Materials

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
DC5782 Jewel Primitive	3/8 yard *	(1) 12 5/8" x 42 1/2" **
DC5785 Jewel Beaded Colorband	5/8 yard	(4) 1 1/4" x 42 1/2" (2) 1 1/4" x 40 1/4" (5) 2 1/2" x W.O.F. - binding
DC5784 Jewel Blanket Chevron	3/4 yard *	(2) 8 1/2" x 42 1/2" ** (2) 3 1/4" x 40 1/4" **
DC5786 Adobe Diamondback	5/8 yard	(2) 4 1/2" x 42 1/2" (2) 4 1/2" x 40 1/4"
* Or amount needed for a complete motif/repeats. ** Center on motifs as shown or as desired.		
Also Needed: 45" x 63" backing, 45 x 63" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, fusible web, and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

Directions

1. Sew one DC5785 1 1/4" x 42 1/2" piece to each side of DC5782 12 5/8" x 42 1/2" piece.
2. Sew one DC5784 8 1/2" x 42 1/2" piece to each side of the center panel. Mirror image the DC5784 pieces as shown.
3. Sew one DC5785 1 1/4" x 42 1/2" piece to each side of the panel.
4. Sew one DC 5786 4 1/2" x 42 1/2" piece to each side of the quilt.
5. Sew one DC 5786 4 1/2" x 40 1/4" piece to the top and bottom of the quilt.
6. Sew one DC5785 1 1/4" x 40 1/4" piece to the top and bottom.
7. Sew one DC5784 3 1/4" x 40 1/4" piece to the top and bottom.
8. Layer, backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
9. Quilt as desired.
10. Bind quilt using DC5785 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.
