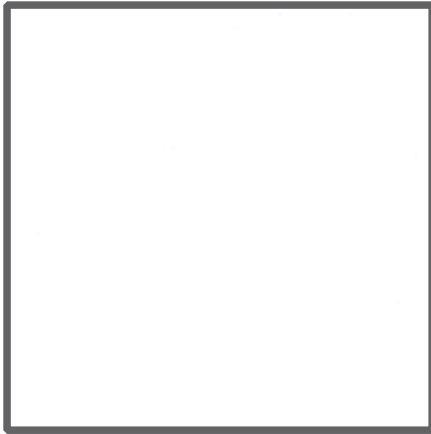

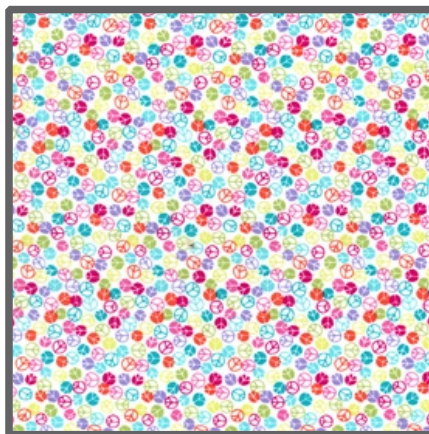

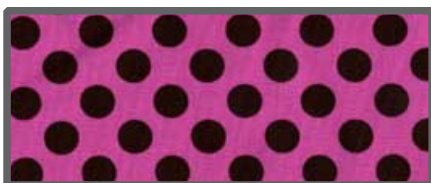

"A" Blanca White Cotton Sheeting	1 1/2 yards	(1) 5 1/2" x 36 1/2" (1) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" (2) 5 1/2" x 45 1/2" * (1) 5 1/2" x 18 1/2" (10) 9 1/2" squares (48) 3 1/2" squares
"B" CX4999 Berry Clara	5/8 yard	(7) 9 1/2" squares (6) 3 1/2" squares
"C" Clip Dot White	5/8 yard	(8) 9 1/2" squares
"D" CX4927 Berry That's All Dot	1 yard	(6) 9 1/2" squares (1) 3 1/2" x 32 1/2" (2) 3 1/2" x 23 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 27 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2"
"E" CX4908 White Peace Swirl	3/4 yard	(3) 9 1/2" squares (1) 3 1/2" x 10 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" (2) 3 1/2" x 27 1/2"
CX4927 Cocoa That's All Dot	1/2 yard	(1) 3 1/2" x 10 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" (2) 3 1/2" x 27 1/2"
CX4956 Berry That's All Stripe	1 1/8 yards	(1) 3 1/2" x 10 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" (2) 3 1/2" x 27 1/2" (2) 1 3/4" x W.O.F. (8) 2 1/2" x W.O.F. - binding
CX4915 White Petite Peace	1/2 yard	(1) 3 1/2" x 32 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 27 1/2" (2) 3 1/2" x 23 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2"
CX4745 Cocoa Paisley Spree	1/2 yard	(1) 3 1/2" x 32 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 27 1/2" (2) 3 1/2" x 23 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2"
CX1492 Orchid Ta Dot	Fat 1/4	(24) 2 1/2" squares

* Cut lengthwise on fabric

Also Needed:

4 1/2 yards of "Blanca" for backing, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

