

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS	
1 MEND PILLOW PANEL	Cut 2	Trim each panel to 17-1/2" x 13-1/2" (Aim for approximately 2" of black above the flag and approximately 1-3/2" to the right and left of the flag.)
2 MEND STRIPE	(3) 4" WOF strips	Sub-cut into (24) 4" squares
3 MEND STARS	(1) 6-1/2" WOF strip Backing	Sub-cut into (6) 6-1/2" squares 40" x 70" 20" x 40" 20" x 30"


Piecing Instructions:

Sew with a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press all seams open.

Make (48) half square triangles. (HST's)

1. Gather the (24) MEND stripe squares and the (24) 4" black squares.

2. Place a striped square and black square right sides together.




3. Pair half of the black squares with the stripes in a vertical orientation and half of the black squares in a horizontal orientation. Draw a line from the top left corner to the bottom right corner on the wrong side of each striped square as shown.

4. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn line.


5. Cut on the drawn line of each sewn square set to yield two HST's. Repeat to make 48 HST's.

6. Press the seam open and trim to $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square.

7. Pair each HST with its mirror image with the stripes vertical as shown.




8. Sew mirror image HST pairs together to create (24) sets of star points that look like this.



9. Gather (6) blue $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, (20) star point sets, and (17) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " black squares to construct 3 complete, 2 partial, and 1 partial corner star.

Construct (3) complete stars



10. For each star use (4) star point sets, one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " blue square, and (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " black squares.

11. Sew star point sets to the top and bottom of the blue square.

12. Sew in a column a black square, a star point set (pointed left) and another black square.


13. Sew the column constructed in step 12 to the left side of center star section making sure to match seams and corners.

14. Sew in a column a black square, a star point set (pointed right) and another black square.

15. Sew the column constructed in step 14 to the right side of the center star section making sure to match seams and corners.

16. Repeat steps 10 – 15 to piece (3) full stars and set aside.

Construct (2) partial stars.



17. For each partial star gather (3) star point sets, one 6½" blue square, and (2) 3½" black squares.


18. Sew star point sets to each side of the blue square making sure the points are oriented correctly.

19. Sew a 3½" black square to each side of a star point set.

20. Sew the row constructed in Step 19 to the bottom of the center star section making sure to match seams and corners.

21. Repeat steps 17 – 20 to piece another partial star for a total of (2) and set aside.

Construct (1) partial corner star.



22. For the partial corner star use (2) star point sets, (1) 6½" blue square, and (1) 3½" black square.


23. Sew a star point set to the left side of the blue square. Make sure the star points are oriented correctly.

24. Sew the black square to the left side of a star point set.

25. Sew the row constructed in Step 24 to the bottom of the center star section. Set aside.

Construct (6) panels.

26. Gather A (pillow panel), B, C, I, and a star point set F for Panel 1.





27. Sew B to the top of panel A.

28. Sew C to the left side of A/B.

29. Sew the star point set F to the right side of I with the star points pointing up.


30. Sew I/F to the bottom of ABC to complete Panel 1.

31. Gather (2) full stars, E, and a star point set F for Panel 2.



32. Sew F to the right side of E with the star points pointing left.

33. Sew stars D to the top and bottom of EF to complete Panel 2.



34. Gather (1) partial star G, (2) H pieces, and J for Panel 3.

35. Sew the H pieces to the top and bottom of the partial star G.


Make sure to orient the partial star as shown.

36. Sew J to the right side of the HGH section to complete Panel 3.


Construct top section of the quilt top.

37. Place panels 1, 2 and 3 in order from left to right as shown.

38. Sew panel 1 to the left side of panel 2. Sew panel three to the right side of the panel 1/2 section to create the top section of the quilt top. Set aside.



39. For Panel 4 gather a full star D, two star point sets F, K, L, M and O.




40. Sew M to the bottom of F making sure the star points point to the right.

41. Sew O to the left side of FM.

42. Sew L to the left side of the full star, D.
43. Sew the LD to the top of OFM.
44. Sew the star points set F to the right side of K again making sure the star points point to the right.
45. Sew KF to the top of LDOFM to complete Panel 4.
46. Gather a partial corner star, Q, a partial star G, E, and N.



47. Sew E to the bottom of the partial corner star, Q.
48. Sew the partial star G to the bottom of QE.
49. Sew N to the bottom of Q,G,E to complete Panel 5.
50. Gather the pillow panel A, P, and R for Panel 6.




51. Sew P to the bottom of A.

52. Sew J to the right of PA to complete Panel 6.

Construct bottom section of the quilt top.

53. Place panels 4, 5 and 6 in order from left to right as shown.




54. Sew panel 4 to the left side of Panel 5.

55. Sew panel 6 to the right side of the panel 4/5 section to create the bottom section of the quilt top.

Complete the quilt top.


56. Sew the top section (Panels 1 – 3) to the bottom section of the quilt (Panels 4 - 6) to complete the quilt top.

Make the back.

57. Sew the two 20" wide pieces to make a column. Sew the column to the side of the 40" wide piece to make a back.



Finish the quilt.

58. Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired.

59. Join the (7) 2 1/2" binding strips and bind to finish the quilt.
