Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	PC4850-Coral Hospital Gown – Coral	$\frac{2}{3}$ yard	• Cut one 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2" x 7" strips and four 2" x 5" strips. • Cut one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips and eight 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips. • Cut one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" squares. • Cut one 1 $\frac{7}{8}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 1 $\frac{7}{8}$" squares
(B)	SC5333-White Cottage Couture – Bright White	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards	• Cut one 12 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 1" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips, ten 1" x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips and ten 1" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips. • Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 5" strips. • Cut one 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 2" x 7" strips and eight 2" x 3". • Cut one 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 2 $\frac{1}{4}$" x 5" strips and eight 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 3" strips. • Cut one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" squares. • Cut one 1 $\frac{7}{8}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 1 $\frac{7}{8}$" squares. • Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into five 3 $\frac{1}{2}$" squares and four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" squares. • Cut one 3 $\frac{7}{8}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut ten 3 $\frac{7}{8}$" squares. • Cut six 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips and two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(C)	PC6328-Navy Little Lifesavers – Navy	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	• Cut one 3 $\frac{7}{8}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into ten 3 $\frac{7}{8}$" squares. • Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(D)	PC6329-Coral Little Anchors – Coral	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	• Cut two 3 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips. • Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(E)	PC1492-Navy Ta Dot – Navy	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twenty 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(F)	PC5720-Navy Starlettes – Navy	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	• Cut one 12 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into ten 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips and ten 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(G)	PC6332-Sprout Little Whales – Sprout	$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	• Cut eight 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into twenty-four 2" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(H)	PC5720-Coral Starlettes – Coral	$\frac{1}{8}$ yard	• Cut one 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2" squares.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(I)	PC1492-Nite Ta Dot – Nite	$\frac{1}{3}$ yard	• Cut two 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips. • Cut three 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(J)	PC1492-Stream Ta Dot – Stream	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" squares. • Cut six 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips for the binding.
(K)	PC6330-Navy Little Sailboats – Navy	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(L)	PC6328-Coral Little Lifesavers – Coral	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(M)	PC5720-Sprout Starlettes – Sprout	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(N)	PC6330-Sprout Little Sailboats – Sprout	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(O)	PC6332-Navy Little Whales – Navy	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(P)	PC6332-Coral Little Whales – Coral	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
(Q)	PC6328-Sprout Little Lifesavers – Sprout	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.
Backing	PC6330-Stream Little Sailboats – Stream	3 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards	• Cut two 64" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 64" pieced backing.

You will also need:

- 64" x 64" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Block Assembly

1. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, lengthwise, to make one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " D/E/D square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make twenty 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " D/E/D squares total.

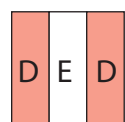

2. Place one $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C square on top of one $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make two B/C units (Fig. 4). Trim B/C units to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make twenty B/C units total.

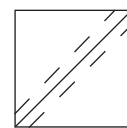

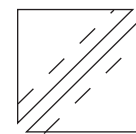

3. Refer to Figure 5 to sew together four D/E/D squares, one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square and four B/C units to make one Block One center.
4. Sew one $1" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Block One center. Sew one $1" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Block One center.

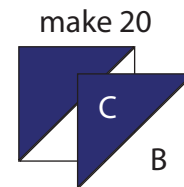

5. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Block One center. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the Block One center to complete one $12\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ Block One (Fig. 6).
6. Repeat Steps 3-5 to make five Block Ones total.

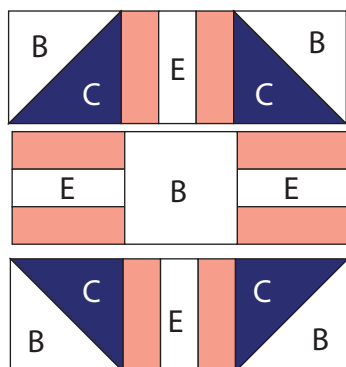

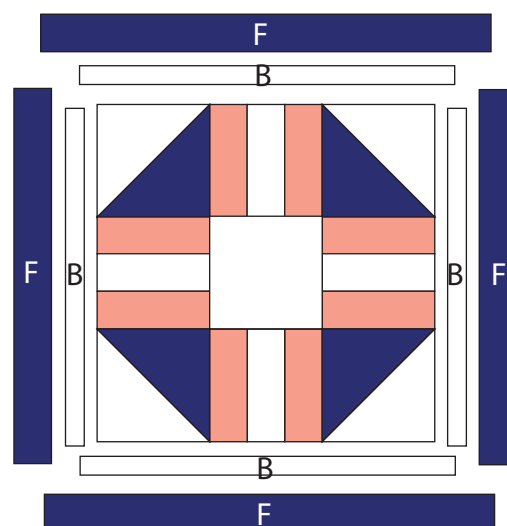

7. Repeat Step 2 using eight $1\frac{7}{8}"$ Fabric B squares and eight $1\frac{7}{8}"$ Fabric A squares to make sixteen $1\frac{1}{2}"$ A/B units total (Fig. 7).
8. Follow Figure 8 and sew four A/B units, four $1\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric A squares and one $1\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric B square together to make one anchor top. Repeat to make four anchor rings.

