

Escape

Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Finished quilt size approximately 50" x 50"

Fabric Requirements:

3/8 yard of CX2898 Watermelon
(enough for four motifs)

1/4 yard of CX2490 Aqua

3/8 yard of CX3196 Watermelon

1/2 yard of CX2860 Lime

1/8 yard of CX2650 Turquoise

3/8 yard of CX3197 Candy

5/8 yard of CX3195 Spa

7/8 yard of CX3199 Watermelon

56" squares for backing

56" square piece of batting

Acrylic ruler, mat and rotary cutter

100% cotton thread

Basic sewing supplies

Cutting Instructions:

Fussy Cut four motifs 10" square
center a design in each square.

Cut eight 1-1/2" x 12" and eight
1-1/2" x 10" strips

Cut eight 1-3/4" x 14-1/2" and
1-3/4" x 12" strips.

Cut twelve 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips.

Cut nine 2-1/2" squares.

Cut two 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips and
two 2-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips.

Cut two 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" and two
1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips. Cut five
2-1/4" x width of fabric (WOF)
strips. Piece them together for the
binding.

Cut two 5-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips. Cut
three 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece
them together into two 5-1/2" x
50-1/2" strips.

Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew one 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" CX2490 strip to the top and bottom of each 10" CX-2898 square.
2. Sew one 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" CX2490 strip to each side of the 10" CX-2898 squares to make four quilt blocks.
3. Sew one 1-3/4" x 12" CX3196 strip to the top and bottom of each quilt block.
4. Sew one 1-3/4" x 14-1/2" CX3196 strip to each side of the quilt blocks.
5. To assemble Rows 1, 3 and 5: Starting with one 2-1/2" CX2650 square, sew together three 2-1/2" CX2650 squares and two 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" CX2860 strips, alternating them to make three rows.
6. To Assemble Rows 2 and 4: Starting with a 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" CX2860 strip, sew together three 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" CX2860 strips and two quilt blocks, alternating them to make two rows.
7. Refer to the quilt photo and sew the rows together in order to make the quilt top.
8. Sew one 2-1/2" x 34-1/2" CX3197 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" CX3197 strip to each side of the quilt top.
9. Sew one 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" CX3195 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" CX3195 strip to each side of the quilt top.
10. Sew one 5-1/2" x 40-1/2" CX3199 strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 5-1/2" x 50-1/2" CX3199 strip to each side of the quilt top.
11. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
