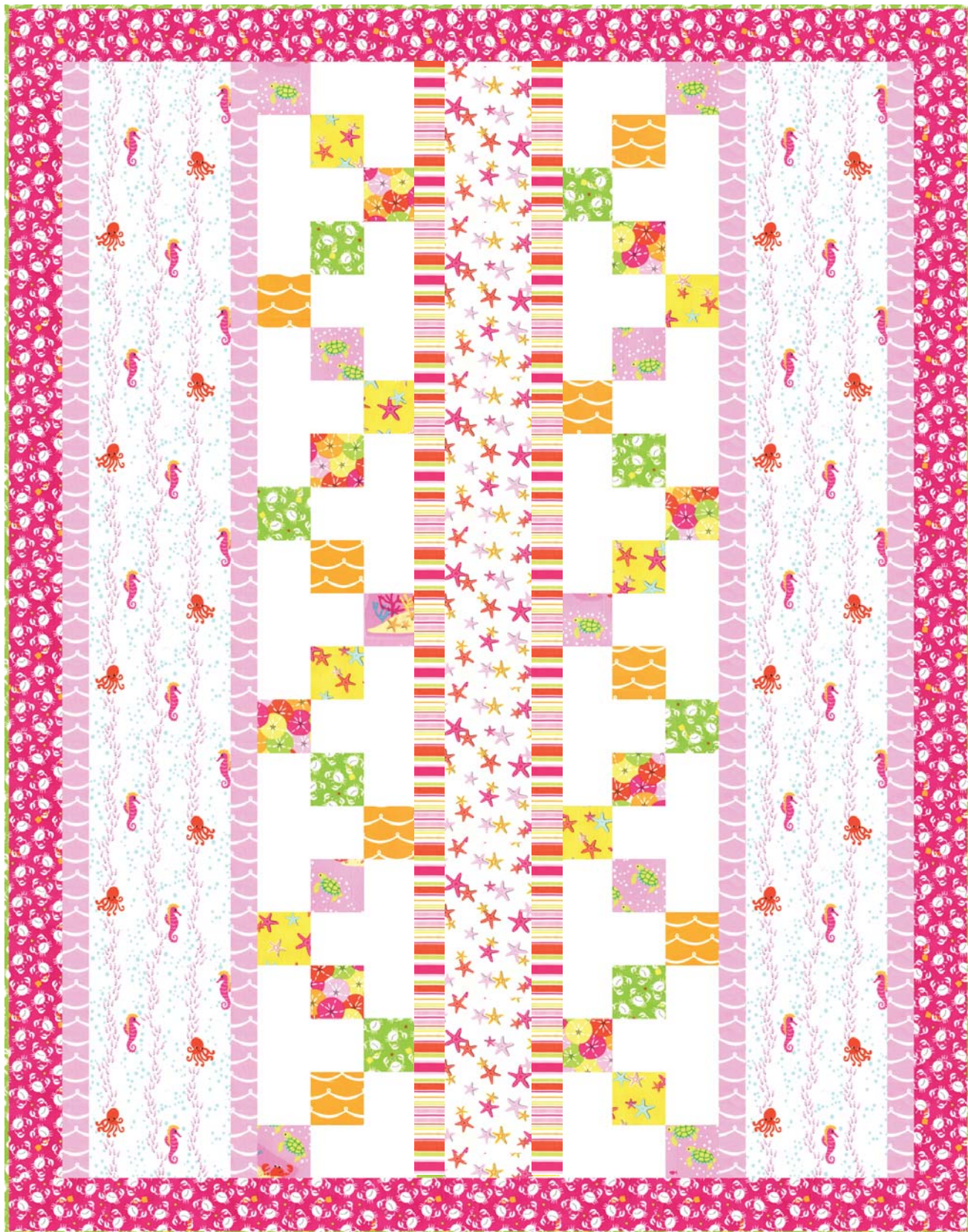


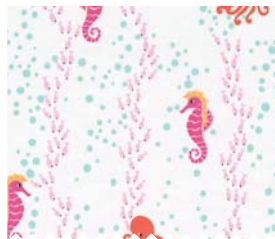

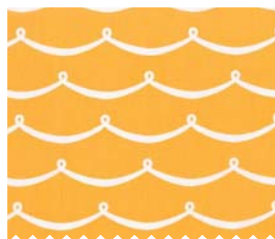

Size: Approximately 54" x 69" Skill Level: Beginner

Materials

Cutting instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	PC6625-Pink Floating with the Fishes – Pink	1 $\frac{7}{8}$ yards	• Cut two 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from the length of fabric (LOF).
(B)	PC6620-Coral A Sea of Stars – Coral	$\frac{1}{3}$ yard	• Cut two 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
(C)	PC6621-Citrus Umbrella Stripe – Citrus	$\frac{1}{3}$ yard	• Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
(D)	PC6623-Pink New Wave – Pink	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	• Cut eight 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut four 2" x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
(E)	PC6624-Pink Meetin at the Reef – Pink	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into ten 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
(F)	PC6620-Yellow A Sea of Stars – Yellow	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
(G)	PC6619-Citrus Dozens of Dollars – Citrus	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
(H)	PC6618-Fern Little Diggers – Fern	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. • Cut seven 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.
(I)	PC6623-Mango New Wave – Mango	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	• Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
(J)	PC6618-Raspberry Little Diggers – Raspberry	$\frac{7}{8}$ yard	• Cut four 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. • Cut three 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
(K)	SC5333-White Cotton Couture – White	1 yard	• Cut one 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and four 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.. • Cut one 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into twelve 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. • Cut three 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-four 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
Backing	PC6616-Magenta Swimming in the Sea – Magenta	3 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards	• Cut two 62" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 77" pieced backing.

