

Materials

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
DC5503 Flax Accounts	1 7/8 yards	(1) 44" W x 63" L
DC5508 Flax Bon Appetit Table Runner	4 1/4 yards	(2) 14 1/2" x 75" (2) 14 1/2" x 94" *
* Cut apart the three strips along black lines. Choose one strip fold in half across 14 1/2" width. Cut apart. Use these piece for each end of the tablecloth. Cut one each of the remaining strips to length for each side.		
Also Needed: Threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

1. Fold DC5503 44" W x 63" in half. Mark the center on each side (31 1/2" from each end). Fold one DC5508 14 1/2" x 94" in half. Mark (47" from each end). Start at the center marks for each piece. Pin to the end of DC5503. Sew strip to tablecloth leaving 1/4" free at the beginning and end of the seam.
2. Repeat marking the center of one end strip and the end of the tablecloth. Repeat step #1.
3. Miter the corner where to two DC5508 strips meet. Trim away excess fabric.
4. Repeat steps #1 and #3 on all four sides of the tablecloth.
5. Turn under a double 1/4" seam on the edges. Topstitch in place.
