CJ4747 Multi Girl's Day	*2/3 yard	(1) 9" x 40 1/2" each fussy cut (1) 8 1/2" x 40 1/2" each fussy cut (1) 5 1/2" x 40 1/2" each fussy cut
CJ4748 Cream Onnanoko	3/8 yard	(1) 4" x 40 1/2" (8) 5 1/2" squares (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (12) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"
CX4602 Gray Mizu	1/6 yard	(12) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
CX1087 Parchment Marble	1/6 yard	(12) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
CM1713 Cherry Maui Bliss	1/4 yard	(10) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (8) 3" squares
K1148 Krystal	1/4 yard	(10) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (8) 3" squares
CX4470 Orange Kimono Flowers	1/4 yard	(12) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (8) 3" squares
CM0376 Spice Fairy Frost	1/4 yard	(12) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (8) 3" squares
CJ4816 Brown Painted Canvas	3/4 yard	(8) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" (5) 2 1/2" x W.O.F.

* Or amount needed for one complete repeat. Each stripe is fussy cut with 1/4" seam allowance on each side.

Also Needed:

45" x 60" backing and 45" x 60" batting, thread to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

1. Randomly piece (20) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces into one row using CX4602, CX1087, CM1713, K1148, CX4470, CM0376, and CJ4748. Make two rows of twenty pieces. Sew one CJ4816 40 1/2" piece to the bottom of one row. Set the other row aside.
2. For Row 2 - sew CJ4747 9" x 40 1/2" piece to the bottom of CJ4816. Keep motifs upright. Sew one CJ4816 40 1/2" piece to the bottom.
3. For Row 3 - randomly piece four 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces into a 4 1/2" square. Make (20) blocks total using the same seven fabrics as step #1. Sew (10) blocks together into a row alternating the directions of the strips. Make two rows. Sew one row to the bottom of the quilt followed by one CJ4816 40 1/2" piece. Set the remaining row aside.
4. For Row 4 - sew CJ4747 8 1/2" x 40 1/2" piece to the bottom of the quilt. Sew one CJ4816 40 1/2" to the bottom.
5. For Row 5 - Sew the remaining (10) - block row from step #3 to the bottom of the quilt. Sew one CJ4816 40 1/2" to the bottom.
6. For Row 6 - Sew the CJ4748 40 1/2" piece to the bottom of the quilt. Add a CJ4816 40 1/2" to the bottom of the quilt.
7. For Row 7 - Place one K1148 3" square right sides together on the upper left corner of one CJ4748 5 1/2" square. Sew diagonally from the lower left corner to the upper right corner of the 3" square. Trim away the excess to 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat for the lower right corner using CM0376, the upper right corner using CX4470 and the lower left corner using CM1713. Make (8) blocks total. Sew together into one row. Sew to the bottom of the quilt. Add one CJ4816 40 1/2" piece to the bottom.
8. For Row 8 - Sew one CJ4747 5 1/2" x 40 1/2" piece to the bottom of the quilt followed by a CJ4816 40 1/2" piece.
9. For Row 9 - Sew the remaining row from Step #1 to the bottom of the quilt.
10. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
11. Quilt as desired.
12. Bind quilt using CJ4816 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.
