

Kitschy Chickie Quilt

Quilt designed by Marinda Stewart. Finished quilt size approximately 36" x 36"

Fabric Requirements:

1/2 yard of CX3219 Brown

5/8 yard of CX3195 Brown

5/8 yard of Jet Brown

3/4 yard of CX2899 Brown

1/2 yard of CX3218 Cream

1/4 yard of CX3248 Cream

Fat Quarter of CX2879 Maize

Fat Quarter of CX3218 Brown

Fat Eighth of CX3155 Cream

40" squares for backing

40" square piece of batting

Acrylic ruler, mat and rotary cutter

100% cotton threads to match

Basic sewing supplies

Fusible Web

Cutting Instructions:

Fussy cut four motifs 4-1/2" square. Fussy cut three Chicken motifs. Cut two 3-1/2" squares.

Cut six 1-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Cut four 2-1/4" x WOF strips for the binding.

Cut fifty-six 2-1/2" squares. See applique instructions.

Cut twenty-four 4-1/2" squares, eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips and two 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips.

Cut eight 2-1/2" squares and eight Template A pieces. Cut six 1-1/2" x WOF strips.

Cut eight 1" x 11-1/2" strips and eight 1" x 10-1/2" strips.

Cut two 10-1/2" squares.

Cut sixteen Template B pieces and sixteen Template B reversed (B-R) pieces.

Cut two 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips.

Applique Instructions:

- 1) Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace one Chicken, one Rooster, four hearts and two set of silverware onto the paper side of the fusible web.
- 2) Roughly cut each shape and press to the back side of the Jet Brown fabric.
- 3) Cut out each shape on the drawn line.
- 4) Press the chicken onto one 10-1/2" CX2879 Maize square. Repeat with the rooster and the remaining 10-1/2" CX2879 Maize square.
- 5) Following the quilt photo as a reference and center two hearts onto one 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" CX3155 strip. Repeat to make two heart blocks. Press each set of silverware onto one 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip.
- 6) Finish the raw edges on all the appliques with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.

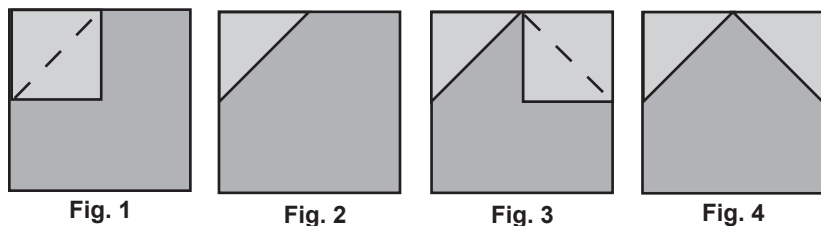
Assembly Instructions:

- 7) Sew one Template B and one Template B-R to each side of one Template A piece. Repeat to make twelve pieced flying geese units.
- 8) Sew one flying goose unit to each side of one 3-1/2" CX3219 Brown square.
- 9) Sew one 2-1/2" CX3218 Cream square to each end of two flying geese units. Sew each flying geese unit to the top and bottom of the 3-1/2" CX3219 Brown square.
- 10) Sew one heart applique block from Step 5 to the bottom of each pieced block.
- 11) Sew one 3-1/2" CX3219 Brown Chicken square to the top of each silverware block. Sew this unit to the right side of the pieced block.
- 12) Repeat Steps 8-11 to make a second pieced block.
- 13) Sew one 1" x 10-1/2" CX3248 Cream strip to the top and bottom of each pieced and each applique block. Sew one 1" x 11-1/2" CX3248 Cream strip to each side of each block.
- 14) For the checkerboard sashing, sew one 1-1/2" x WOF CX3195 Brown strip lengthwise to one 1-1/2" x WOF CX3218 Cream strip. Repeat with the remaining strips to make set strip sets.
- 15) Cut the strip set into (150) 1-1/2" segments.
- 16) Sew together eleven 1-1/2" segments to make one 11-1/2" checkerboard sashing unit. Make six 11-1/2" sashing units total.
- 17) Sew one 11-1/2" checkerboard sashing unit to the top of each pieced block, the chicken and rooster applique blocks.
- 18) Sew the Chicken block to the bottom of one pieced block. Sew one 11-1/2" checkerboard sashing strip to the bottom of the chicken block to make one vertical row. Sew the remaining pieced block to the bottom of the rooster block. Sew one 11-1/2" checkerboard sashing strip to the bottom of the pieced block to make the second vertical row.
- 19) Sew together twenty-eight 1-1/2" segments from Step 14 to make one 28-1/2" vertical checkerboard sashing strip. Make three total.
- 20) Sew one vertical checkerboard sashing strip to the right side of the chicken block row. Sew the rooster block row to the right side of the checkerboard sashing strip to make the quilt top.
- 21) Sew one vertical checkerboard sashing strip to each side of the quilt top.

