

# "Magic Carpet aka Yasmin"

Size: Approximately 40" W x 56" H Skill Level : Confident Beginner

## Materials

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
CX5541 Indigo Yasmin	2 & 7/8 yards	(2) 12" x 50 1/2" * (20) 5 1/2" squares **
DC6278 Indigo Romi	3/4 yard	(2) 3 1/2" x 40 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" x 50 1/2" *** (2) 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" ***
DC6275 Nite Hani	3/8 yard	(5) 2 1/2" x W.O.F. – binding
CX5554 Azure Kota	3/8 yard	(80) 2 1/2" squares
* Cut lengthwise with the border. ** Center each square on a motif and fussy cut. *** Pieced for length		
<b>Also Needed:</b> Also needed: 45" x 60" backing, 45" x 60" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, and mat. <b>OPTIONAL:</b> 2 3/8 yard purchased fringe for the ends of the quilt (3" long).

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Directions

1. For one 5 1/2" block = place one CX5554 2 1/2" square in upper left corner of one CX5541 5 1/2" square. Sew diagonally across the corner of the small square. Press open. Trim away excess from the back. Repeat for each corner to complete the block. Make (20) blocks total. Sew (10) together end to end in a row. Make (2) rows. Set aside.
2. Working from the center – sew one CX5541 12" x 50 1/2" piece to each side of one DC6278 3 1/2" x 50 1/2" (pieced for length) piece. Refer to the photo for the placement of the border.
3. Sew one 10-row strip to each side of the quilt.
4. Sew one DC6278 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" (pieced for length) to each side.
5. Sew one DC6278 3 1/2" x 40 1/2" piece to the top and bottom of the quilt.
6. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
7. Quilt as desired. The quilting used echoes the motifs.
8. Bind quilt using DC6275 2 1/2" strips pieced as needed for length.

**OPTIONAL:** Cut fringe to fit each end. Stabilize with stitching or turn under raw ends. Pin to top and bottom of the quilt. Top stitch in place to finish.
