Note: There is a lot of applique in this quilt. Machine applique is recommended because it is faster. Use straight stitch, buttonhole stitch, or satin stitch. Satin stitch was used for this quilt. The applique makes this quilt more time consuming. However, once completed it will be a treasured holiday quilt to be used year after year, becoming a family tradition.

Also Needed: 45" x 60" batting, scissors, straight pins, threads to match (red, green, orange, black, gray, white, and pale blue for applique), rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, mat, and fusible web.

Optional (but recommended) iron-on tear-away stabilizer (use behind all machine applique).

Directions:

- 1. Following manufacturer's directions, trace road pattern (with all the segments joined) to the paper side of the fusible web. Rough cut out. Iron onto SC5333 Breeze. Cut out pattern. Remove paper backing. Iron in place on top of CX8385 Snow 18 ½" W x 23 ½" H piece as shown. Machine stitch in place. Change thread to gray. Machine straight 5-6 irregular lines along road to create tire tracks. Keep motifs upright.
- 2. With right sides together sew CX8385 Winter 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " W x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " H piece to the top of CX8385 Snow, as shown. Keep motifs upright. Set aside.

3. For the Cherry house – trace all needed pattern pieces onto the fusible web. Rough cut out. Iron each pattern piece on the designated fabrics. Cut out. Refer to photo for placement. Place SC5333 Cherry – $8" \times 10 \%"$ piece in upper right corner of center panel. Add roof pieces, snow, short chimney, arched windows, shutters, door as shown. Place CX8385 Peppermint $1\%" \times 3"$ bias pieces on each side of door for picket fence. Fuse pieces in place as shown. Add SC5333 Bright White $\%" \times 3"$ piece over striped pickets to make fence. Add (2) SC533 Bright White $3/8" \times 3"$ pieces to the bottom edge of the roof. Trim outer edge to match roof angle. Form a peak using SC5333 Bright White $3/8" \times 5"$ pieces. Trim angles as shown. Machine applique house pieces in place using matching threads. Repeat process for the Green house using the appropriate pattern pieces and fusible web. Refer to photo for placement of all pieces. Add (1) SC5333 Green and (2) SC5333 Spearmint small trees as shown to complete the center panel.

Use iron-on tear-away stabilizer on the back of the center panel before stitching patterns in place. Remove all stabilizer after stitching.

- 4. Sew CX8386 Peppermint 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew CX8386 Peppermint 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to each side. Set aside.
- 5. For the border of appliqued blocks. Follow the process in Step #3. Trace patterns onto fusible web, cut out, iron on designated fabric. Cut out. Remove paper. Iron motif on designated background. Machine applique in place.

Make the following:

- (1) Large Spearmint tree on DC7818 5 ½" x 10 ½" piece
- (1) Large Green tree on DC7818 5 ½" x 10 ½" piece
- (2) Snowflakes one each on DC7818 5 1/2" W x 4 1/2" H
- (2) Snowflakes one each on DC7818 5 1/2" squares
- (1) Small Green tree on one DC7818 5 1/2" square
- (1) Red car with (2) tires and ½ tree on top of car on SC5333 Breeze 5 ½" x 8 ½" piece
- (1) Green car with (2) tires and (3) gifts on top of car on SC5333 Breeze 5 ½" x 8 ½" piece
- (1) Small Spearmint tree on DC7818 5 ½" W x 4 ½" H piece
- (2) DC7818 Snowman on SC5333 Breeze 5 ½" x 8 ½". Add hat and scarf to each as shown.

Machine applique. Add twig arms, 'coal' eyes, mouth, and buttons. Stitch orange carrot for nose, using satin stich reduced in width gradually to make 'carrot'. Set aside.

6. To add border: Bottom row begin and end with CX8386 Midnite 1" \times 5 ½" pieces alternate with the following block, red car block 5 ½" \times 8 ½", snowflake 5 ½" square, and CX8383 5 ½" square. Sew to the bottom of the quilt. Keep motifs upright.

For left side row from the bottom using CX8386 1" x 5 %" pieces between (1) 5 %" W x 10 %" H Spearmint tree, (1) CX8383 5 %" square, (1) 5 %" x 9" snowman, (1) 5 %" W x 4 %" H, end with CX8386 1" x 5 %" piece. Sew to the left side of the quilt.

For the right side from the bottom sew together (2) DC7818 3" squares with (2) SC5333 Breeze 3" squares to make a checkerboard, use CX8386 Midnite 1" \times 5 ½" strips between blocks, add (1) 5 ½" W \times 4 ½" H snowflake, (1) CX8382 5 ½" W \times 4 ½" H square, (1) 5 ½" \times 10 ½" large green tree, (1) 5 ½" \times 9" snowman, (1) CX8383 5 ½" square, (1) CX8385 Midnite 1" \times 5 ½" piece. Sew to the right side of the quilt.

For the top row from the left side to the right using CX8386 Midnite 1" \times 5 ½" pieces between, begin with a second checkerboard block made from 3" squares – (2) each SC5333 Breeze and (2) DC7818, (1) 5 ½" square snowflake, and (1) 5 ½" square CX8383, (1) 5 ½" square small Green tree and ending with the Green car block with the gifts. Sew to the top of the quilt.


- 7. Sew one CX8386 Evergreen 1" x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one 1" x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece pieced for length to each side.
- 8. Sew one CX8381 5" W x 46 ½" H (cut vertically) to each side of the quilt. Keep motifs upright.
- 9. Sew one CX8384 5" square to each end of the CX8381 5" H x 31 ½" W pieces. Sew one to the top and one to the bottom, keeping motifs upright.
- 10. Layer backing CX8384 Winter, batting, and guilt top. Baste.
- 11. Quilt as desired.
- 12. Bind guilt using CX8386 Midnite 2 ½" strips pieced as needed for length.




