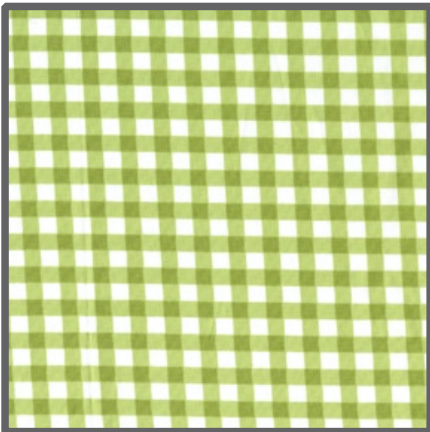

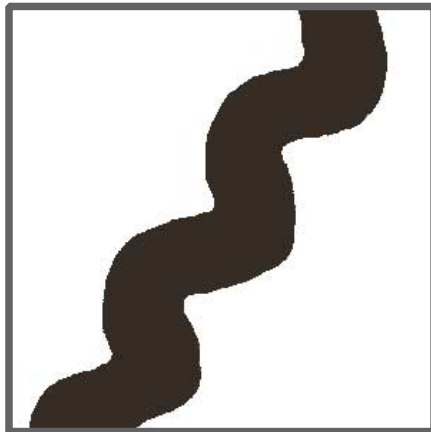

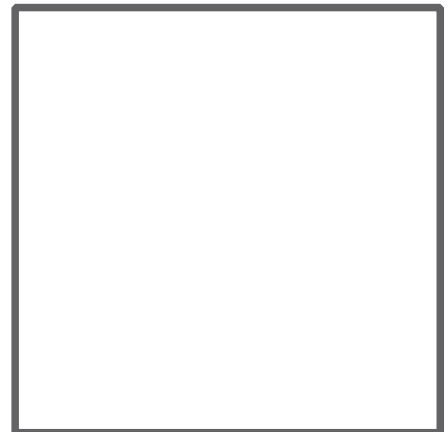

Happy Birthday Cupcake! 40 1/2" x 50 1/2" quilt by Ellen Maxwell

Directions

Step One:

From CX4618_Brown

CUT lengthwise

Left section - 50 1/2" x 22 1/2"

Right section - 50 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Step Two:

From CX4201_Multi

CUT

3 - 10 1/2" (long) x 8 1/2" (wide)

From solid white fabric

CUT

2 - 10 1/2" (long) x 8 1/2" (wide)

Step Three:

Trace cupcake designs on the paper side of lite fusible webbing. Cut around each shape and press with the iron - based on manufacturer's directions - to fabric scraps of your choice.

Step Four:

Press cupcake parts in place on the 3 multi blocks and the 2 solid white blocks. Machine applique in place. Sew assorted colors of ruffle rac where the cupcake top meets the cupcake bottom.

Step Five:

Sew the 5 cupcake blocks together - one on top of the other - in one long strip with a 1/4" seam. Sew the right and left section of brown cupcake fabric to the sides of the cupcakes.