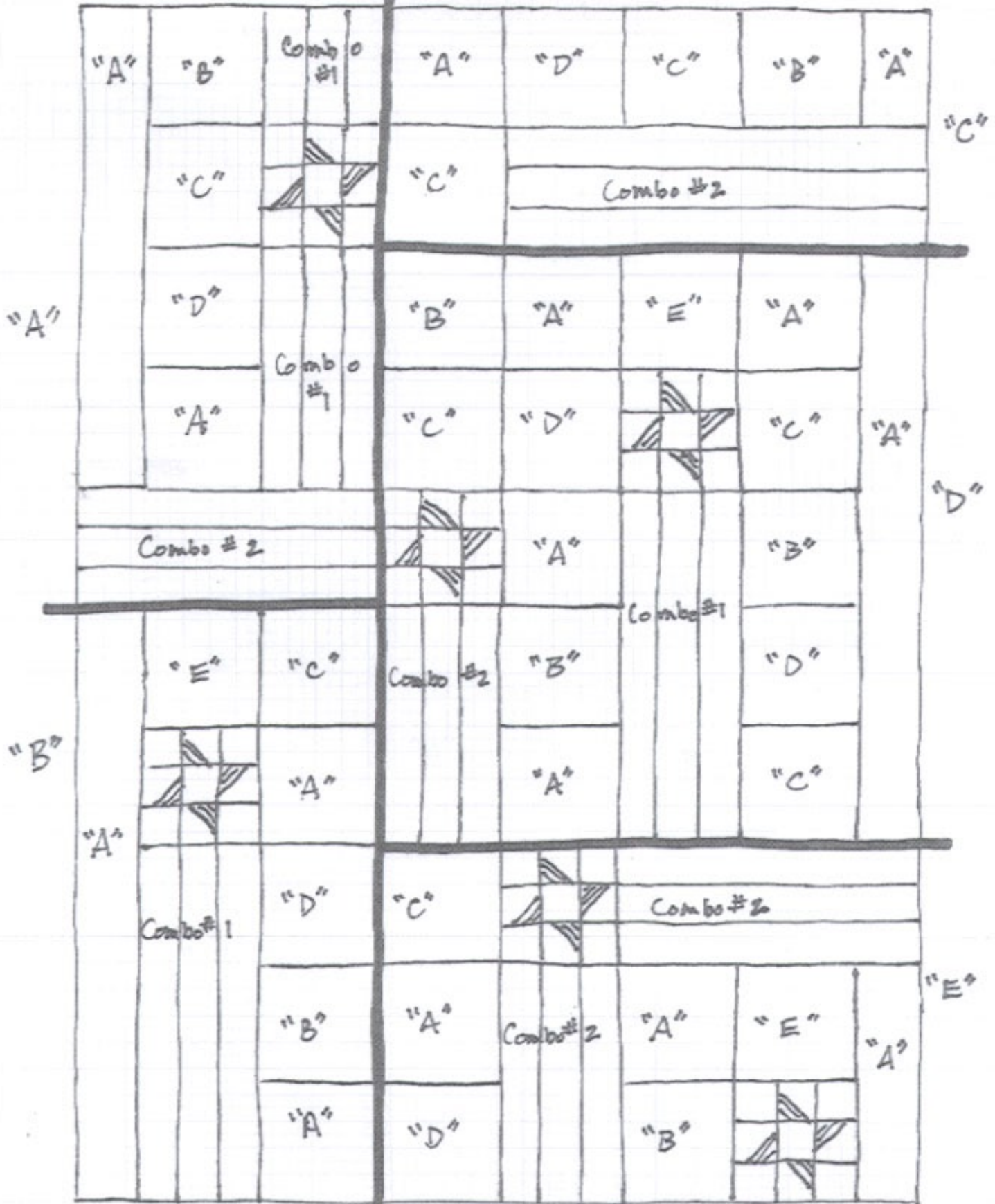
Directions

1. For pieced star blocks - place one CX1492 2 1/2" square right sides together on one 3 1/2" Blanca square. Align the corners. Sew diagonally across the corner from tip to tip on the CX1492 square. Press to the corner, trim away the excess from the back. Make four total. Sew one star point to the top and bottom of one CX4999 3 1/2" square as shown. Sew one Blanca 3 1/2" square to the top and bottom of each remaining star point. Make two. Sew one strip to each side of the center unit. Make six total. Set aside.
2. For Section 'A' - Sew together one strip of four 9 1/2" square into a vertical piece 9 1/2" x 36 1/2" Use (1) "B", (1) "C", (1) "D", and one "A". Sew a 5 1/2" x 36 1/2" "Blanca" strip to the left side. Sew together (1) each 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" piece of CX4908, CX4927 Cocoa and CX4956 to make a 9 1/2" square. Keep the CX4927-cocoa in the center. Repeat for the 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" pieces of the same fabrics. Sew the 9 1/2" square to the top of one star block. Sew the 18 1/2" pieced strip to the bottom of the star block. Sew the unit to the right side of the section.
3. Using one each of 3 1/2" x 23 1/2" strips of CX4915, CX4745, and CX4927 Berry. Sew together with CX4745 in the center. Sew to the bottom of Section "A". Set aside.
4. For Section "B" - sew together a vertical strip of 9" squares in the following order beginning with (1) "C", (1) "A", (1) "D", (1) "B", and ending with one "A". Sew one 9 1/2" "E" to the top of one star block. Piece together one each 3 1/2" x 27 1/2" strip of CX4908, CX4927 Cocoa, and CX4956 as in step #2. Sew one 5 1/2" x 45 1/2" Blanca strip to the left side of the star block unit. Sew the 5-square unit to the right side. Sew the top of Section "B" to the bottom of Section "A" as shown. Set aside.
5. For Section "C" - sew together four 9 1/2" squares horizontally in the following order from the left - (1) "A", (1) "D", (1) "C" and (1) "B". End with a 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" Blanca piece. Sew together one each 3 1/2" x 32 1/2" piece of CX4915, CX4745, and CX4927 Berry as in step #2. Sew one 9 1/2" "C" square to the left end of the pieced strip. Sew the unit to the bottom of the four square strip to complete section "C".
