R	(1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips and (2) 2-1/2" squares.
S	(1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips and (2) 2-1/2" squares.
T	(1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips and (2) 2-1/2" squares.
U	(1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips and (2) 2-1/2" squares.
V	(1) 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" WOF strip, piece as needed. (1) 1-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
W	(4) Template T-1 triangles. (4) Template T-2 triangles.
X	(2) Template T-1 triangles. (2) Template T-2 triangles.
Y	(3) Template T-1 triangles. (3) Template T-2 triangles.
Z	(2) Template T-1 triangles. (2) Template T-2 triangles.

BB	(1) 5" x 9" strip.
CC	FOR BINDING: (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sew short ends together.
Back	(2) 50" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 50" x 50" pieced backing.
	Batting 50" x 50"
	You will also need: 5" x 9" strip of fusible web

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Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

1. Follow **Figure 1** and sew together along the long sides, (1) Fabric **K Template 1** triangle and (1) Fabric **J Template 1** triangle. Press open to make (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" **Block One** rectangle. Repeat to make (8) **Block One** rectangles total.

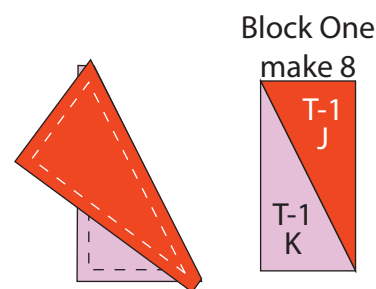

2. Repeat **Step 1** and refer to **Figures 2-21** for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of block rectangles for **Block Two** through **Block Twenty-One**. *Note: There will be a total of (84) block rectangles for **Block One** through **Block Twenty-One**.*

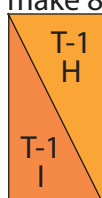

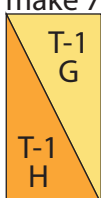

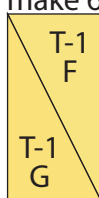

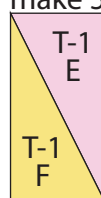

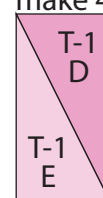

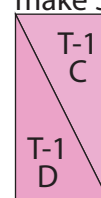

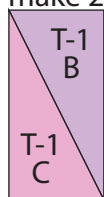

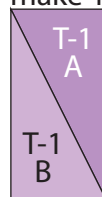

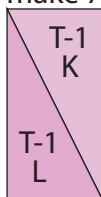

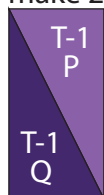

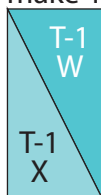

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3. Sew (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **R** square to the top of (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **S** square (**Fig. 22**). Using **Template 1**, cut out (1) **Unit 1** triangle (**Fig. 22**).

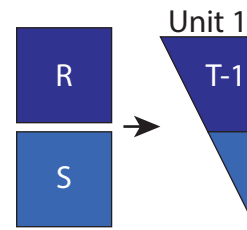

4. Sew (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **T** square to the top of (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **U** square (**Fig. 23**). Using **Template 1**, cut out (1) **Unit 2** triangle (**Fig. 23**).

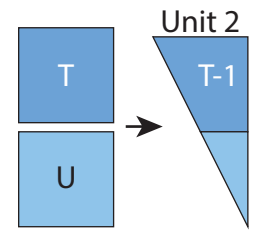

5. Follow **Figure 24** and sew together (1) Fabric **W** **Template 1** triangle and (1) **Unit 1** triangle along their long sides to make (1) **Block Twenty-Two** rectangle.

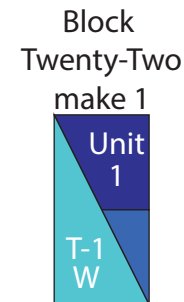

6. Follow **Figure 25** and sew together (1) Fabric **Y** **Template 1** triangle and (1) **Unit 2** triangle along their long sides to make (1) **Block Twenty-Three** rectangle.

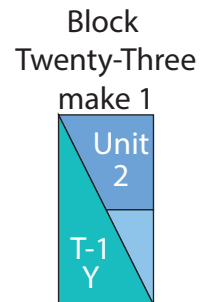

7. Follow **Figure 26** and sew together (1) Fabric **A** **Template 2** triangle and (1) Fabric **B** **Template 2** triangle along their long sides to make (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" **Block Twenty-four** rectangle.

