Trickster

1/4" Seam Allowance Check

Even if you use a 1/4" foot, your seam allowance may not be accurate!

To check if your seam is accurate, cut three 1 1/2" x 3" pieces from scrap fabric.

Sew the pieces together along the 3" side, using what you believe is a 1/4" seam.

Press away from the center piece.

Measure.

The center piece should be **exactly** 1" wide.



If, when you measure, the center is less than 1", your seam allowance is too large.

If it's more than 1", your seam allowance is too small.

Refer to your machines owner's manual for instructions on changing your needle position.

Repeat the test until your center strip measures *exactly* 1".

FABRIC	CUTTING
Α	(3) 2½" x 41½" (2) 2½" x 32½"
В	(3) 6" squares, fussy cut on small squares of panel
С	(4) 6" x 65%" rectangles, fussy cut on wide stripe
D	(5) 4½" x WOF (width of fabric)
E	(5) 2½" x WOF for binding
F	(1) 21" x 41½" fussy cut on design

Assembly:

Use the assembly diagram on page 4 to assemble the quilt.

- 1. Stitch three fabric B 6" squares and four fabric C 6" x 65%" squares together as shown.
- 2. Combine three fabric A $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips with the pieced strip and fabric F $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- 3. Add one fabric A 2½" x 32½" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 4. Stitch one fabric D 4½" x WOF strip to the top and bottom of the quilt, preparing to miter corners.
- 5. Cut one fabric D 4½" x WOF strip in half. Add a whole strip to each piece. Add to the quilt, mitering corners.

Finishing:

- 6. Layer, baste and quilt as desired.
- 7. Bind with five fabric E $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

Bonus:

You can make a set of four placemats with the remaining panel pieces of fabric B. Just layer each piece on a fat quarter of backing fabric and make sure to use 100% cotton batting. Then just quilt and bind!