You will also need:

- 62" x 77" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Block Assembly

1. Sew one 3 ½" Fabric E square, one 3 ½" Fabric F square, one 3 ½" Fabric G square, two 3 ½" Fabric K squares and two 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric K strips together to make one Block One (Fig. 1).
2. Repeat Step 1 using assorted 3 ½" squares, two 3 ½" Fabric K squares and two 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric K strips to make eight Block Ones.
3. Sew three assorted 3 ½" squares, three 3 ½" Fabric K squares and one 3 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric K strip together to make one Block Two (Fig. 2). Repeat to make six Block Twos total.

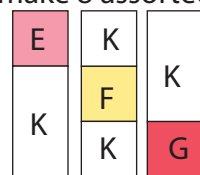

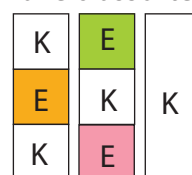
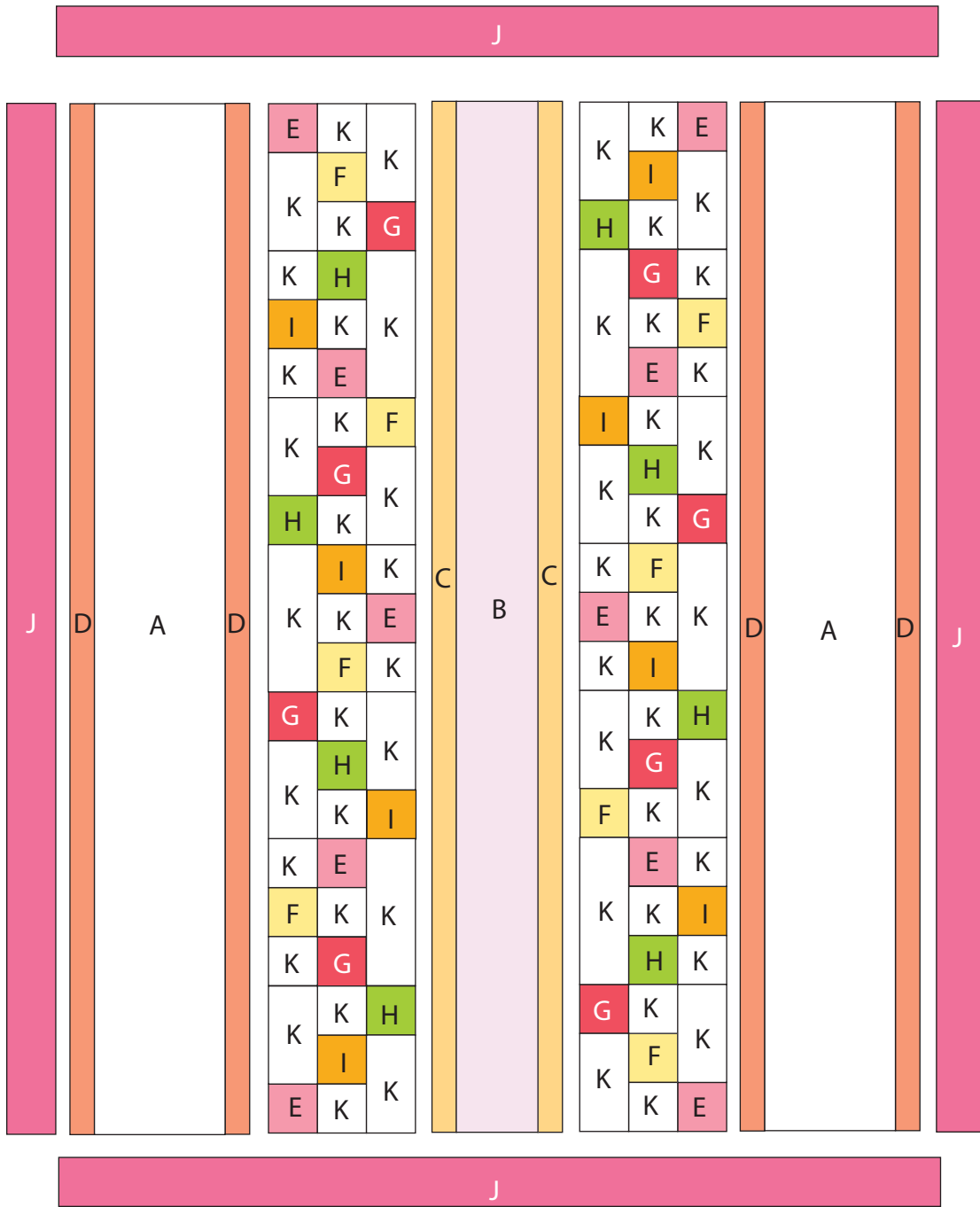

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

4. Sew one 2" x 63 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of one 8 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric A strip to make Column One. Repeat to make Column Five.
5. Sew four Block Ones and three Block Twos together to make Column Two. Repeat to make Column Four.
6. Sew one 2" x 63 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of one 5 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric B strip to make Column Three.
7. Sew the five columns together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
8. Sew one 3 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the seven 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
11. Bind as desired.