Disclaimers

1. This pattern is provided as a courtesy to quilt stores, catalogs and quilters. Michael Miller Fabrics, LLC is not responsible for the accuracy of any kits packaged to accompany this pattern. Please direct any inquiries to the kit maker.
2. Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.
3. While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

- 22) Place one 2-1/2" Jet Brown square to the top left corner on one 4-1/2" CX2899 square right sides together (fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric 1/4" from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
- 23) Place another 2-1/2" Jet Brown square on the upper right corner of the 4-1/2" square from Step 2, right sides together (fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric 1/4" from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (fig. 4). Repeat to make twenty-four Border units.



- 24) Follow Figure 5 and make four left border corner units and four right corner units using the flip and sew method used above.

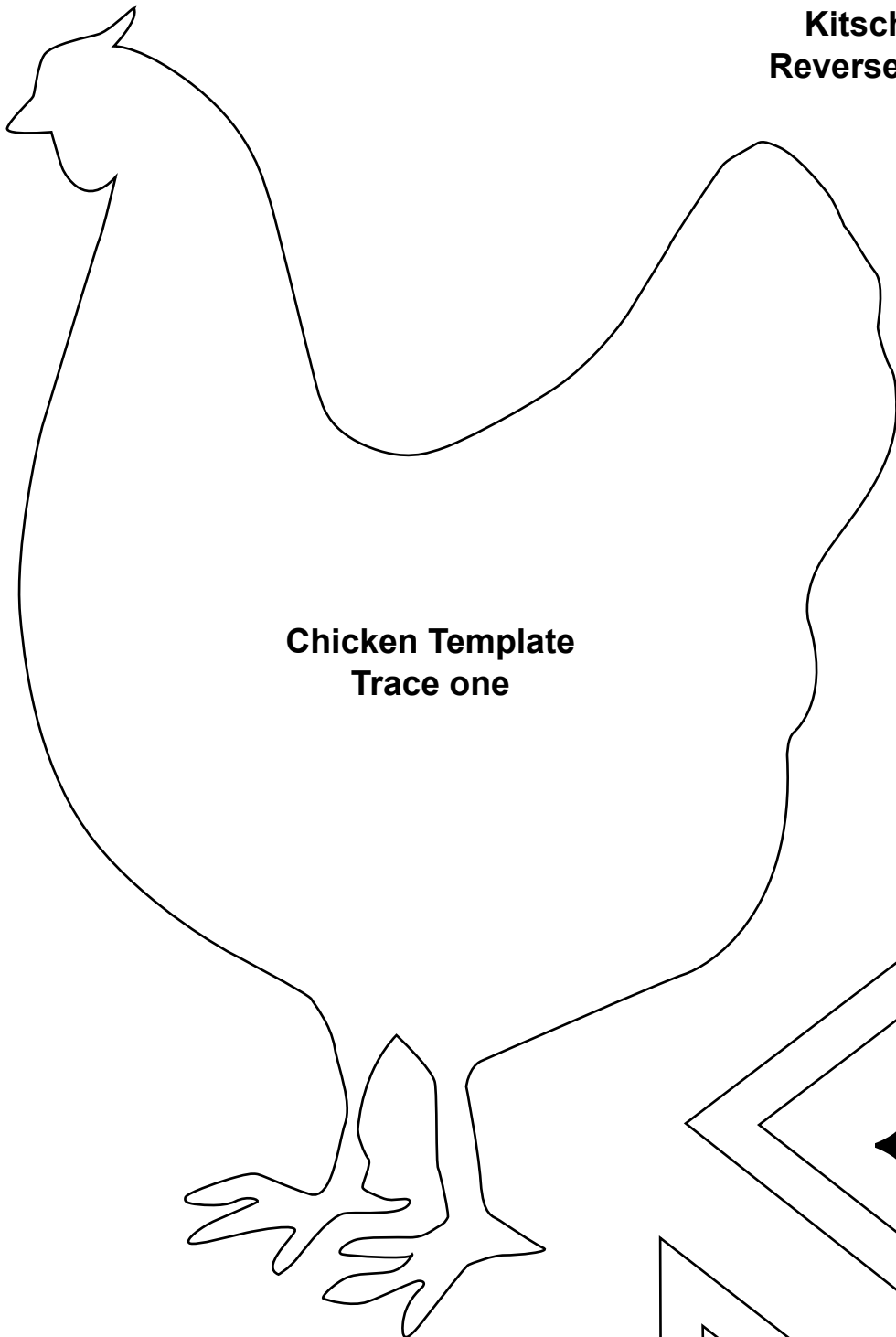


Make (4) Right Corner Units

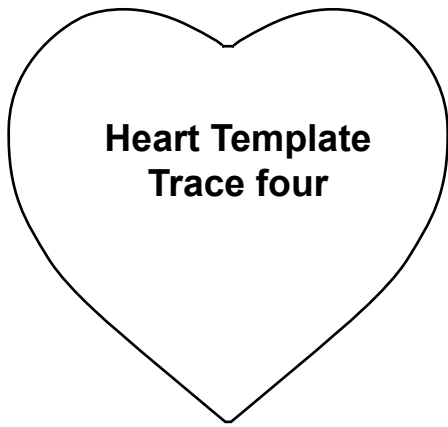
Make (4) Left Corner Units

- 25) Beginning with one left corner unit sew together one left corner unit, six border units and one right corner unit to make one outer border strip. Repeat to make four outer border strips total.
- 26) Sew one border strip to each side of the quilt top,
- 27) Sew one 4-1/2" CX3219 Brown square to each end of the remaining two pieced borders. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 27) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

