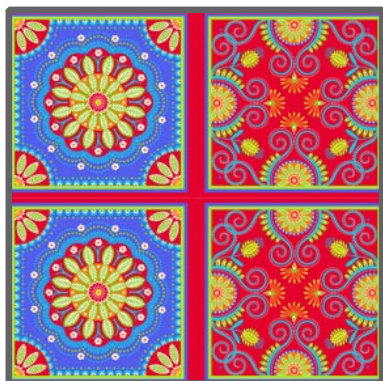
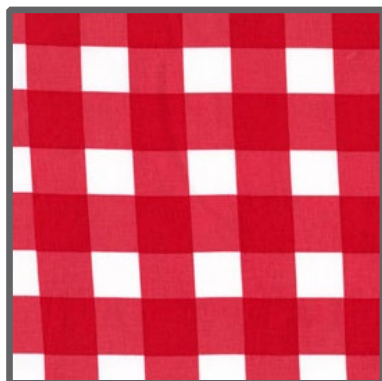


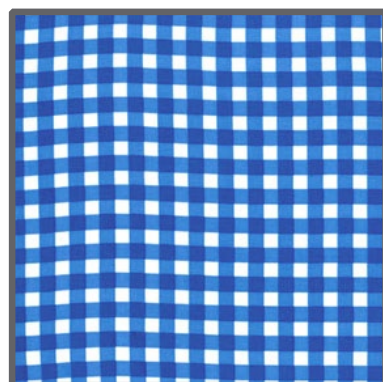

## "Jumbo Gypsy Bandana Geese"

Quilt by Ellen Maxwell

Size: Approximately 49 1/2" W x 62 1/2" H - Skill Level: Beginner

### Materials

Fabric	Yardage	Swatch
<b>DC4608 Red Gypsy Bandana</b>	2 Repeats	
<b>DC4702 Red Jumbo Gypsy Gingham</b>	1 5/8 yards	
<b>DC4616 Sapphire Gypsy Gingham</b>	1 1/4 yards	
<b>DC4609 Red Bandana Border</b>	1 3/4 yards	
<b>DC4609 Sapphire Bandana Border</b>	1 3/4 yards

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

### Directions

2 repeats of design DC4608\_Red

includes 2 blue bandanas and 2 red bandanas

Cut bandana squares 1/2" past inside of most inner border of fabric. Then cut the bandanas twice diagonally. Refer to diagram for making geese blocks.

1 5/8 yards DC4702\_Red

Cut strips for sashing center and outer borders - lengthwise.

Cut three 3 1/2" x 54" and two 3 1/2" x 50".

NOTE: Quilt as shown was fussy cut - 1/4" past design of 3 big squares.

Refer to quilt photo and diagram for making strip sets.

1 1/4 yards DC4616\_Sapphire

Open piece of fabric and fold on bias. Carefully cut on bias fold to make

bias strips for sashing and biding.

Sashing - Cut four strips 1 1/2" x 54" and two strips 1 1/2" x 50".

Binding - cut strips 2 1/2" wide to measure a total of 225".

Be careful not to stretch binding on bias.

1 3/4 yards DC4609\_Red

Cut a lengthwise strip down the side opposite the border - 10 1/2" wide.

Cut this strip into six 10 1/2" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal. These will be corners for the flying geese blocks.

Sew the remaining piece with border to the same section of the blue border listed below - matching border designs for the quilt backing.

1 3/4 yards DC4609\_Sapphire

Repeat above steps as listed for red fabric.
