Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Quilt measures approximately 50" x 50"

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
CX3388 Black	2/3 yard	Fussy cut one 15-1/2" square from the large packed flowers. Cut four 4-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips.
CX3060 Sunset	1/3 yard	Cut twelve 3-7/8" squares.
CX3060 Lava	5/8 yard	Cut two 1-1/2" x 29-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 31-1/2" strips. Cut five 2-1/4" x width of fabric (WOF) strips for Binding.
CX3060 Moss	1/4 yard	Cut two 1" x 31-1/2" strips and two 1" x 32-1/2" strips. See instructions to cut four leaves.
CX3182 Orange	3/4 yard	Cut two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together into two 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips. Cut two 4-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips.
CX3187 Tangerine	5/8 yard	Cut thirty-six 4-1/2" squares.
CX0274 Pink	3/8 yard	Cut thirty-six 2-1/2" squares.
CX0274 Purple	1/4 yard	Cut four 4-1/2" squares.
CX0274 Orange	3/8 yard	Cut thirty-six 2-1/2" squares.
CX0274 Yellow	1/2 yard	Cut twelve 3-7/8" squares. Cut two 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2".
CX3184 Flame	3/8 yard	Cut thirty-six 2-1/2" squares.
CX3184 Orange	3/8 yard	Cut thirty-six 2-1/2" squares.

You will also need:

55" X 55" backing
55" X 55" batting
Fusible Web
Threads to match, including black.
Scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, mat, rotary cutter
Chalk Pencil (optional)

- Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
- While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and or sewing. the enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Assembly Instructions

- 01) Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace four leaf templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape 1/4" outside the drawn line.
- 02) Press the fusible templates to the back side of CX3060 Moss. Cut out each leaf on the drawn line.
- 03) Press each leaf to the center of 4-1/2" CX0274 Purple square.
- 04) Finish the raw edges of each leaf with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch. Set aside the blocks.
- 05) Place one 3-7/8" CX3060 Sunset square on top of one 3-7/8" CX0274 Yellow square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line through the center of the top block (Fig. 1).
- 06) Sew 1/4" away from the drawn diagonal line on each side (Fig. 2).
- 07) Cut the squares across the drawn diagonal line to make two half-square triangles (Fig. 3). Repeat to make twenty-four half-square triangles (fig. 4).
- 08) Refer to the quilt photo and sew together five half-square triangles for the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border.
- 09) Sew the top and bottom borders to the 15-1/2" CX3388 Black square.
- 10) Sew together seven half-square triangles for each side border.
- 11) Sew the side borders to the 15-1/2" CX3388 Black square to make the quilt top.
- 12) Sew one 4-1/2" x 21-1/2" CX3388 Black strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 13) Sew one 4-1/2" purple leaf square from Step 1 to each of the remaining two 4-1/2" x 21-1/2" CX3388 Black strip.
- 14) Sew one border to each side of the quilt top.

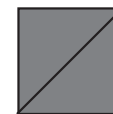

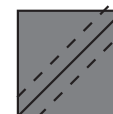

Assembly Instructions

- 15) Align one 2-1/2" CX3184 Flame square with one corner of the 4-1/2" CX3187 Tangerine square. Draw a line and sew across the diagonal of the smaller square (fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed to check that the edges are aligned (fig. 6). Press the triangle open and trim the excess fabric away leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
- 16) Repeat Step 15 with the remaining three corners and one 2-1/2" CX3184 Orange square, one 2-1/2" CX0274 Orange square and one 2-1/2" CX0274 pink square for each corner following Figure 7 for fabric placement and diagonal direction for each corner to complete one square-in-a-square block
- 17) Repeat Step 15 and 16 to make thirty-six square-in-a-square blocks.
- 18) Sew together eight square-in-a-square blocks to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border.
- 19) Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt top.
- 20) Sew together ten square-in-a-square blocks to make one side border. Repeat to make a second side border.
- 21) Sew the borders to the quilt top.
- 22) Sew one 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" CX0274 Yellow strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" CX0274 Yellow strip to the sides of the quilt top.
- 23) Sew one 4-1/2" x 42-1/2" CX3182 Orange strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" CX3182 Orange strip to each side of the quilt top.

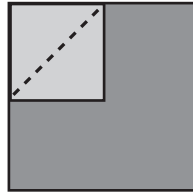

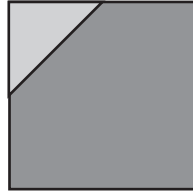

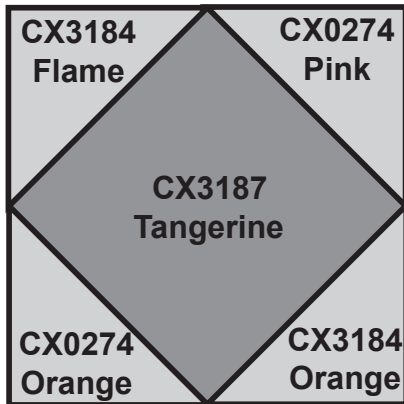
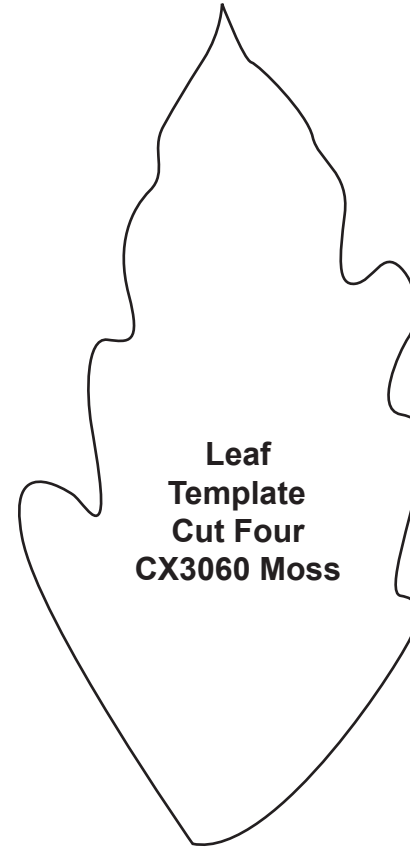