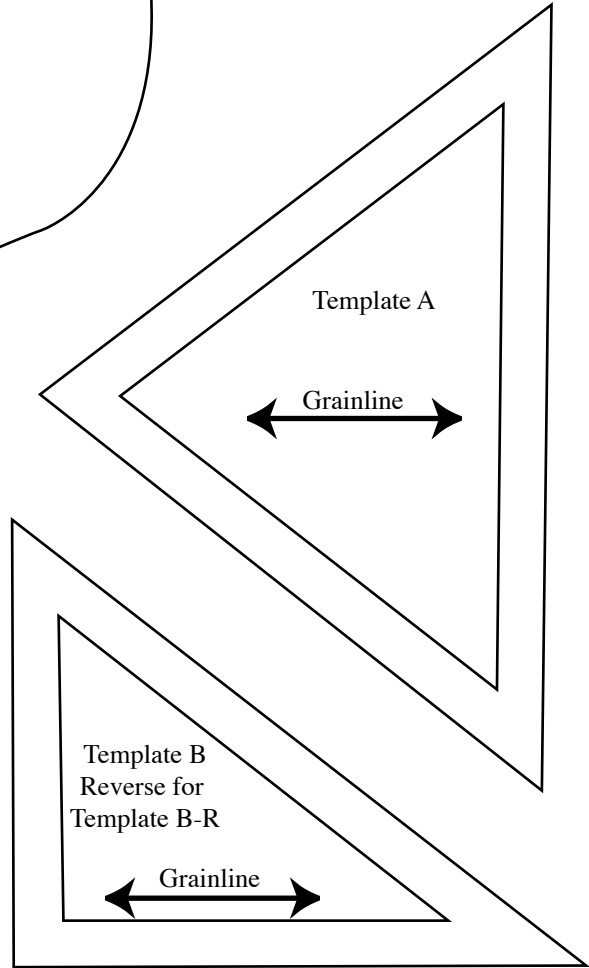
**Kitschy Chicky Templates

Trace four**