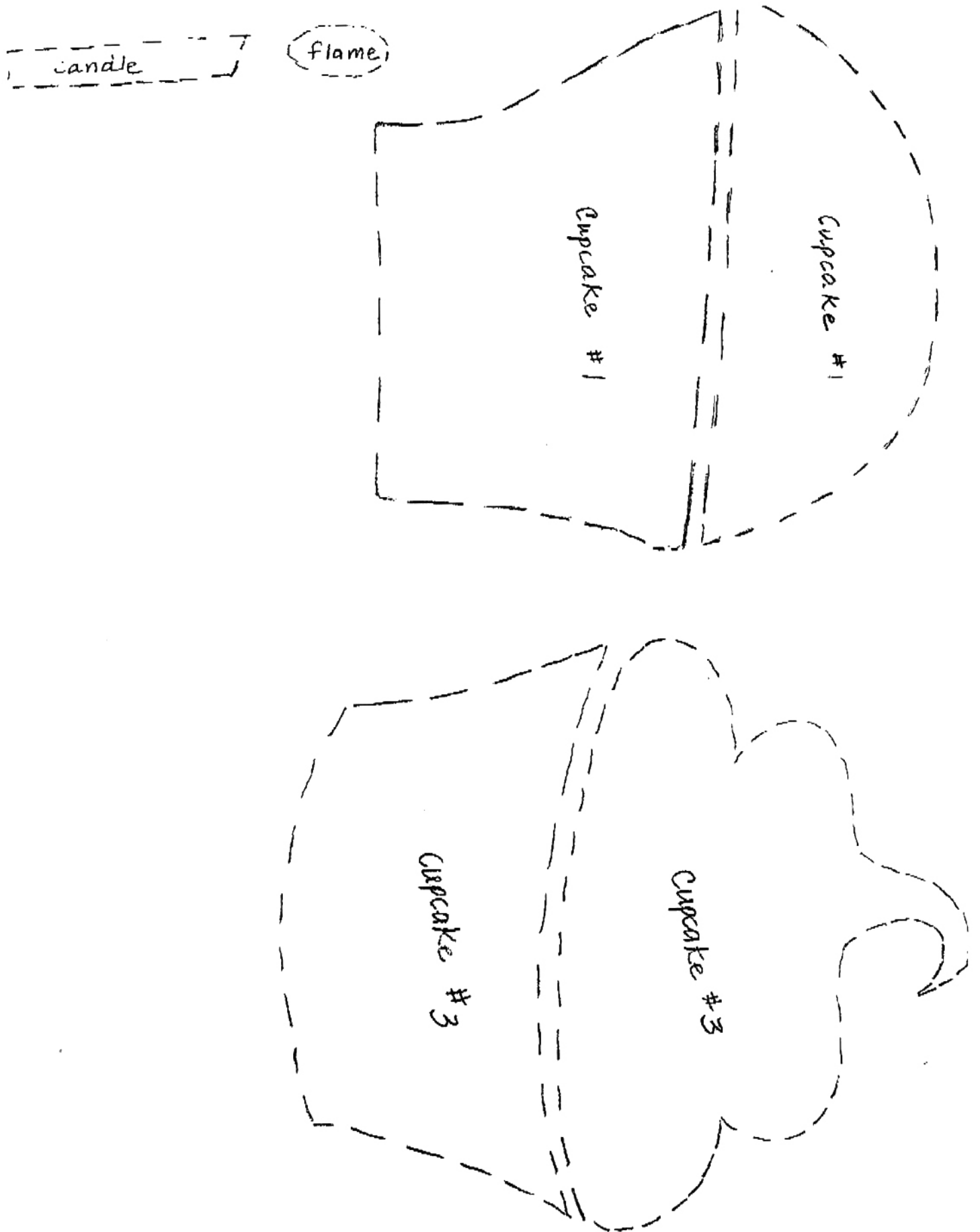
Step Six:

Layer quilt top, batting and CX1492_Candy for backing. Quilt as desired. From CX4496_Lime

