Size: Approximately 52 1/2"W x 52 1/2"H

Materials

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
DC4393 Brown Pretty Bird	1 1/8 yard	(1) 36 1/2" x 36 1/2" square ON POINT (see directions)
DC4323 Spice Garden Stripe	1 yard	(4) 2 1/2" x 35" Cut 2 1/2" bias strips from remaining fabric for binding pieced as needed for length.
DC4326 Spice Dancing Flowers	1 yard	(4) 8 3/4" x 30 1/8"
DC4322 Orange Twirling Tendrils	1/4 yard	(4) 3" x 14" Fussy cut half of the ten- dril as shown
DC4322 Green Twirling Tendrils	1 3/4 yard	(4) 5 1/2" x LENGTH of fabric Fussy cut complete strip
DC4321 Brown Bloomies	Fat 1/4	(2) 7" square cut in half diagonally
DC4326 Orange Dancing Flowers	3 1/2 yard	Backing - Piece as needed for correct size

Also Needed: Batting 55" x 55", thread to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter, and mat.

REMEMBER : This is a simple pattern and the instructions are meant to be simple, too!!! Start in the center and just keep going round and round with each additional fabric!
Refer to the photo for fabric placement.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

1. Fold DC4393 'Pretty Bird' in half horizontally and again vertically to make a 1/4 size square. Measure 18 1/4" from center fold on each folded edge. Mark with a pin. Draw a diagonal line between the pins. This should measure 26 1/8" long. Cut along drawn lines. Unfold square. It should measure 26 1/8" along each side and 36 1/2" corner to corner top to bottom and side to side. Handle fabric carefully as the edges are all on the bias.
2. Center each DC4323 2 1/2" x 35" strip on a side of the quilt. Sew in place. Use excess fabric to miter each corner. Trim away excess fabric once mitering is complete.
3. Sew DC4326 8 3/4" to all edges of the quilt. Trim off excess fabric at a 45 degree angle as show to maintain the center square.
4. Sew DC4322 Orange 3" pieces to the quilt. Trim the excess fabric off a in step #3.
5. Add the right square triangles to each corner as shown. Trim off any excess. Finished quilt-top should measure 41 3/4" square.
6. Center each DC4322 Green 5 1/2" strips on a side of the quilt for the outer border. Repeat step #2.
7. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
8. Quilt as desired.
9. Bind with DC4323 2 1/2" bias strips pieced as needed for length.