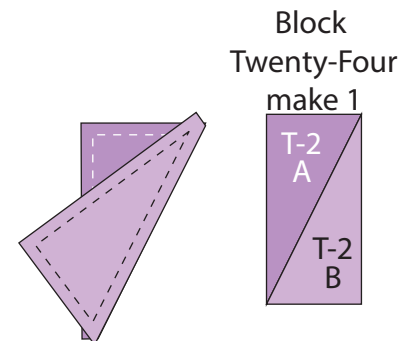

8. Repeat **Step 7** and refer to **Figures 27-46** for fabric identification and placement to make the indicated number of block rectangles for **Block Twenty-Five** through **Block Forty-Four**. *Note: There will be a total of (84) block rectangles for **Block Twenty-Four** through **Block Forty-Four**.*

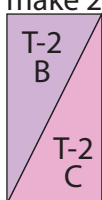

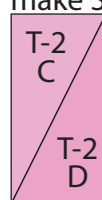

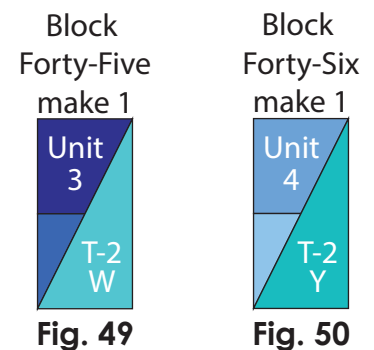
9. Sew (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **R** square to the top of (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **S** square (**Fig. 47**). Using **Template 2**, cut out (1) **Unit 3** triangle (**Fig. 47**).

10. Sew (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **T** square to the top of (1) 2-1/2" Fabric **U** square (**Fig. 48**). Using **Template 2**, cut out (1) **Unit 4** triangle (**Fig. 48**).



11. Follow **Figure 49** and sew together (1) **Unit 3** triangle and (1) Fabric **W** **Template 2** triangle along their long sides to make (1) **Block Forty-Five** rectangle.

12. Follow **Figure 50** and sew together (1) **Unit 4** triangle and (1) Fabric **Y** **Template 2** triangle along their long sides to make (1) **Block Forty-Six** rectangle.



13. Refer to **Figure 51** and sew together (20) assorted block rectangles lengthwise to make **Row One**.

14. Repeat **Step 13** and refer to **Figure 51** for component identification, placement and orientation to make **Row Two** through **Row Seven**.

15. Refer to **Figure 51** and sew together (18) assorted block rectangles lengthwise. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric **Q** strip to each end of the newly sewn strip to make **Row Eight**.

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16. Sew together the (8) pieced **Rows**, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom, to make (1) 40-1/2" x 32-1/2" **Unit 5** rectangle (**Fig. 51**).

17. Following the manufacturer's instructions, press the fusible web onto the wrong side of the 5" x 9" Fabric **BB** strip.

18. Fold the 5" x 9 Fabric **BB** strip right sides together to make a 5" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Align the fabric fold with the "FOLD" side of the Sun template. Trace the Sun template onto the paper side of the Fabric **BB** rectangle.

19. Cut on the drawn line through both layers of fabric to make the Fabric **BB** Sun.

20. Refer to **Figure 52** to arrange and press the Fabric **BB** Sun onto the **Unit 5** rectangle.

21. Finish the raw edges of the shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the **Top Row** (**Fig. 52**).

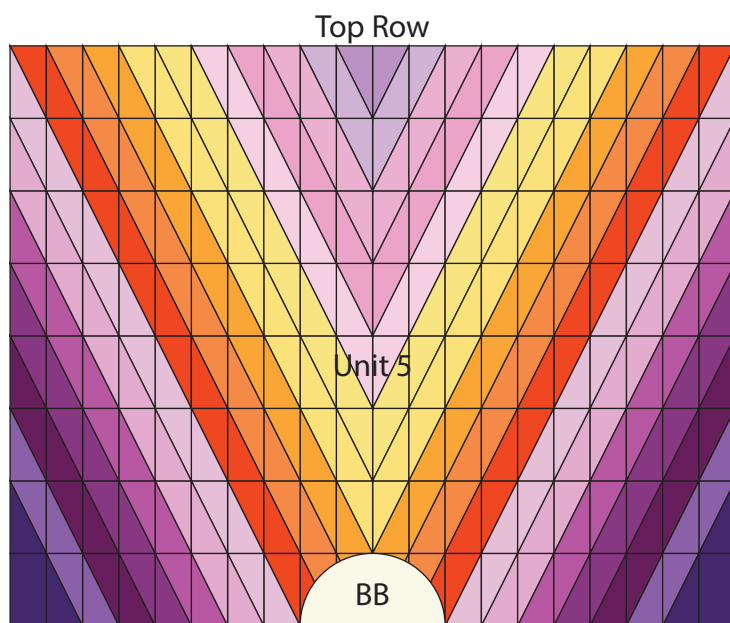

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22. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric **R** to the top of (1) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric **S** strip lengthwise to make (1) **RS** strip (Fig. 53). Repeat to make (2) **RS** strips total.

23. Refer to **Figure 53** to sew together (6) assorted block rectangles lengthwise. Sew (1) **RS** strip to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the **Middle Row (Fig. 53)**.

24. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric **T** to the top of (1) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" Fabric **U** strip lengthwise to make (1) **TU** strip (**Fig. 54**). Repeat to make (2) **TU** strips total.