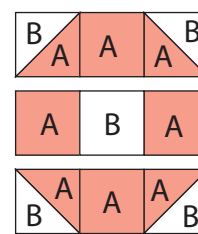

9. Sew one 3 1/2" x 5" Fabric B strip to each side of each anchor rings to make four anchor tops (Fig. 9).
10. Sew one 2" x 3" Fabric B strip to each side of one 2" x 7" Fabric A strip to make the anchor middle (Fig. 10). Repeat to make four anchor middles.
11. Place one 2 1/2" Fabric B square on the left side of one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 12). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
12. Place another 2 1/2" Fabric B square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 13). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 13). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 14). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to complete one left B/A/B unit.
13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make four left B/A/B units total.
14. Repeat Steps 11-12 with four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric A strips and eight 2 1/2" Fabric B squares, this time sew from the upper left corner to the lower right corner across each square to make four right B/A/B units (Fig. 15).
15. Follow Figure 16 and sew two 2" x 7" Fabric B strips, two 2 1/2" x 3" Fabric B strips, two B/A/B units, two 2 1/4" x 5" Fabric B strips, one 2" x 5" Fabric A strip and one 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric A strip to complete one anchor bottom. Repeat to make four anchor bottoms.
16. Sew two 1" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strips, one anchor top, one anchor middle and one anchor bottom together to make one Anchor Block (Fig. 17). Repeat to make four Anchor Blocks total.

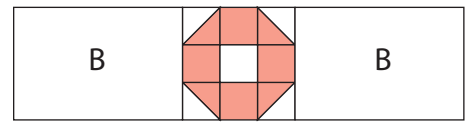

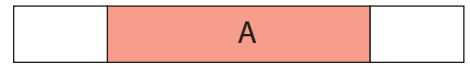

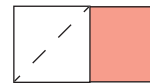

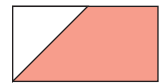

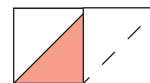

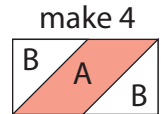

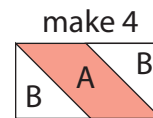

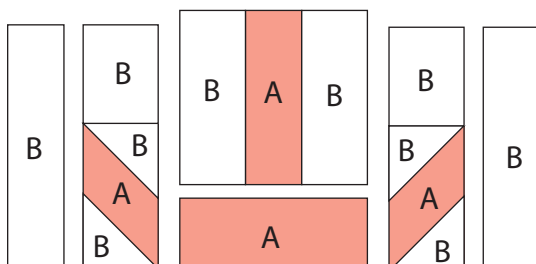

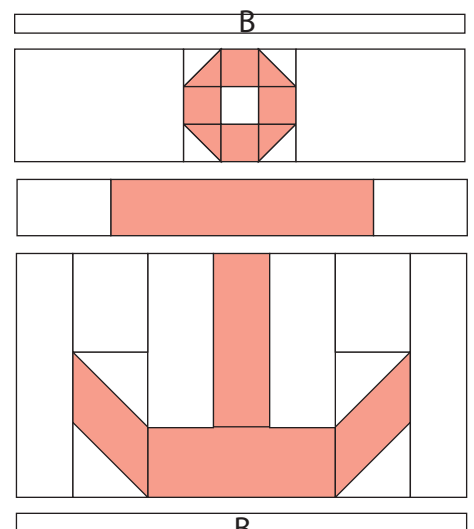

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow Quilt layout while assembling the quilt top.)

17. Sew three 2" x 12 ½" Fabric G strips and four 2" Fabric H squares together to make one sashing row. Repeat to make four sashing rows total.
18. Sew two Block Ones, one Anchor Block and four 2" x 12 ½" Fabric G strips together to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
19. Sew two Anchor Blocks, one Block One and four 2" x 12 ½" Fabric G strips together to make Row Two.
20. Sew the three rows and four sashing rows together to make the quilt top.
21. Sew 1 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
22. Sew one 2 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
23. Sew thirty-two 2" x 4 ½" assorted Fabric strips together to make one border strip. Repeat to make four border strips total.
24. Sew one border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4 ½" Fabric J square to each end of the remaining two border strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
25. Layer and quilt as desired.
26. Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
27. Bind as desired.
