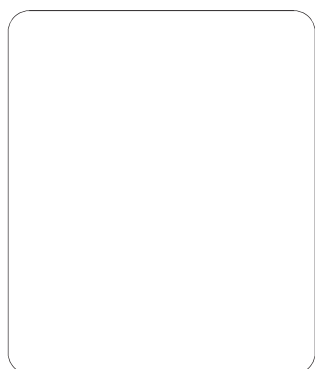

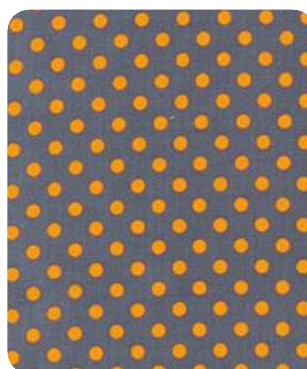

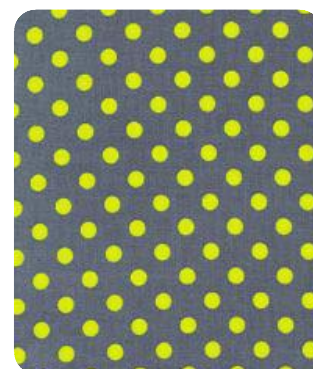

"A" Neon Pink Neon Solid	1/2 yard	15 1/2" x 4" 21 1/2" x 4" (2) 16 1/2" x 4" (2) 20 1/2" x 4" 17 1/2" x 4" 19 1/2" x 4"
"B" Neon Orange Neon Solid	1/2 yard	15 1/2" x 4" 21 1/2" x 4" 19 1/2" x 4" 17 1/2" x 4" 25 1/2" x 4" 11 1/2" x 4"
"C" Neon Lemon Neon Solid	1/2 yard	13 1/2" x 4" 23 1/2" x 4" (2) 16 1/2" x 4" (2) 20 1/2" x 4"
"D" PN2490 Pluto Neo Dot	1/3 yard	11 1/2" x 4" (2) 18 1/2" x 4" 25 1/2" x 4"
"E" PN2490 Ozone Neo Dot	1/3 yard	11 1/2" x 4" (2) 18 1/2" x 4" 25 1/2" x 4"
"F" PN2490 Luna Neo Dot	1/3 yard	11 1/2" x 4" 16 1/2" x 4" 20 1/2" x 4" 25 1/2" x 4"
"G" PN2490 Pink Neo Dot	1/2 yard	(4) 36 1/2" x 4"
"H" PN2490 Orange Neo Dot	1/2 yard	(3) 36 1/2" x 4"
"J" PN2490 Lemon Neo Dot	1/2 yard	(3) 36 1/2" x 4"

Also Needed:

70" x 78" backing, 70" x 78" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

DIRECTIONS

1. This quilt is assembled in vertical rows. Assemble each row as directed.
2. Row#1 - Sew together D 18 1/2", W 36 1/2", D 18 1/2" with W in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabric.
3. Row#2 - Sew together A 13 1/2", G 36 1/2", A 23 1/2" with G in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabric.
4. Row#3 - Sew together C 20 1/2", J 36 1/2", C 16 1/2" with J in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabric.
5. Row#4 - Sew together E 25 1/2", W 36 1/2", E 11 1/2" with W in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabric.
6. Row#5 - Sew together A 17 1/2", G 36 1/2", A 19 1/2" with G in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabric.
7. Row #6 - Sew together B 15 1/2", H 36 1/2", B 21 1/2" with H in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabric.
8. Row #7 - Sew together F 11 1/2", W 36 1/2", F 25 1/2" with W in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabric.
9. Row#8 - Sew together B 19 1/2", H 36 1/2", B 17 1/2" with H in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.
10. Row#9 - Sew together C 16 1/2", J 36 1/2", C 20 1/2" with J in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.
11. Row#10 - Sew together D 25 1/2", W 36 1/2", D 11 1/2" with W in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.
12. Row#11 - Sew together A 20 1/2", G 36 1/2", A 16 1/2" with G in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.
13. Row#12 - Sew together C 13 1/2", J 36 1/2", C 23 1/2" with J in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.
14. Row#13 - Sew together E 18 1/2", W 36 1/2", 18 1/2" with W in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.
15. Row#14 - Sew together A 15 1/2", G 36 1/2", A 21 1/2" with G in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.

16. Row#15 - Sew together B 25 1/2", H 36 1/2", B 11 1/2" with H in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.
17. Row#16 - Sew together F 20 1/2", W 36 1/2", F 16 1/2" with W in the middle. Press seams towards the darker fabrics.
18. Sew rows together in pairs. Sew pairs together continuing until all the rows are together.
19. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
20. Quilt as desired.
21. Bind quilt using SC5333_Charcoal 2 1/2" strips pieced together as needed.
