





## **Materials**

## **Cutting instructions**

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	CX6901-Blue On the Town – Blue	1 ½ yards	• Fussy cut six 10 ½" x WOF strips. Sew together matching artwork to make three 10 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
(B)	CX6900-Blue Lana – Blue	¼ yard	• Cut one 5 ⅓" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into five 5 ⅓" squares.
(C)	CX6899-Navy Ava – Navy	¼ yard	• Cut one 5 ⅓" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 5 ⅓" squares.
(D)	CX6904-Blue Blooming Damask – Blue	¼ yard	• Cut one 5 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 5 1/8" squares.
(E)	CX6902-Blue Nosegay Bouquet – Blue	¼ yard	• Cut one 5 ⅓" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 5 ⅓" squares.
(F)	CX6665-Navy Marilyn – Navy	¼ yard	• Cut one 5 ⅓" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into five 5 ⅓" squares.
(G)	CX6665-Blue Marilyn – Blue	¼ yard	• Cut one 5 ⅓" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into five 5 ⅓" squares.
(H)	CX6905-Blue On the Town Stripe – Blue	¼ yard	• Cut one 5 ⅓" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 5 ⅓" squares.
(1)	CX6899-Blue Ava – Blue	¼ yard	• Cut one 5 $\%$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 5 $\%$ " squares.
(J)	SC5333-Turquoise Cotton Couture – Turquoise	½ yard	• Cut (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (6) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
(K)	SC5333-Bright White Cotton Couture – Bright White	1 yard	• Cut five 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-two 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
(L)	SC5333-Midnight Cotton Couture – Midnight	½ yard	• Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
Backing CX6665-Navy Marilyn – Navy		3 ¼ yards	<ul> <li>Cut two 58" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 74" pieced backing.</li> </ul>

#### You will also need:

• 58" x 74" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.




# **Block Assembly**

1. Place one 5 ½" Fabric K square on top of one 5 ½" Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two BK units (Fig. 3). Trim BK units to measure 5 ½" square. Repeat to make ten BK units total. (Only nine will be used).



2. Repeat Step 1 and follow Figure 4, using the chart below, make the designated number of units:

<u>5 %" Square</u>	<u>5 %" Square</u>	Total # of 5 ½" units
(4) Fabric K	(4) Fabric C	(8) CK units (seven will be used)
(3) Fabric K	(3) Fabric D	(6) DK units
(4) Fabric K	(4) Fabric E	(8) EK units
(5) Fabric K	(5) Fabric F	(10) FK units (nine will be used)
(5) Fabric K	(5) Fabric G	(10) GK units (nine will be used)
(3) Fabric K	(3) Fabric H	(6) HK units
(3) Fabric K	(3) Fabric I	(6) IK units



# **Quilt Top Assembly**

## (Follow the Quilt layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 3. Sew one 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of one 10 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric A strip to make one A-strip. Repeat to make three A-strips total.
- 4. Sew ten assorted 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " units together end to end to make one pieced strip. Repeat to make six pieced strips total.
- 5. Sew the six pieced strips and three A-strips together to make the quilt top.
- 6. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 7. Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF Fabric L strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 8. Bind as desired.
