





CX5937 Black Tea Room	3/4 yard	(1) 16 1/2" W x 22 1/2" H * (4) Teapots **
CX5896 Red Apron Ruffle	1/4 yard	(2) 2" x 16 1/2" (2) 2" x 25 1/2" **
CX5939 Ebony Rosy Dots	1/2 yard	(2) 5" x 19 1/2" (2) 5" x 25 1/2" (4) 5" squares
CX5939 Black Rosy Dots	1/2 yard	(16) 2 3/4" squares (16) 5 1/2" squares
CX5938 Black Tea Room Stripe	1 1/2 yards	(2) 10 1/2" x 28 1/2" (2) 10 1/2" x 34 1/2" **
CX2490 Ebony Dumb Dot	3/8 yard	(4) 10 1/2" squares
Jet Black	1/2 yard	(6) 2 1/2" x W.O.F. - binding

* One way print. Cut vertically. Fussy.

** Center on motif. Fussy stripes and ruffle scallop as shown. Rough cut out four teapots.

Also Needed:

54" x 60" backing, 54 x 60" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, fusible web, and mat. OPTIONAL: iron-on tear-away stabilizer

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

1. Sew one CX5896 Red 2" x 16 1/2" piece to the top and bottom of CX5937 16 1/2" W x 22 1/2" H piece. Sew one CX5896 Red 2" x 25 1/2" piece to each side. Set aside.
2. For the cornerstones - (4) large and (4) small - for one small cornerstone place one CX5939 Black 2 3/4" square in the upper left corner of one CX5939 Ebony 5" square. Align raw edges. Sew diagonally across black square from lower left to upper right corner. Trim away excess fabric from the back. Press contrast corner in place. Repeat for each corner. Repeat for (4) blocks total. Repeat for large cornerstones using CX2490 10 1/2" squares and CX5939 Black 5 1/2" squares. Make (4) total.
3. From CX5937 rough cut four teapot motifs. Following manufacturer's directions iron fusible web on the back of each. Cut out each teapot, removing all background fabric. Remove paper backing. Center one teapot in the center of one 10 1/2" cornerstone as shown. Fuse in place. Machine applique all raw edges to finish. OPTIONAL but recommended - iron stabilizer paper to the back of each cornerstone before starting to applique. Applique through tear-away stabilizer. Remove all stabilizer after stitching. Stabilizer improves the quality and ease of appliques and reduces distortion.
4. Sew one CX5939 Ebony 5" x 19 1/2" piece to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Sew one 5" cornerstone to each end of CX5939 Ebony 5" x 25 1/2" piece. Sew one cornerstone unit to each side of the quilt.
5. Sew one CX5938 10 1/2" x 28 1/2" piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one 10 1/2" cornerstone to each end of one CX5938 10 1/2" x 34 1/2" piece. Keep teapots upright. Sew one cornerstone to each side of the quilt.
6. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
7. Quilt as desired.
8. Bind quilt using Jet Black 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.