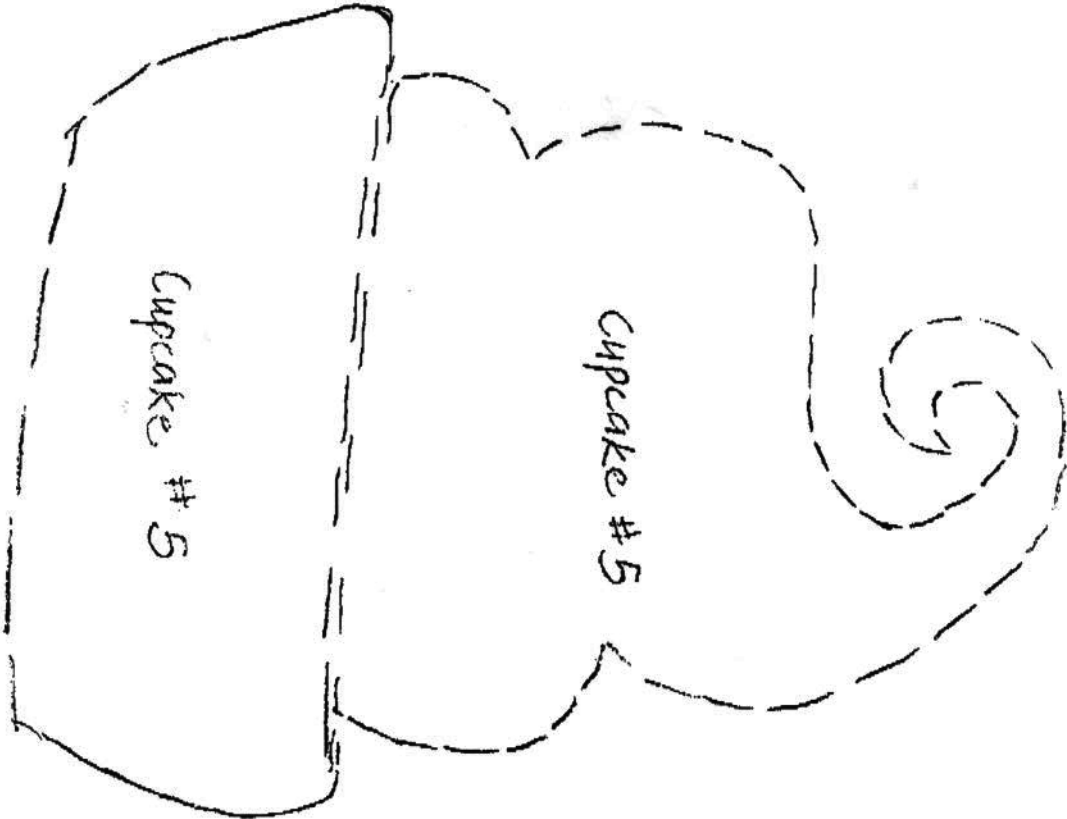
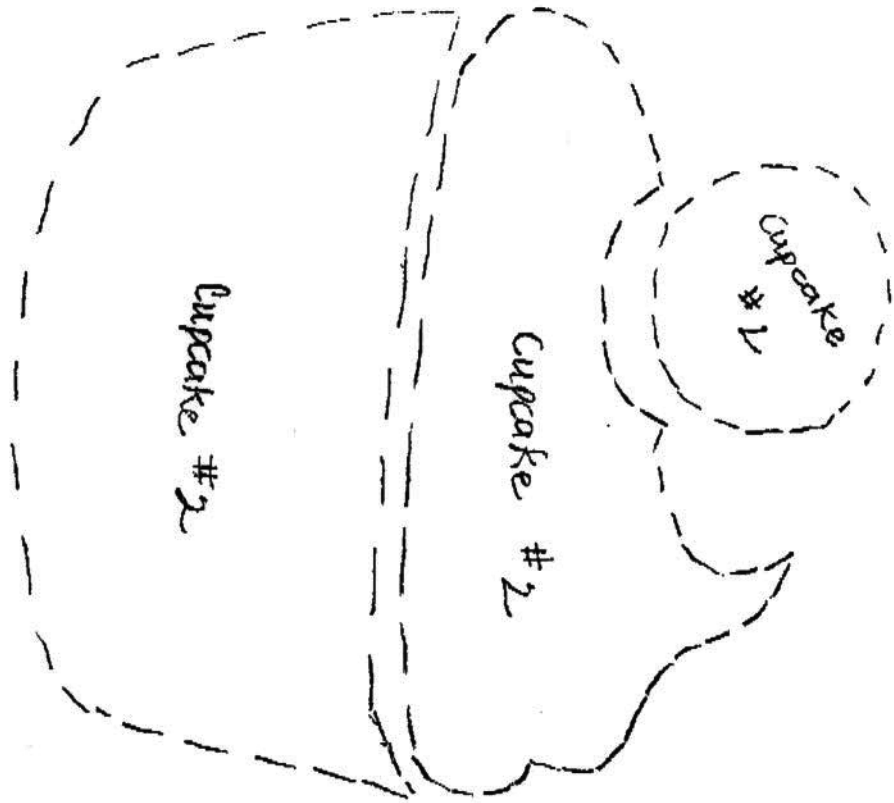
CUT

5 - 2 1/2" x width of the fabric for binding Sew end to end, press - wrong sides together - and attach as French Fold binding.
