottom of each of the 8 blocks and the fussy cut center square. All of the blocks should measure 15-1/2" including the seam allowances.

10. The quilt is sewn together in 3 rows with 3 blocks in each row. Sew the blocks into rows and the rows into the quilt top. Place the large fussy cut square in the center of the quilt.



Borders

11. Cut two vertical borders 3" x 45-1/2" and two horizontal borders 3" x 54-1/2" from the K2258 Dark Navy Krystal fabric. Sew the vertical borders to opposite sides of the quilt and the horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

12. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt the layers together. Cut 5 binding strips 2-1/4" from the K2258 Dark Navy Krystal fabric to bind the outside edges.
