SC5333 Magenta, Cherry, Orange, Mango, Canary, Meadow, Kryptonite, Crocus, and Violet. Cotton Couture		(4) 2 1/2" x 9" each color
CX5911 Sunshine and Jewel Cora		
CX4834 Lime and Fuchsia Tiny Gingham		
CX5518 Yellow Kiss Dot		
CX1065 Apple, Red, Banana, and Azure Garden Pindot		
DC4808 Pastille Wing Study	1/2 yard	Fussy-cut (5) butterflies and (2) birds
Also Needed: 45" x 60" batting, 45" x 60" backing, thread to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, mat, and fusible web.		
OPTIONAL: Iron-on tear-away stabilizer. (Recommended)

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions:

1. Align one 2 $1/2" \ge 9"$ piece with the top left of one CX5997 6 1/2" square. Sew from the top to within 1/4" of the bottom of the 6 $\frac{1}{2}"$ square. Align one 2 $\frac{1}{2}" \ge 9"$ piece with the lower right corner. Sew seam across bottom of the square to within $\frac{1}{4}"$ of the lower left corner. With the remaining fabric from the two 2 $\frac{1}{2}"$ strips, miter the lower left corner as shown. Trim excess from the back to $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowance. Make four blocks each with the following combinations –

SC5333 Violet/CX5911 Jewel, SC5333 Crocus/CX1065 Azure, SC5333 Meadow/CX1065 Apple, SC5333 Kryptonite/CX4834 Lime, SC5333 Canary/CX5518 Yellow, SC5333 Mango/CX1065 Banana, SC5333 Orange/CX5911 Sunshine, SC5333 Cherry/CX1065 Red, and SC5333 Magenta/CX4834 Fuchsia – (Make 3 of this combination).

- 2. Sew (5) blocks together to make one row. Make (7) rows. Arrange blocks as shown (refer to photo) or as desired.
- 3. Rough cut (2) birds and (5) butterflies from DC4808. Following manufacturer's directions iron fusible web onto the back of each. Cut out. Remove paper backing. Fuse in place on the quilt top as shown or as desired. Machine appliqué all raw edges to finish. OPTIONAL: Use iron-on tear-away stabilizer on the back of the quilt behind each motif before stitching. This improves stitch quality and reduces distortion, remove all stabilizer after stitching.
- 4. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
- 5. Quilt as desired.
- 6. Bind quilt using SC5333 Loden 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.
