76" x 96" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

- 1. Sew together (11) assorted 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces of DC5153, DC5152, CX4834, and CX4833. Make (2) strips. Sew one to the top of the DC5110 panel and one to the bottom.
- 2. Sew DC5057 12 1/2" x 22 1/2" piece to the top of the panel.
- 3. Sew CM0376 Sprout 1 $1/2'' \times 22 1/2''$ piece to the bottom of the panel. Sew CM0376 Sprout 1 $1/2'' \times 65 1/2''$ (pieced for length) to each side.
- 4. Sew DC5057 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" piece to the bottom of the quilt. Sew DC5057 2 1/2" x 69 1/2" piece to each side.
- 5. Sew CM0376 Azalea 1 1/2" x 28 1/2" piece to the bottom. Sew CM0376 Azalea 1 1/2" x 70 1/2" (pieced for length) to each side.
- 6. Align edges of DC5108 21 1/2" border piece with top of quilt (with the bottom of the panel to the outside). Sew the border to each side of the quilt. Excess will be left at each end. Mark the middle of the DC5108 21 1/2" x 76 1/2" border panel. Mark the center bottom of the quilt panel. Match the marks and sew the border to the bottom of the quilt. Use the excess fabric on each end to miter the corners. Set aside.
- 7. For the backing sew one DC5057 19" x 96" piece to each side of the 96" x W.O.F. piece (with selvage edges removed).
- 8. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 9. Quilt as desired.
- 10. Bind using CM0376 Azalea 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.

Pillow Sham

- 1. Sew one CM0376 Sprout 1" \times 18 1/4" strip to each side of the DC5110 22 1/2" W \times 18 1/4" H section of the panel.
- 2. Sew one CM0376 Azalea 1 1/4" x 18 1/4" piece to each end of the panel. Set aside.
- 3. Turn under a double 1/4" hem along one 18 1/4" edge of each DC5108 18 1/4" H x 19 1/2" W piece.
- 4. Place each DC5108 piece wrong sides together on top of the pillow front. Overlap the hemmed edges in the center. Pin in place.
- 5. For the phlange, sew one DC5153 5 $1/2'' \times 18 1/4''$ piece to each end. Fold to the back. Turn under 1/4'' seam allowance. Stitch in place.
- 6. Repeat for the top and bottom each using DC5153 5 $1/2" \times 31 1/2"$ pieces. Sew to pillow. Fold ends right sides together. Sew 1/4" seam. Trim inner corner. Turn to the right side. Fold under 1/4" seam allowance and stitch to the back of the pillow. Insert standard size bed pillow to finish.
