| $E$ | (1) 3-1/2" $\times$ WOF strip; subcut (4) 2" $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles E-1 and (4) $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares E-2 |

## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Sew a Fabric B rectangle B-1 to a Fabric D rectangle D-1. Press toward Fabric B rectangle. Pieced unit to measure $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 4 total units.


Make 4

Sew a Fabric C rectangle C-1 to a Fabric E rectangle E-1. Press toward Fabric C rectangle. Pieced unit to measure $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 4 total units.


Make 4

Sew a Fabric B rectangle B-2 to a Fabric E square E-2. Press toward Fabric B rectangle. Pieced unit to measure 2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.



Make 4

Sew a Fabric C rectangle C-2 to a Fabric D square D-2. Press toward Fabric C rectangle. Pieced unit to measure 2" x 10-1/2".


Make 4
Make 4 blocks: Sew short sections to the top and the bottom of the panel rectangle. Add longer sections to left and right side. Press all seams toward panel.


Stitch blocks together ordering as shown below.


Layer runner, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Join (4) 2-1/2" Fabric G strips, then bind.

## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Sew a Fabric B rectangle to a Fabric D rectangle D-1. Press toward Fabric D rectangle. Stitch Fabric F rectangle F-1 to end of pair. Pieced unit to measure $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 4 total units.


## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS, CONTINUED

Sew a Fabric C rectangle to a Fabric E rectangle E-1. Press toward Fabric E rectangle. Stitch Fabric G rectangle G-1 to end of pair. Pieced unit to measure 4-1/2" x 13-1/2". Repeat to make 4 total units.


Make 4

Sew a Fabric D rectangle D-2 to Fabric G rectangle G-2. Press toward Fabric D rectangle. Pieced strips to measure 2" x 10-1/2". Repeat to make 4 total strips.

$\square$ Make 4

Sew a Fabric E rectangle E-2 to Fabric F rectangle F-2. Press toward Fabric E rectangle. Pieced strips to measure 2 " x 10-1/2". Repeat to make 4 total strips.


Make 4

Arrange all sections as shown below. Sew short sections to the top and the bottom of the panel rectangle. Add larger sections to left and right side. Press all seams toward panel.

Layer pieced placemat, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired.
Join (7) 2-1/2" Fabric H strips, then bind.