6. For Section "D" - for row #1 - sew together vertically one 9 1/2" "B", (1) "C", (1) Star Block and one striped piece made from one each 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" CX4915, CX4745, CX4927 Berry. For row #2 - sew together vertically the following 9" squares (1) "A", (1) "D", (1) "A", (1) "B", and (1) "A". Sew to the right side of row #1. For row #3 sew (1) 9 1/2" square "E" to the top of one star block. Sew one each 3 1/2" x 27 1/2" CX4908, CX4927 Cocoa, and CX4956 as in Step #2. Sew to the bottom of the star block. Sew to the right side of row #2. For row #4 sew together vertically one 9 1/2" "A", (1) "C", (1) "B", (1) "D", and (1) "C". Sew to the right side of Section "D". Sew one 5 1/2" x 45 1/2" (pieced for length) Blanca to the right side of Section "D". Sew section "D" to the bottom of Section "C".
7. For Section "E" sew together vertically one each 9 1/2" square "C", "A", and "D". Sew together one each 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" strip of CX4915, CX4745, CX4927 Berry as in step #2. Sew one star block to the top of the pieced strip. Sew unit to the right side of the 3 square strip. Sew one "A" square to the top of one "B" square. Sew one "E" square to the top of the remaining

star block. Sew star block unit to the right side of the 2 square strip. Sew one 5 1/2" x 18 1/2" Blanca to the right side of the 4 block unit. Sew together one each 3 1/2" x 23 1/2" piece of CX4915, CX4745, CX4927 Berry as in Step #2. Sew to the top of the star unit. Sew completed unit to the right side of the remaining star unit to complete Section "E" as shown. Sew section "E" to the bottom of the C/D section.

8. Join the A/B unit to the C/D/E unit as shown to make one 64 1/2" x 90 1/2" top.
9. For the backing from Blanca cut one 44" x 74" piece and two 11" x 74". Sew one 11" piece to each side of the 44" piece, use 1/2" seam allowance for the backing. Turn under one 1/4" hem. Repeat. Top stitch hem in place. Cut one 21" x 64 1/2". Hem along one 64 1/2" edge in the same way. Place 64 1/2" x 74" and 64 1/2" x 21" pieces wrong sides together with the pieced cover. Overlap the 74" edge over the 21" edge at the bottom of the duvet for an envelope opening.
10. Bind all edges with CX4956 pieced as needed for length. Piece along the stripes to conceal the seams.
11. For the ties sew together each 1 3/4" x W.O.F. strip with right sides together across the width of fabric. Turn each to the right side. Press. Cut each strip into four equal pieces. Sew (4) ties equally spaced to the bottom of the 74" edge. Match the remaining four ties to the smaller side of the back. Sew in place.
12. Insert comforter and tie opening closed to finish.