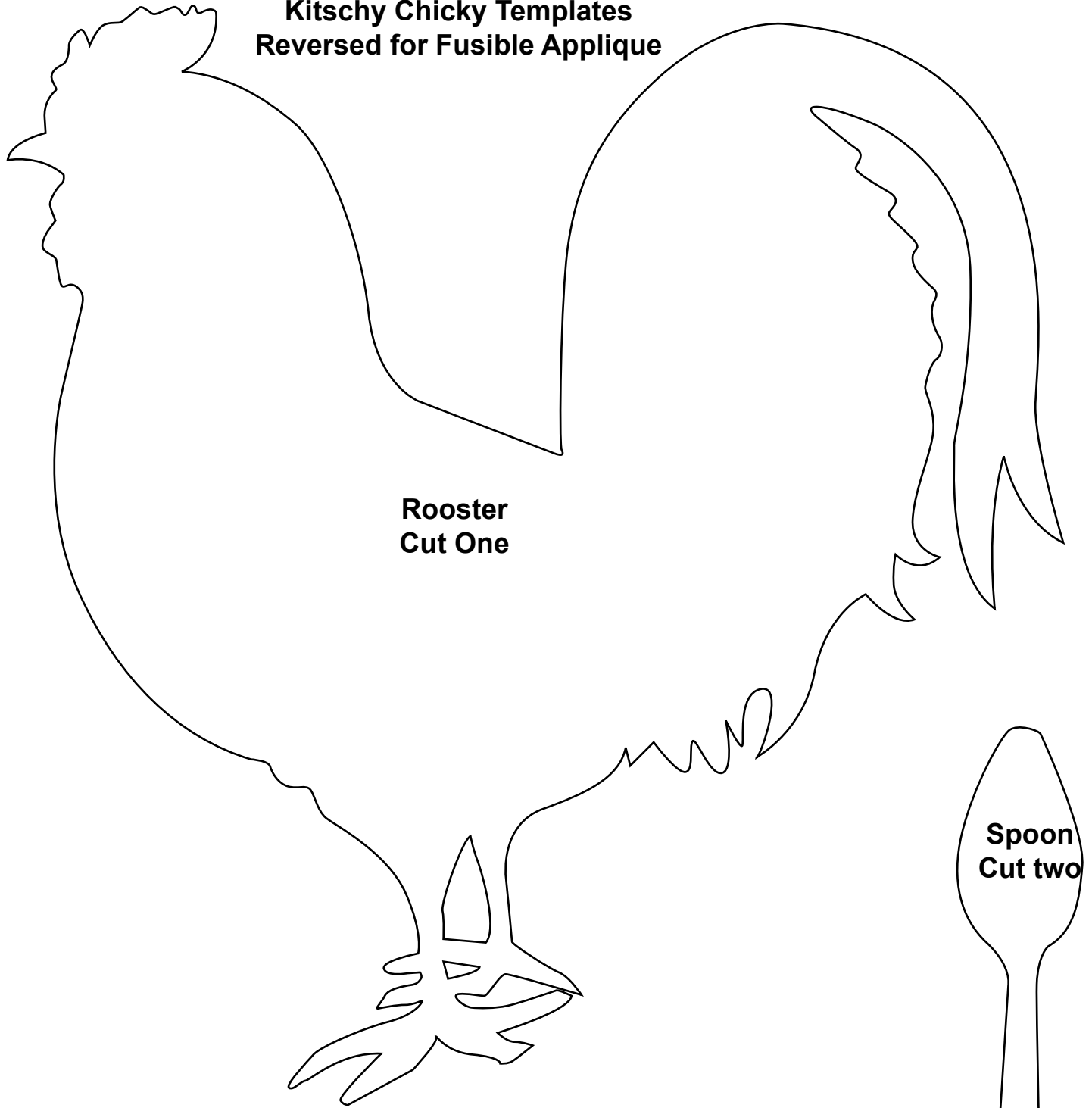

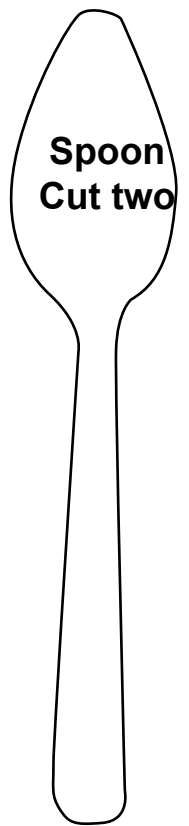

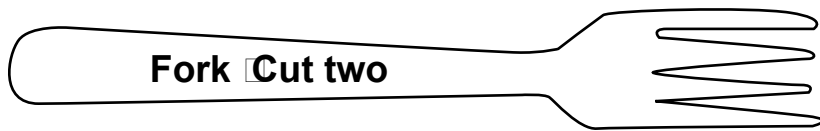
