Finished Quilt approximately 50" x 50"

## Fabric Requirements

Fat Quarters for blocks:

CX3194 Stripe Illusion Lime

CX3194 Stripe Illusion Teal

CX3182 Beatnik Daisy Teal

CX3180 Daisy Daze Jade

CX3186 Daisy Drama Teal

CX3197 Peggy Paisley Pistachio

CX3197 Peggy Paisley Marine

CX3181 Posey Paisley Brown

CX3187 Hoodies Garden Lime

1-1/2 yards - borders/blocks

CX3102 Pixel Square Teal

1 yard for sashings

1055 Krystal Pale Lime

1 yard for sashings

CX3183 Beatnik Stripe Teal

1/2 yard for binding

CX 3185 Beatnik Vibe Teal

2 yards for backing

## Cutting

(4) strips 6" x length of fabric CX3187 Hoodies Garden - Lime

(9) 3-1/2" squares from each fat quarter and CX3187 Hoodies Garden - Lime

(4) 2-1/4" squares from CX3197 Peggy Paisley - Marine

(6) 3-1/2" x width of fabric strips from 1055 Krystal - Pale Lime

re-cut 3 strips at 2-1/4" intervals for 54 short block sashings

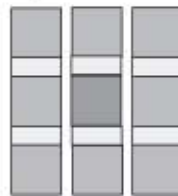
(11) 2-1/4" x width of fabric strips from CX3102 Pixel Square - Teal

re-cut 4 strips at 12" intervals for 12 short sashing strips

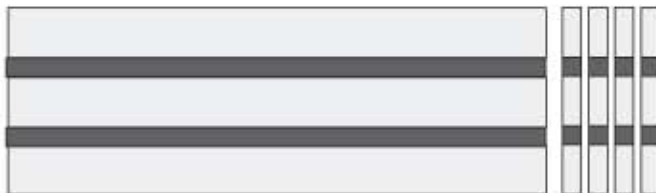
(6) strips 2-1/4" x width of fabric stripe CX3185 Beatnik Stripe - Teal

## Sewing

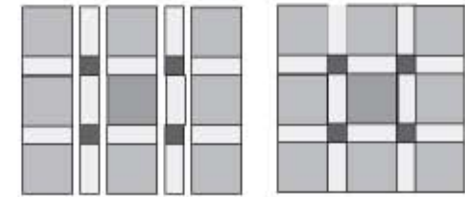
1. Using 9 different prints for each block and the short lime green sashing strips sew 3 rows of print squares and lime sashings for each of the 9 blocks. The center square is Beatnik Daisy teal. The other squares are sewed in random positions to give a scrappy look.



2. Sew 3 pale lime width of fabric strips alternating with 2 pixel square strips together. Re-cut at 2-1/4" intervals for 18 block sashing strips.



3. Using block row units and sashing units sew the blocks together. Make 9 blocks.  
Finished block size: 11-1/2"



4. Sew 3 blocks and 2 short sashing strips into a row. Make 3 rows.  
5. Sew 2 rows of Pixel Square sashing strips using 3 short sashings and 2 Peggy Paisley squares for each sashing row.



6. Alternate the 3 block rows and the 2 sashing rows to sew the quilt together.

7. Sew the remaining Pixel Square sashing strips into one long strip. Cut 2 strips 37-1/2" long and sew to opposite sides of the quilt.

Cut 2 strips 40" long and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

6. Cut 2 of the Hoodies Garden strips 40" long and sew to opposite sides of the quilt top. Cut 2 remaining strips 50-1/2" long and sew to top and bottom of the quilt top.

7. Cut large backing piece 54" long x width of fabric. Cut remaining half yard of backing into 3 pieces 13-1/2" wide and sew into a long strip. Sew this strip to large backing piece to make backing fabric.

8. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, then quilt layers together.

9. Bind the outside edges using the Beatnik Stripe fabric strips.
