

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Α	Centering motifs, fussy-cut (8) Diamond Templates and (8) 2-1/4" squares.
В	(1) 3" x 42" strip; subcut (8) Diamond Templates.
С	 (1) 6-1/4" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 6-1/4" x 20" rectangles. (3) 3-1/2" x 42" strips; subcut (16) Large Triangle Templates and (12) Small Triangle Templates and (12) reversed Small Triangle Templates. (1) 6-3/4" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 6-3/4" squares. Cut squares in half diagonally once to make (4) triangles. FOR BINDING: (6) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.
D	"Mi Casa Es Tu Casa" letter patterns (see step 1).
Е	(8) Diamond Templates with arrow on straight grain.
F	(1) 6-3/4" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 6-3/4" squares and (4) Diamond Templates. Cut squares in half diagonally once to make (4) triangles.
G	(4) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 44-1/2" strips and (2) 2-1/4" x 35-1/2" strips.
Н	(6) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 59-1/2" strips and (2) 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips.
I	(1) 3" x 42" strip; subcut (8) Diamond Templates.
J	(20) Diamond Templates with arrow on straight grain.
K	Centering design, fussy cut: 35-1/2" x 44-1/2".
	Batting 63" x 72"

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

3-1/8 yards backing fabric Sewing machine Template plastic Thread to match fabrics Basic sewing supplies Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Optional:

Paper backed fusible webbing



APPLIQUÉ BLOCKS

1. Prepare the **D** "MI CASA ET TU CASA" letters using your favorite raw edge appliqué technique. Pin, fuse or baste the letters in place centered on (1) 6-1/4" x 20" **C** rectangle. Sew along the edges of the letters.







PATCHWORK BORDERS

- 2. Sew (1) A Diamond Template to (1) B Diamond Tempate. Make 2.
- **3.** Sew Diamond pairs together to make a diamond unit. Make 4.
- 4. Following steps 2-3, make diamond units using E/J, F/J and I/J.



- **5.** Sew (1) **C** Large Triangle to side of (1) **E/J** diamond unit. Sew (1) **C** Small Triangle to opposite side. Make 4.
- 6. Sew (2) C Large Triangles to opposite sides of (1) A/B diamond unit. Make 4.
- 7. Sew (2) C Large Triangles to opposite sides of (1) F/J diamond unit. Make 2.





8. Sew triangle/diamond units together matching seams. Sew (2) **C** reversed Small Triangles to **E/J** diamonds to complete side borders. Border should measure 6-1/4" x 48" including seam allowance. Make 2.

9. Sew (2) **C** Small Triangles to opposite sides of (1) **I/J** diamond unit. Sew (2) **C** reversed Small Triangles to sides of (1) **I/J** diamond unit to make a rectangle unit. Make 4.

10. Sew rectangle units to ends of appliqué blocks to make top and bottom borders. Borders should measure 6-1/4" x 50-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 2.

11. Sew (1) **F** 6-3/4" triangle to (1) **C** 6-3/4" triangle along diagonal edges to make a square unit. Make 4

BORDERS

- **12.** Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, sew (1) **G** 2-1/4" x 44-1/2" strips to each side of (1) **K** 35-1/2" x 44-1/2" panel. Sew (2) **A** 2-1/4" squares to ends of (2) **G** 2-1/4" x 35-1/2" strips. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- **13.** Sew diamond borders to sides of quilt. Sew (2) **C/F** square units to ends of top and bottom borders. Note orientation of fabric triangles. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- **14.** Sew (2) **H** (2) 2-1/4" x 59-1/2" strips to sides of quilt. Sew (2) **A** 2-1/4" squares to ends of (2) **H** 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.



Quilt Layout




FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using six fabric **C** 2-1/4" strips.



Appliqué Patterns

Note: Trace patterns in reverse when using paper backed fusible webbing. Iron to wrong side of fabric.