25. Refer to **Figure 54** to sew together (8) assorted block rectangles lengthwise. Sew (1) **TU** strip to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the **Bottom Row (Fig. 54)**.

26. Sew together the (3) pieced **Rows** lengthwise to make the 40-1/2" x 40-1/2" **Center Block (Fig. 55)**.

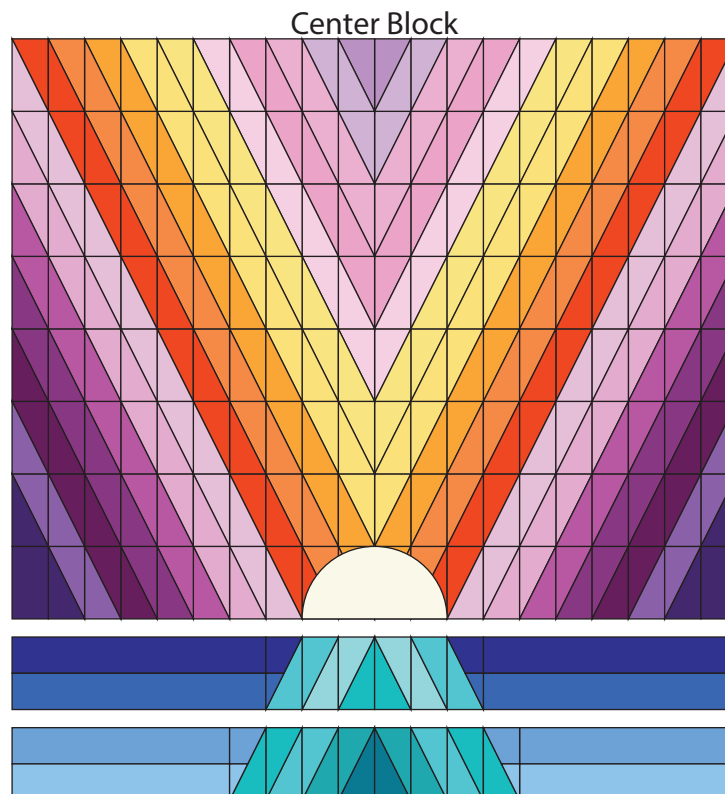

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Quilt Top Assembly:

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

27. Sew 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" Fabric **C** strip to the top of (1) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric **V** strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the left side and the right side of the **Center Block**.

28. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" Fabric **L** strip to the top of the **Center Block**.

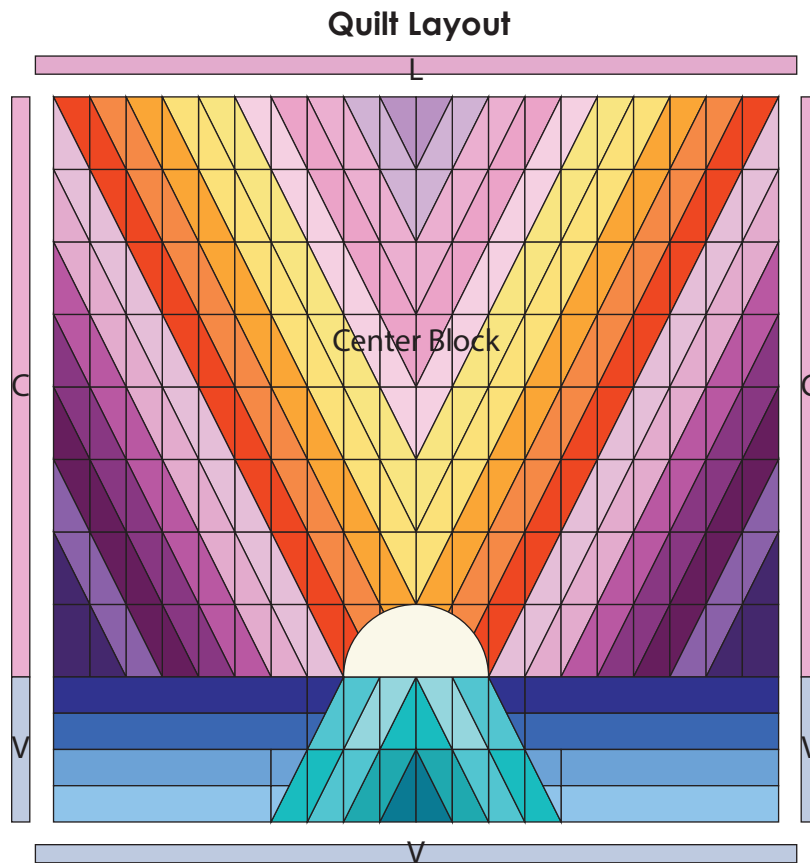
29. Sew (1) 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" Fabric **V** strip to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING:

30. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.

31. Quilt as desired.

32. Bind to finish quilt.
