“Road to Marrakesh Quilt”

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Materials

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
CX4502 Gray Road to Marrakesh	1 5/8 yard	(1) 17 1/2” w x 54 1/2” h (gray side) (1) 11 1/2” w x 54 1/2” h (purple side) (54) triangles in sets of 4 (see pattern)(pink)
K2176 (smokey purple) Krystal	5/8 yard	(5) 2 1/2” x W.O.F. (27) 2 1/2” squares
K2276 (ink purple) Krystal	1/6 yard	(27) 2 1/2” squares (9) 1 1/4” squares
CM0376 Grape Fairy Frost	1/6 yard	(14) 2 1/2” x 4 1/2”
CM0376 Violet Fairy Frost	1/6 yard	(13) 2 1/2” x 4 1/2”
CM0376 Azalea Fairy Frost	1/6 yard	(2) 3/4” x 6” (8) 1” x 6” (2) 1” x 54 1/2” pieced for length
CX4842 Lavender Dots ‘n’ Squares	1/6 yard	(13) 2 1/2” x 14 1/2”
CX4842 Carnation Dots ‘n’ Squares	1/6 yard	(14) 2 1/2” x 4 1/2” (9) 5/8” squares

Also Needed:

50” x 65” Backing, 50” x 65” Batting, Threads to match, fusible web, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

1. From CX4502 sew together four matching triangles into a square as shown. Trim to an accurate 6" square. Make (9) total.
2. Following manufacturer's directions, iron fusible web onto the back of K2276 1 1/4" squares and CX4842 Carnation 5/8" squares. Remove paper backing from each. Layer one 5/8" square on top of one K2276 1 1/4" square. Make 9. Place one on point at the center intersection of the 6" triangle block. Machine appliqué all raw edges to finish.
3. Begin and end with CM0376 Azalea 3/4" x 6" piece alternate with 6" blocks and CM0376 Azalea 1" x 6" pieces to make a 6" x 54 1/2" strip. Sew one CM0376 Azalea 1" x 54 1/2" (pieced for length) to each side of the strip. Set aside.
4. To make zig-zag border place one K2276 2 1/2" square right sides together on top of one CX4842 Carnation 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" piece. Sew diagonally from the top left corner to the lower right corner of the 2 1/2" square. Press open the corner. Trim the excess from back. Make (14) total. Repeat using K2276 and CM0376 Violet, sewing from the lower left corner to the upper right corner of the 2 1/2" square. Make (13) total. Beginning and ending with a K2276/CX4842 piece sew together all pieces in an alternating pattern. Set aside. Repeat using K2176 2 1/2" squares and CM0376 Grape 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces. Make (14). Finish with K2176 2 1/2" squares and CX4842 Lavender. Make (13). Sew into a 4 1/2" x 54 1/2" strip. Sew K2176 to the left side of the 6" block strip with the K2176 pieces to the outside. Sew the K2276 strip to the right side in the same way.
5. Sew CX4502 11 1/2" x 54 1/2" piece to the right side of the quilt. Sew CX4502 17 1/2" x 54 1/2" piece to the left side of the quilt.
6. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
7. Quilt as desired.
8. Bind quilt using K2176 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.
